

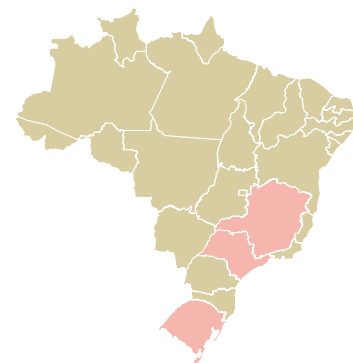
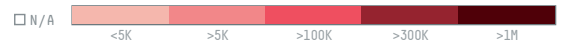
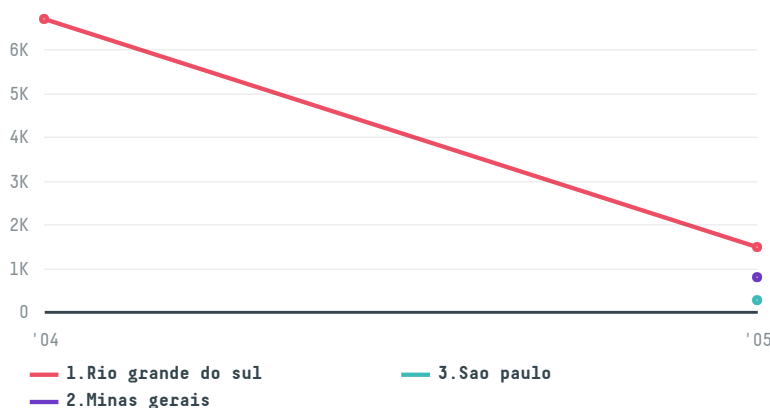
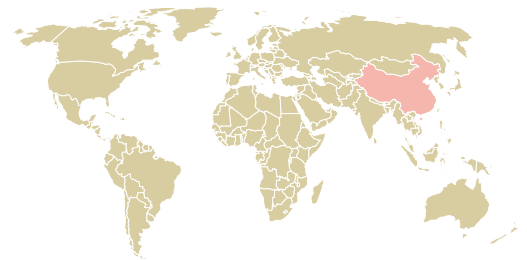
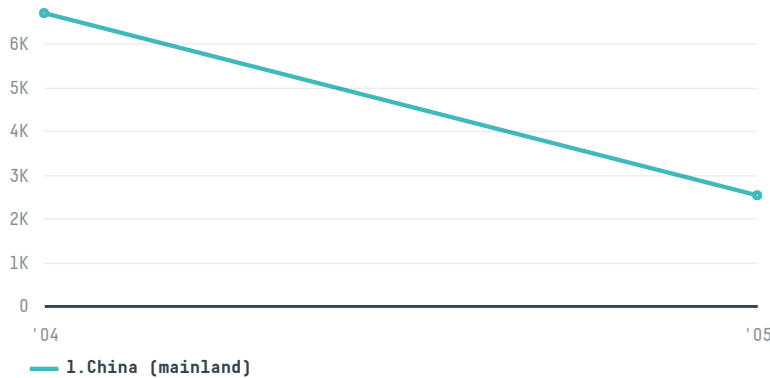


## Kuok oils and grains ltd

Kuok oils and grains ltd was the 89th largest importer of soy from BRAZIL in 2005, accounting for 3 thousand tons. This is a 62% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Kuok oils and grains ltd sources from 14 municipalities, or 1% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy imported by Kuok oils and grains ltd is China (mainland), accounting for 100% of the total.

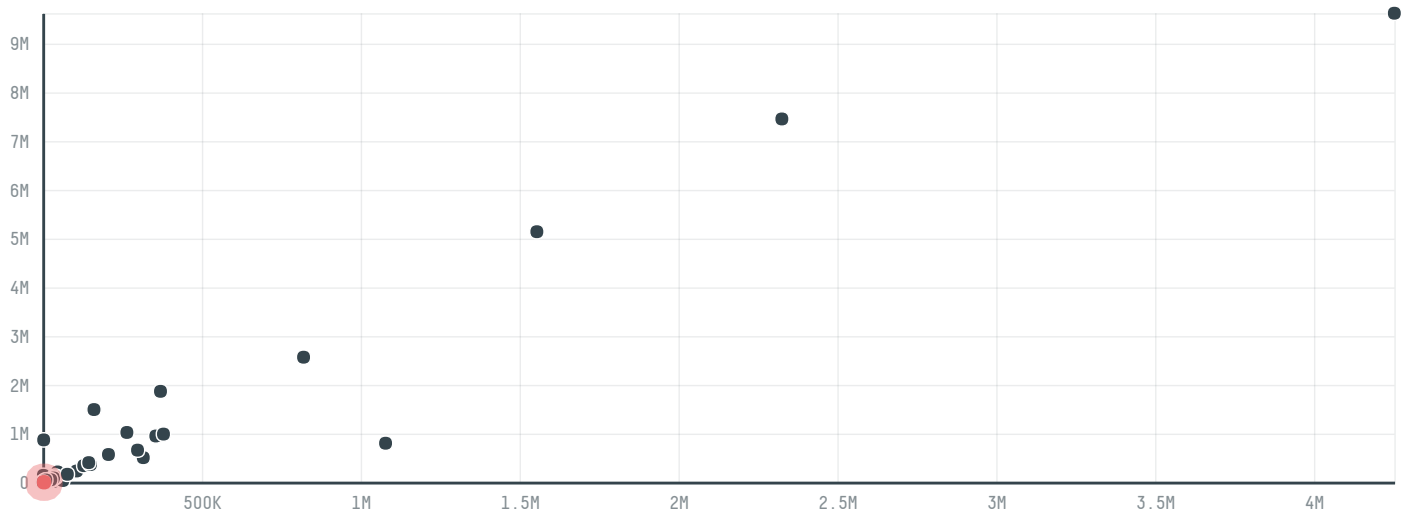

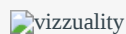
#### COMPARING COMPANIES IMPORTING SOY FROM BRAZIL IN 2005
