



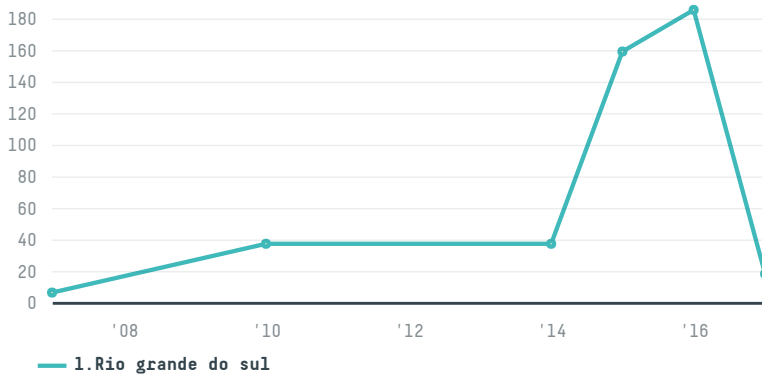
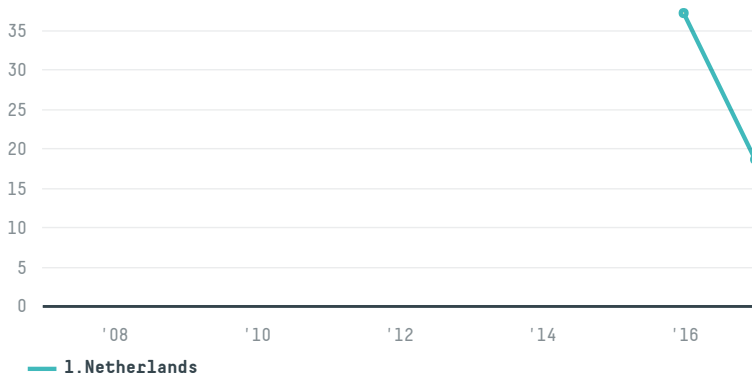

The main destination of the soy imported by Solae europe sa is Netherlands, accounting for 100% of the total.

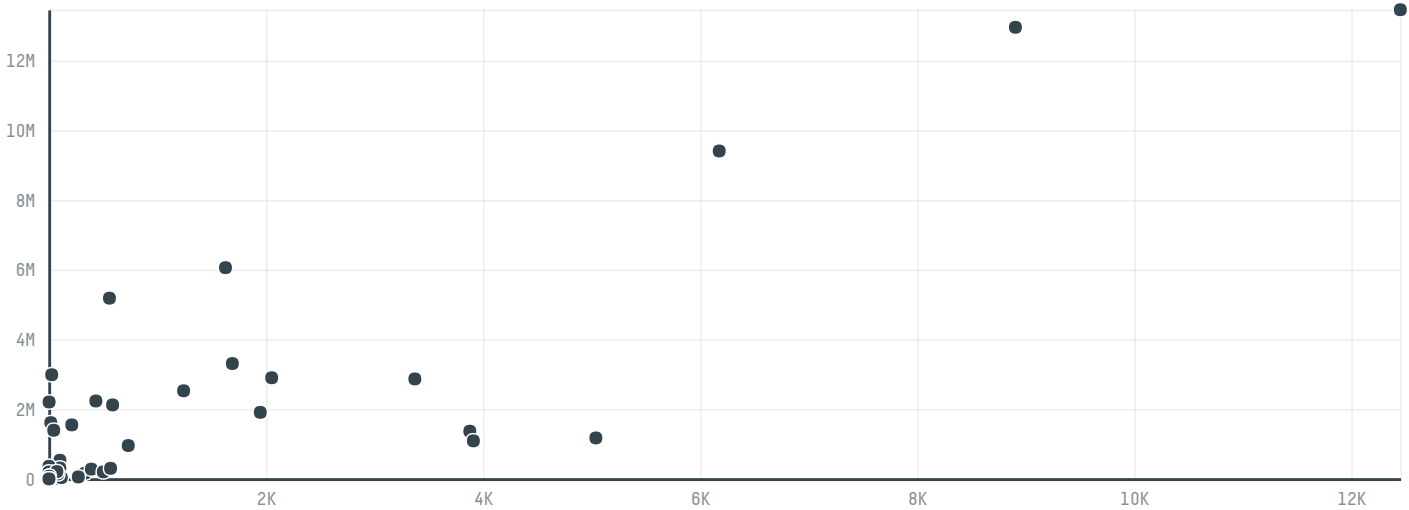
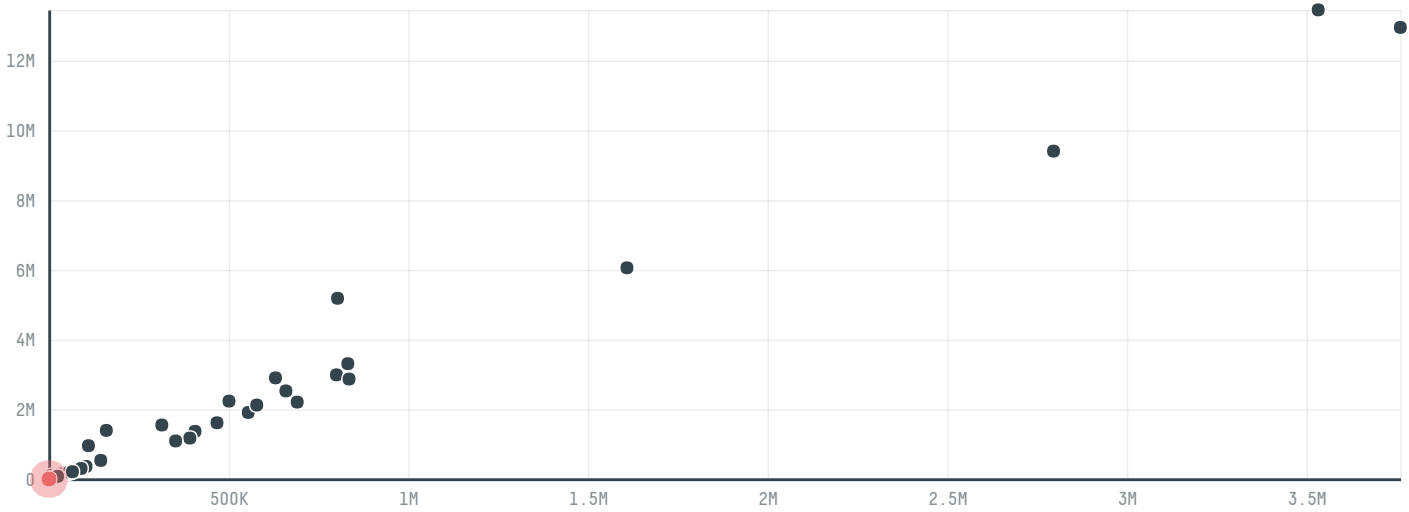

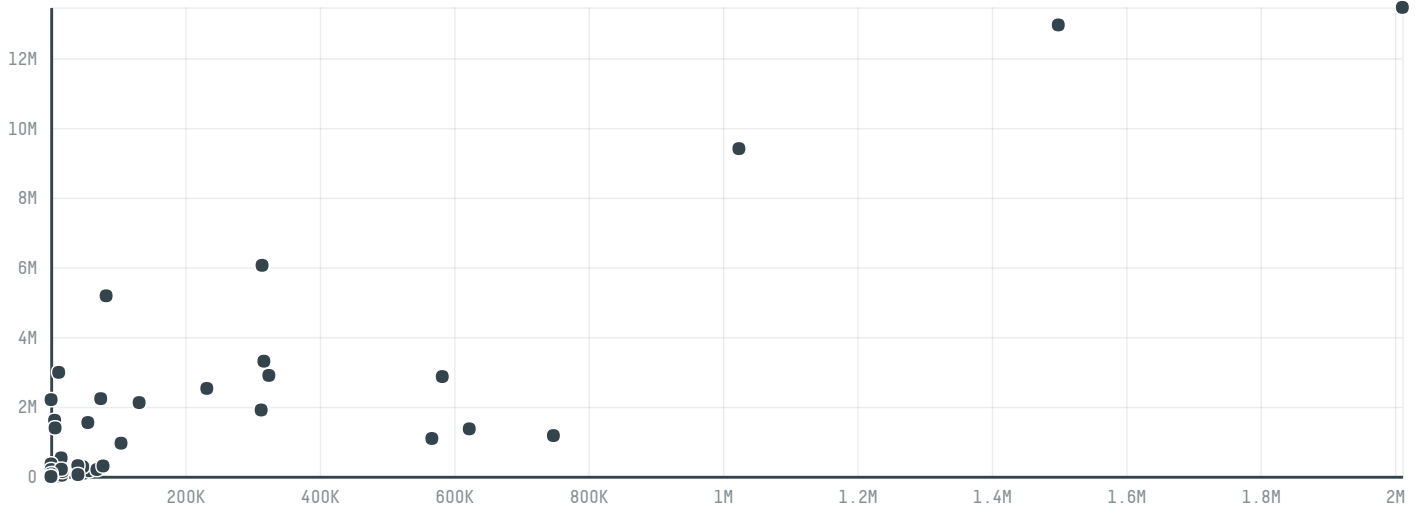
