



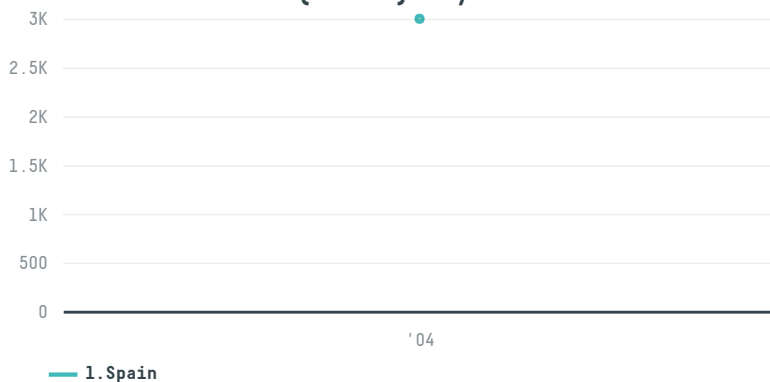

### TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF SOY IMPORTED BY SUMITOMO CORPORATIO(TOKYO) 04/0323:

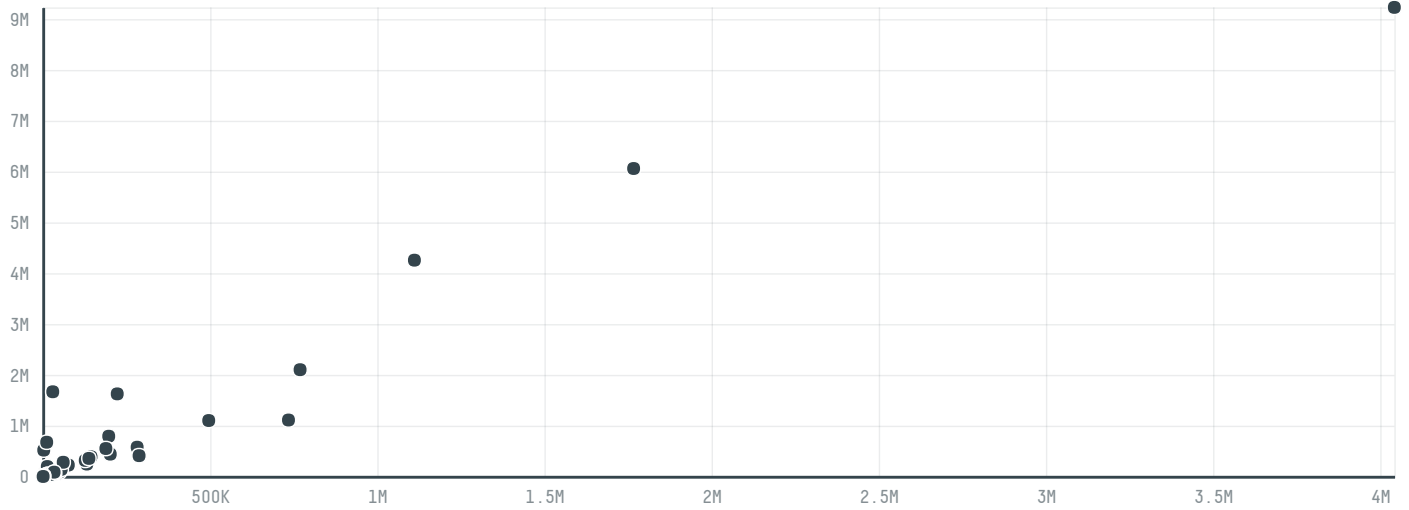
