Amcel - amapa florestal e celulose was the 97th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2013, accounting for 28 thousand tons. This is a 139% increase vs the previous year. As an exporter, Amcel - amapa florestal e celulose sources from 7 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by Amcel - amapa florestal e celulose is Netherlands, accounting for 58% of the total.

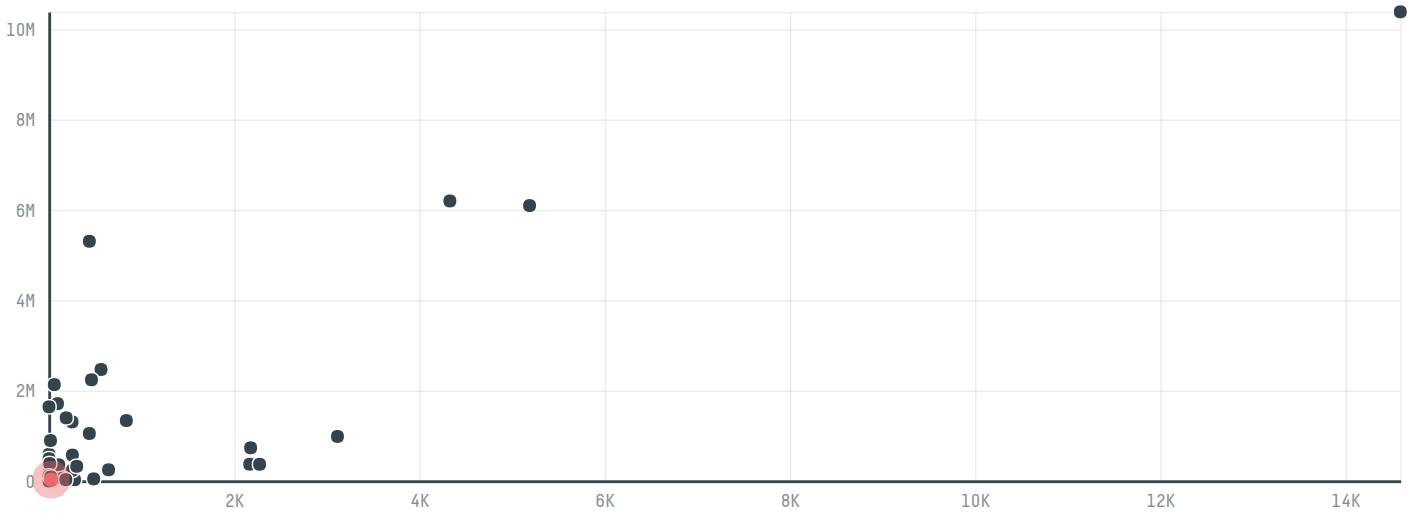
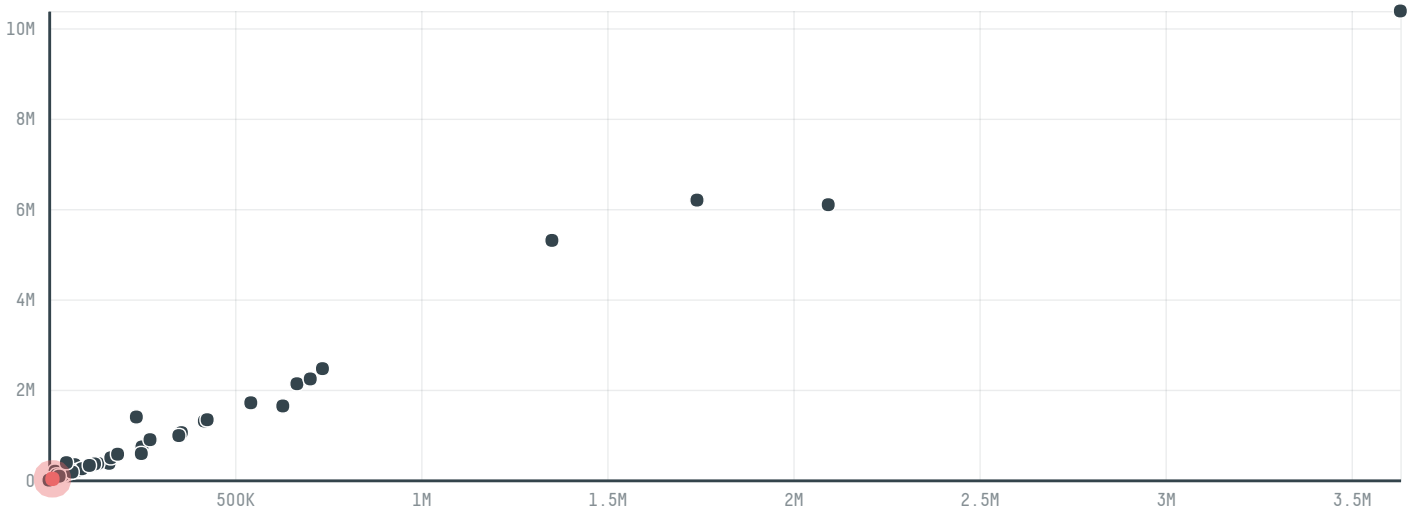
