

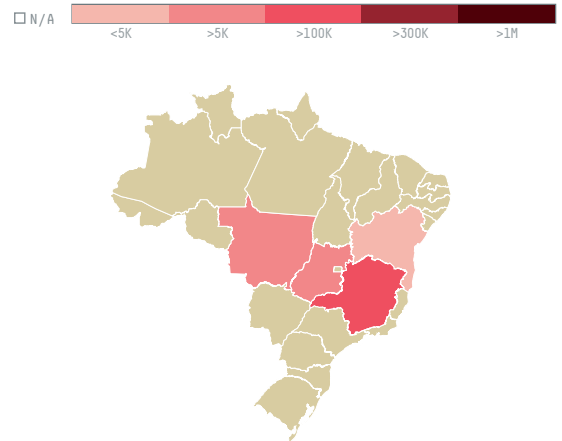
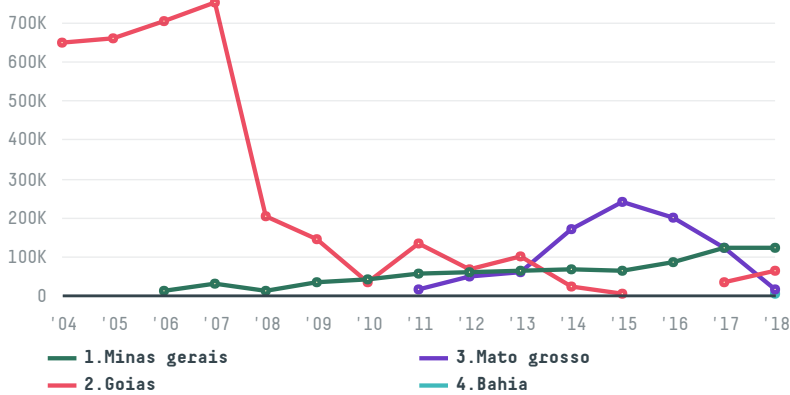
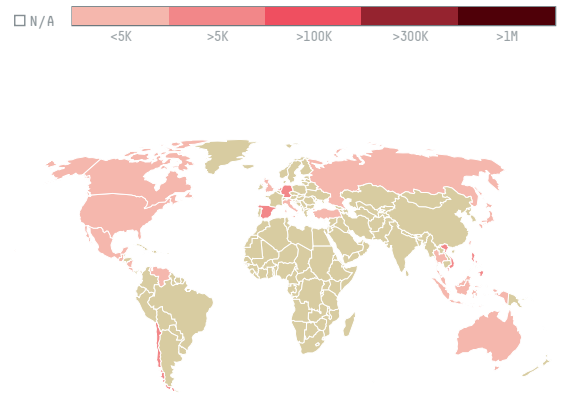
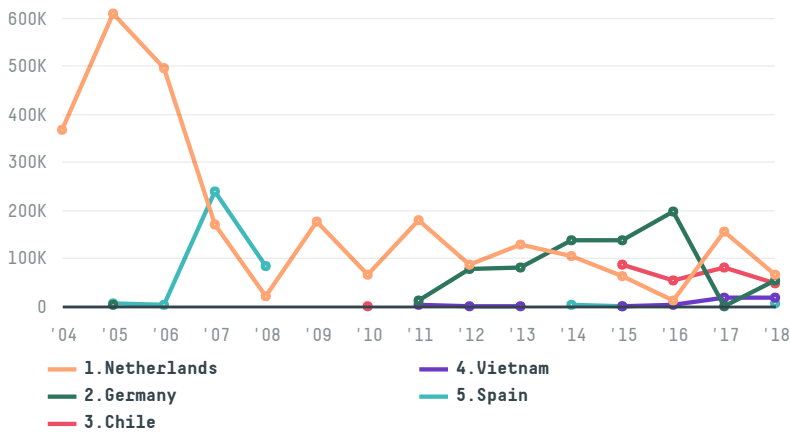


Selecta

Selecta was the 35th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 218 thousand tons. This is a 22% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, Selecta sources from 6 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by Selecta is Netherlands, accounting for 30% of the total.

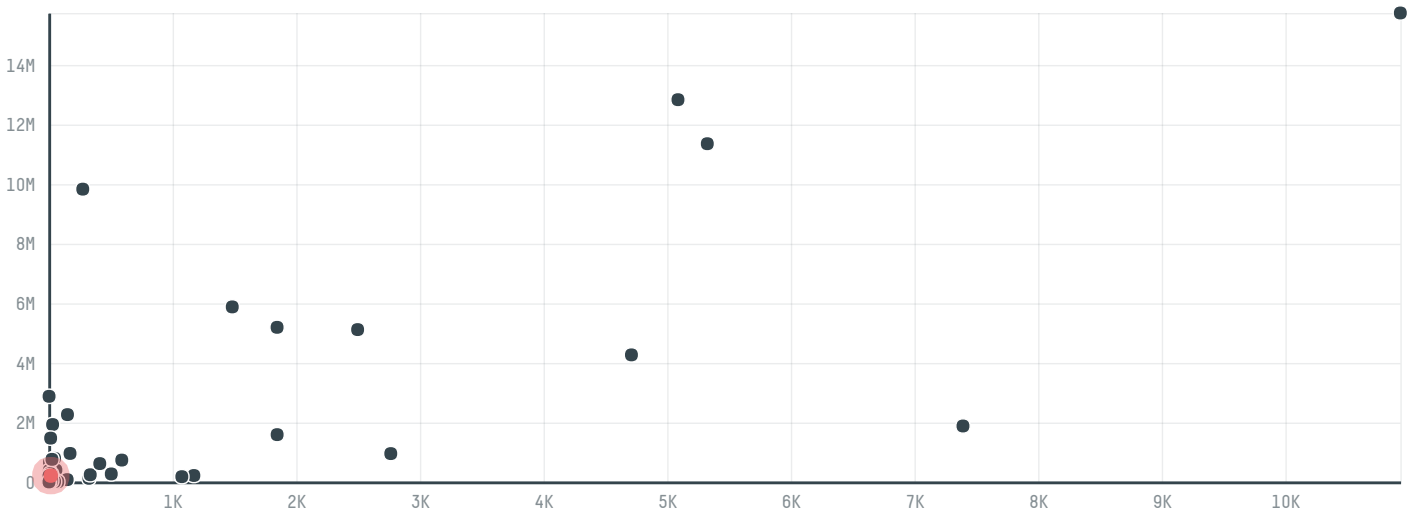
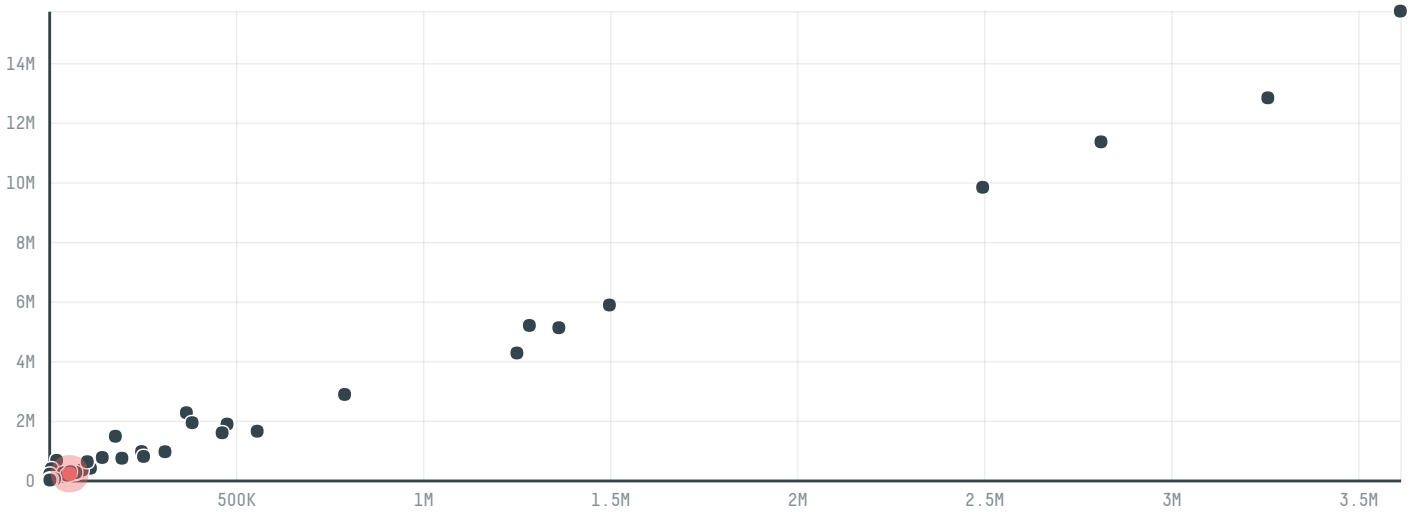

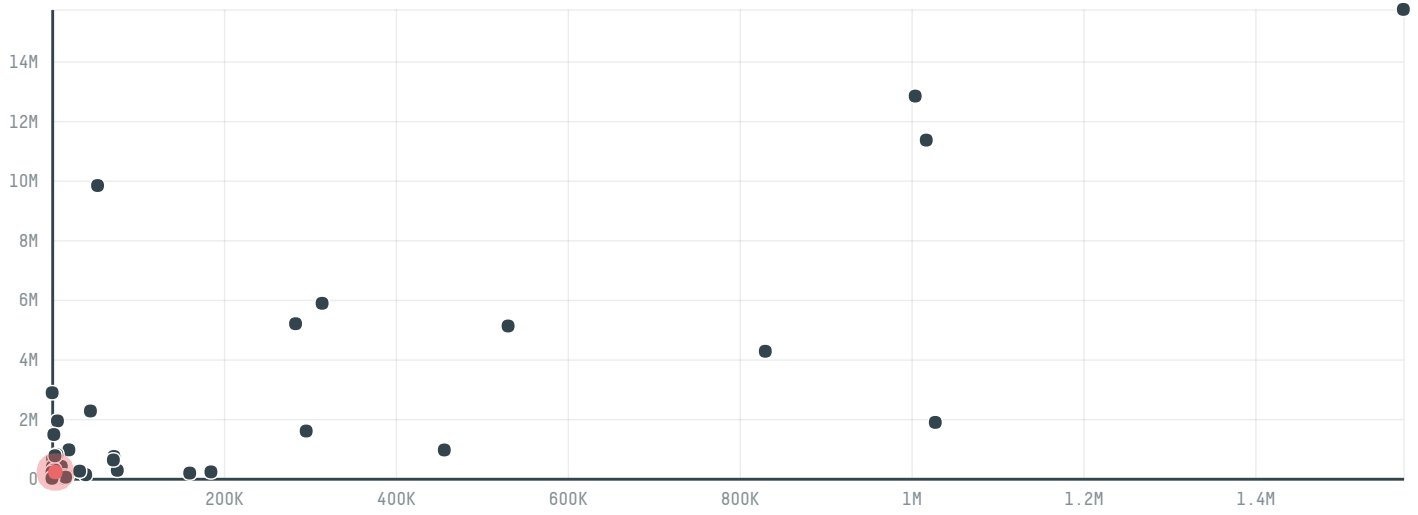
