



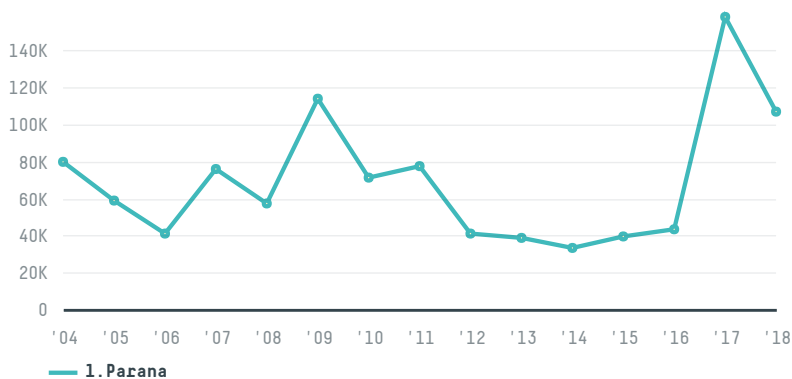
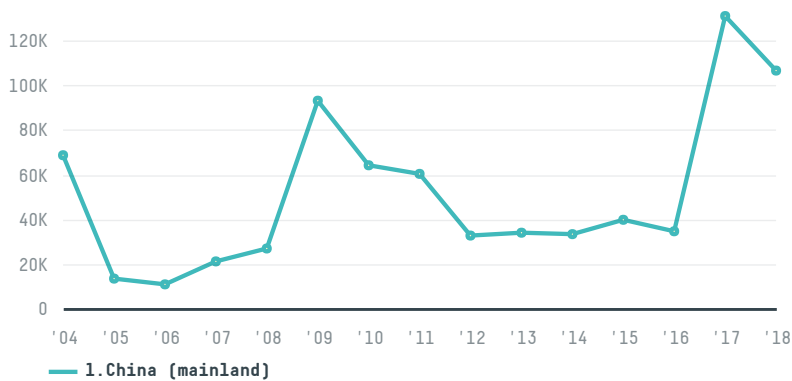

Moinho iguacu agroindustrial was the 55th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 107 thousand tons. This is a 32% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, Moinho iguacu agroindustrial sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by Moinho iguacu agroindustrial is China (mainland), accounting for 100% of the total.

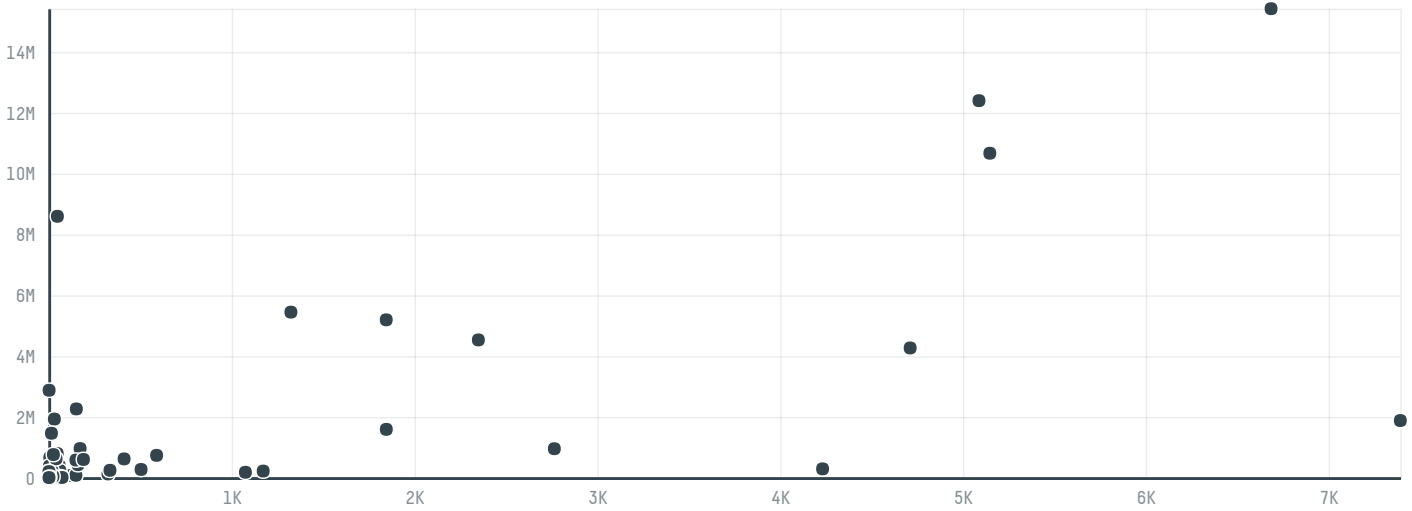
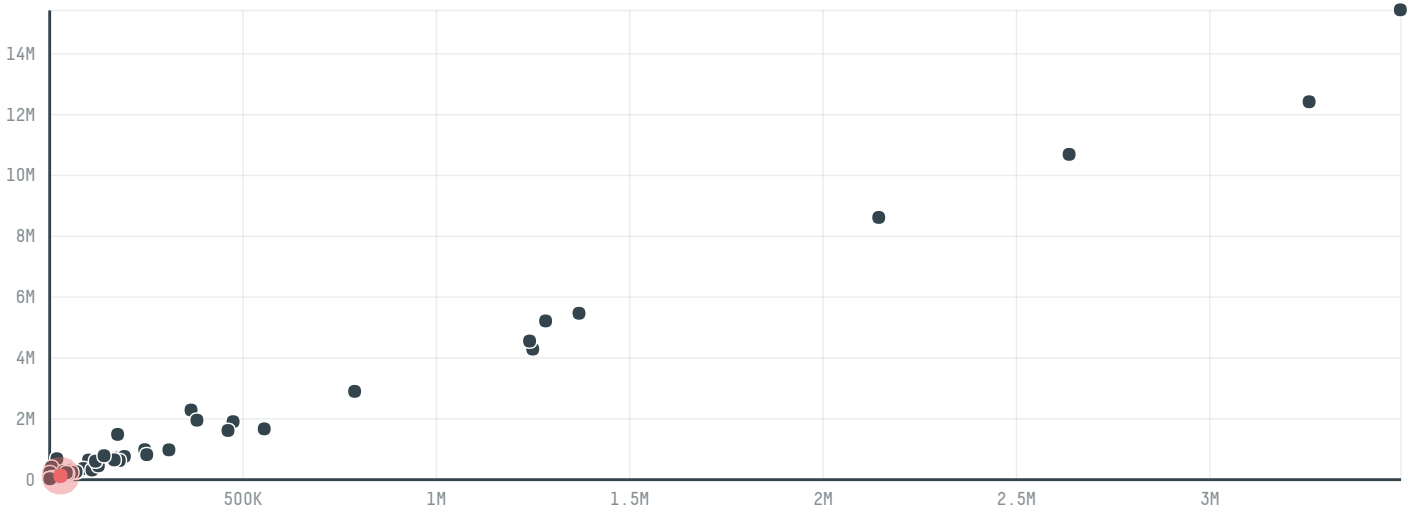
