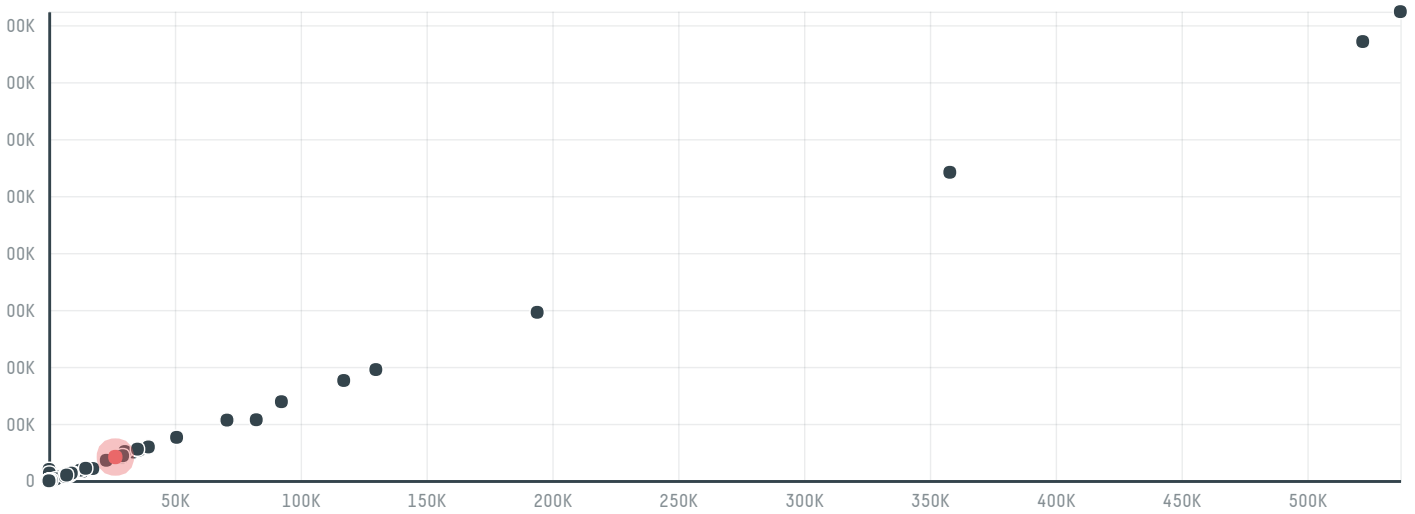
Jbs s/a was the 6th largest exporter of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 47 thousand tons. This is a 17977% increase vs the previous year. As an exporter, Jbs s/a sources from 16 municipalities, or 5% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork exported by Jbs s/a is United states, accounting for 30% of the total.
