



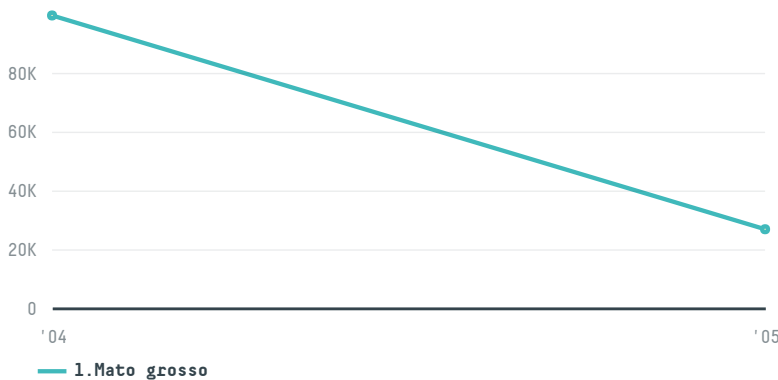
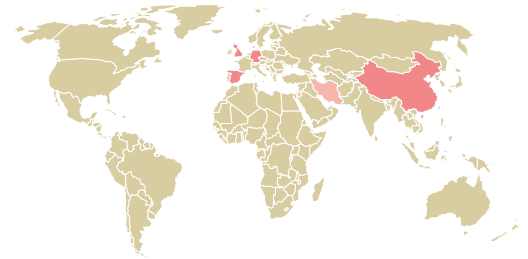
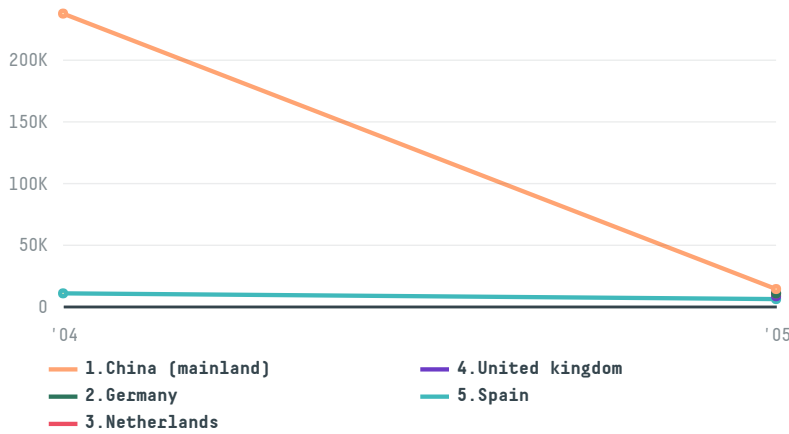

Conagra trade group was the 41st largest importer of soy from BRAZIL in 2005, accounting for 49 thousand tons. This is a 83% decrease vs the previous year. The main destination of the soy imported by Conagra trade group is China (mainland), accounting for 28% of the total.

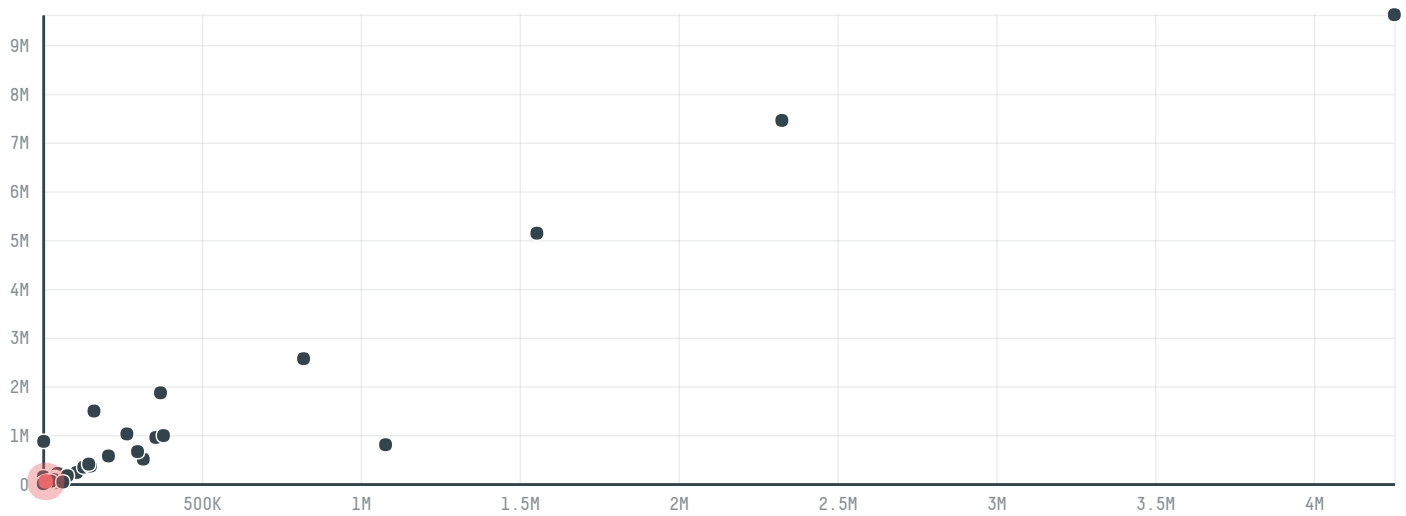
