## Bom Jesus agropecuaria

Bom Jesus agropecuaria was the 80th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 29 thousand tons. This is a 85% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, Bom Jesus agropecuaria sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by Bom Jesus agropecuaria is Netherlands, accounting for 91% of the total.

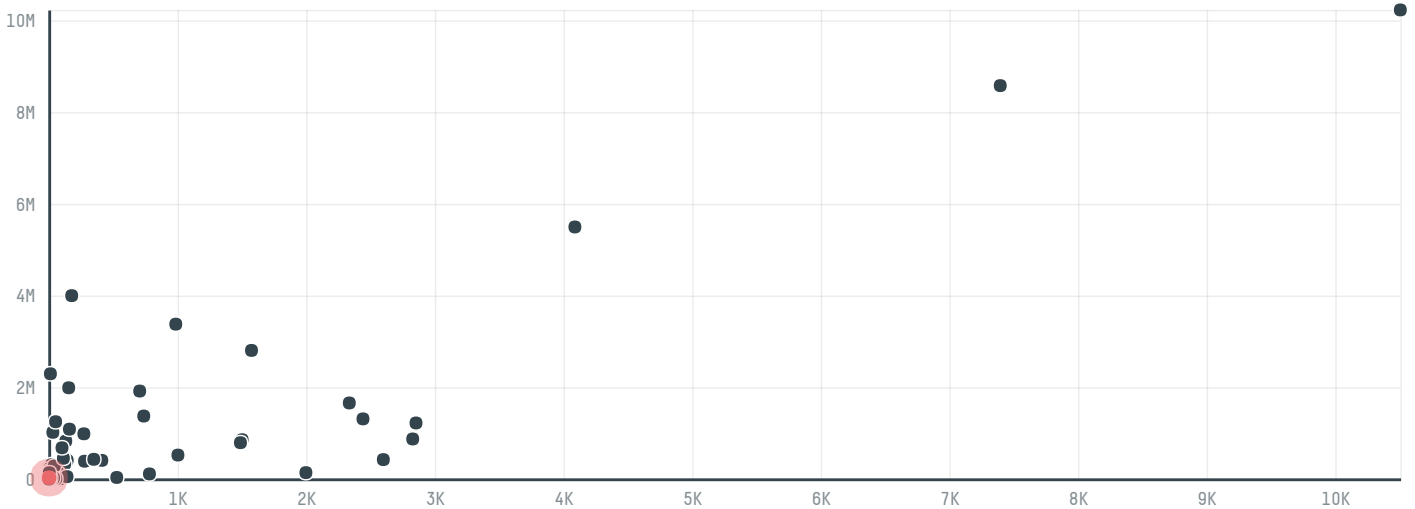
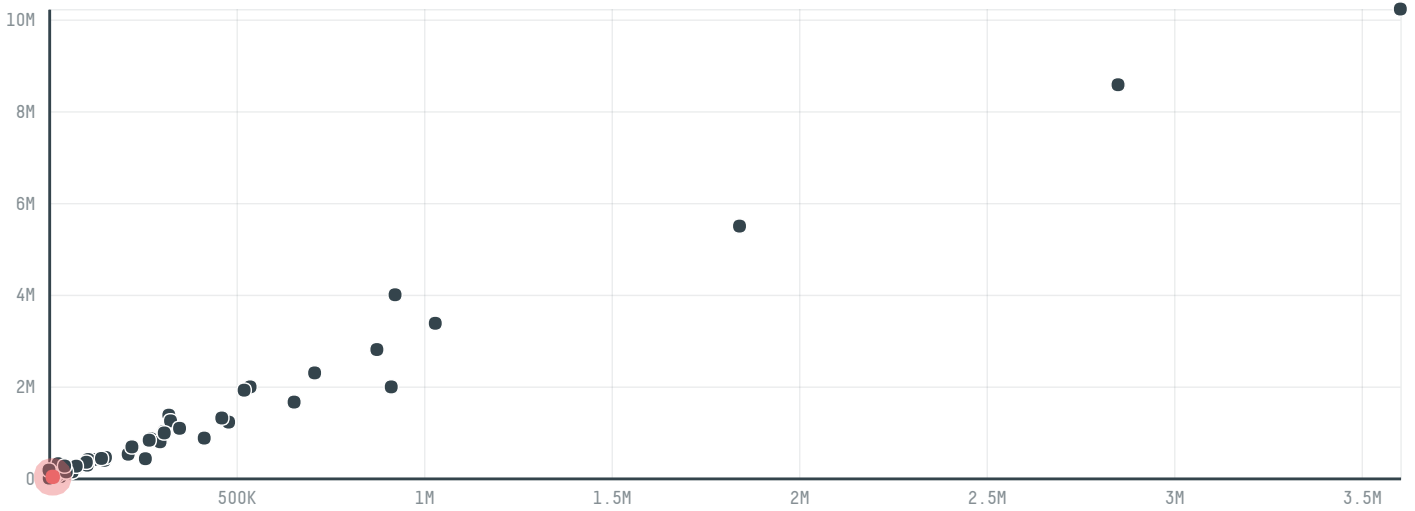
