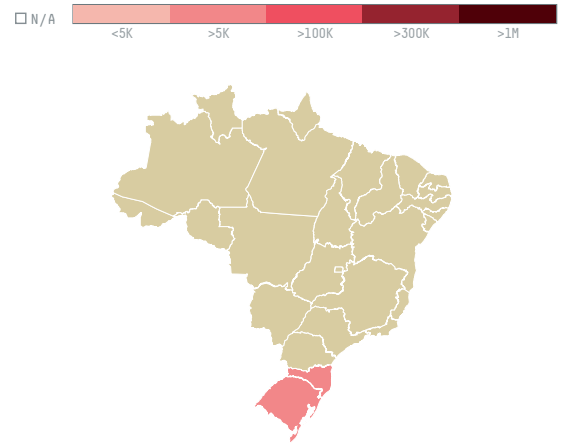
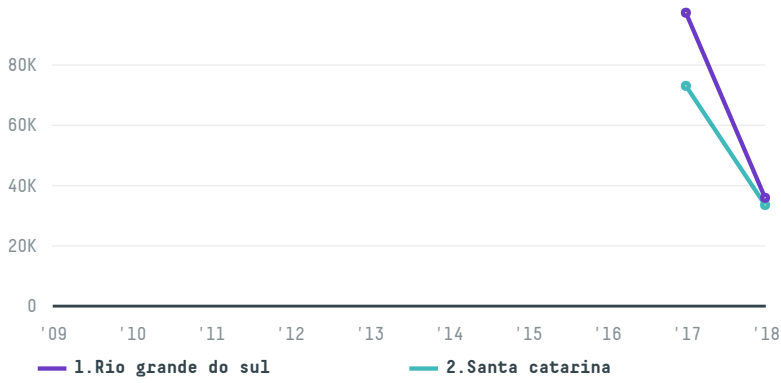
Lansing brasil comercial & exportadora de produtos agricolas

Lansing brasil comercial & exportadora de produtos agricolas was the 39th largest importer of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 74 thousand tons. This is a 62% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Lansing brasil comercial & exportadora de produtos agricolas sources from 38 municipalities, or 2% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy imported by Lansing brasil comercial & exportadora de produtos agricolas is China (mainland), accounting for 100% of the total.

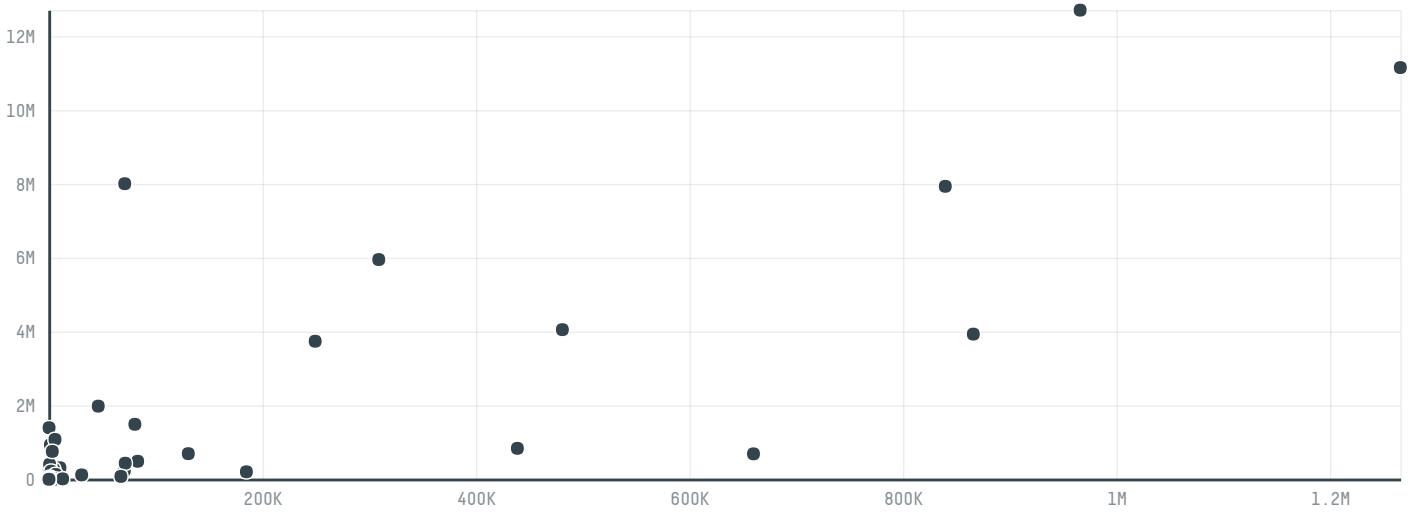
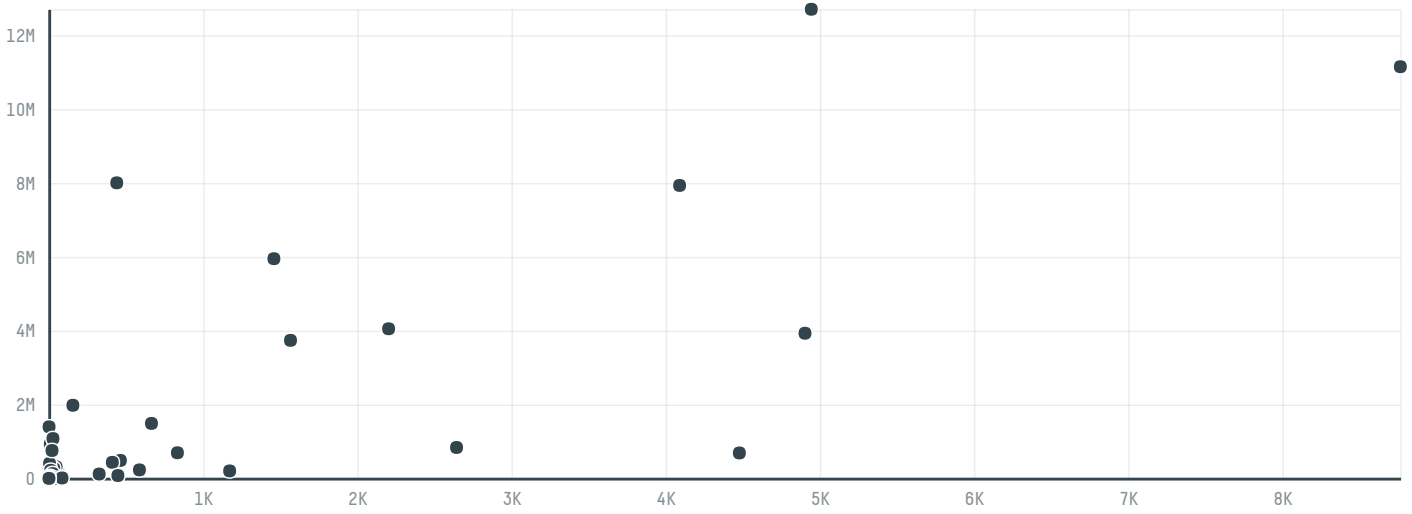
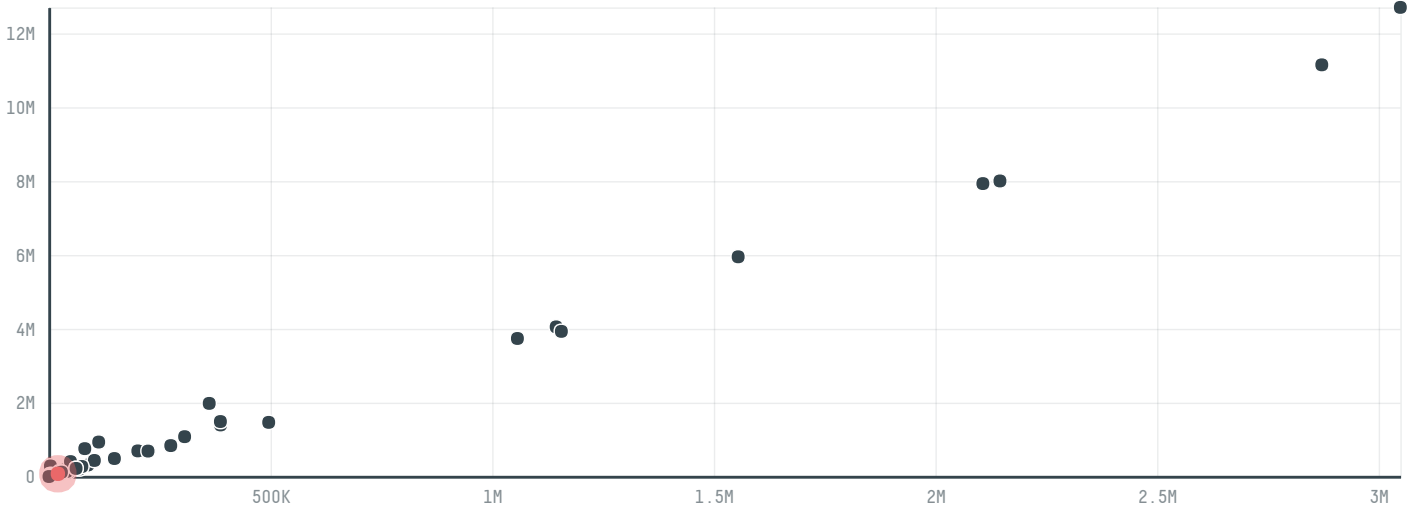
