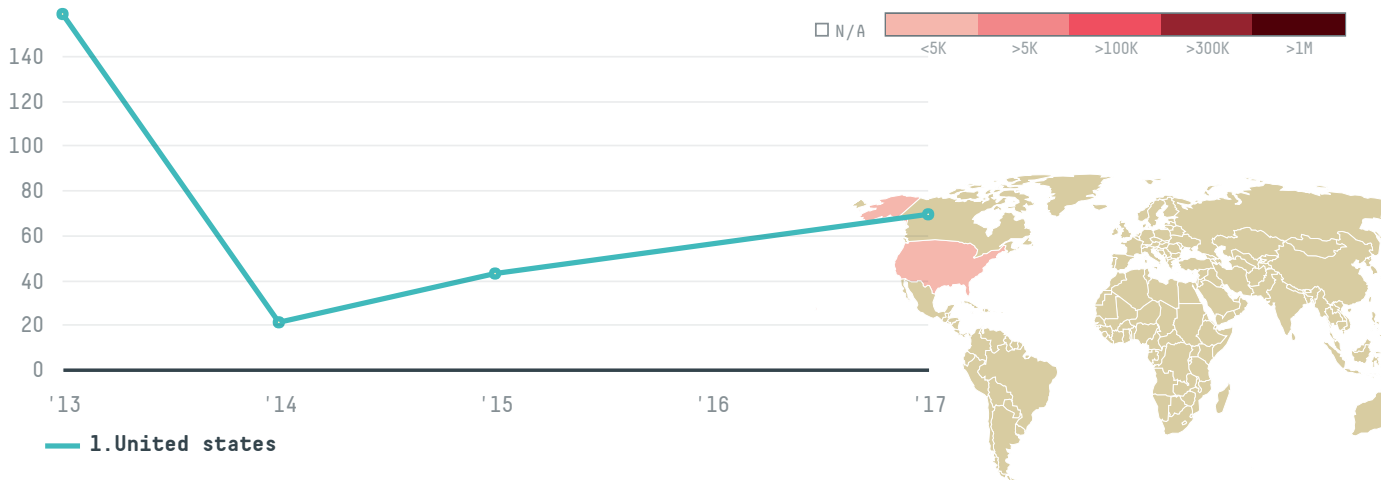
## Harvest valley

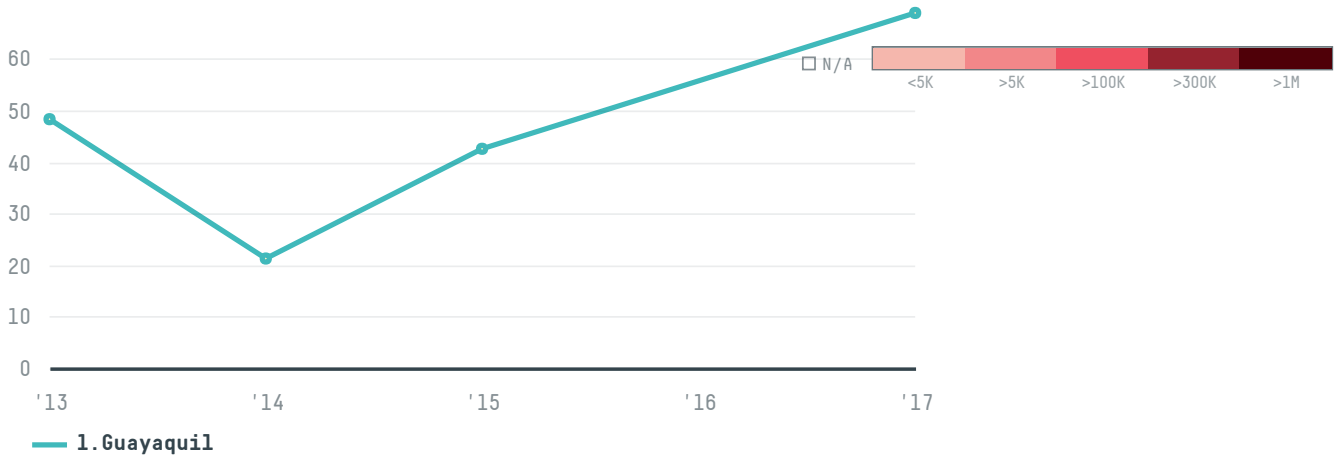
Harvest valley was the 502nd largest importer of shrimp from ECUADOR in 2017, accounting for 69 tons. As an importer, Harvest valley sources from 1 parishes, or 2% of the shrimp production parishes. The main destination of the shrimp imported by Harvest valley is United states, accounting for 100% of the total.
