Tottus s a was the 813th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 210 tons. This is a 403% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, Tottus s a sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Tottus s a is Peru, accounting for 60% of the total.

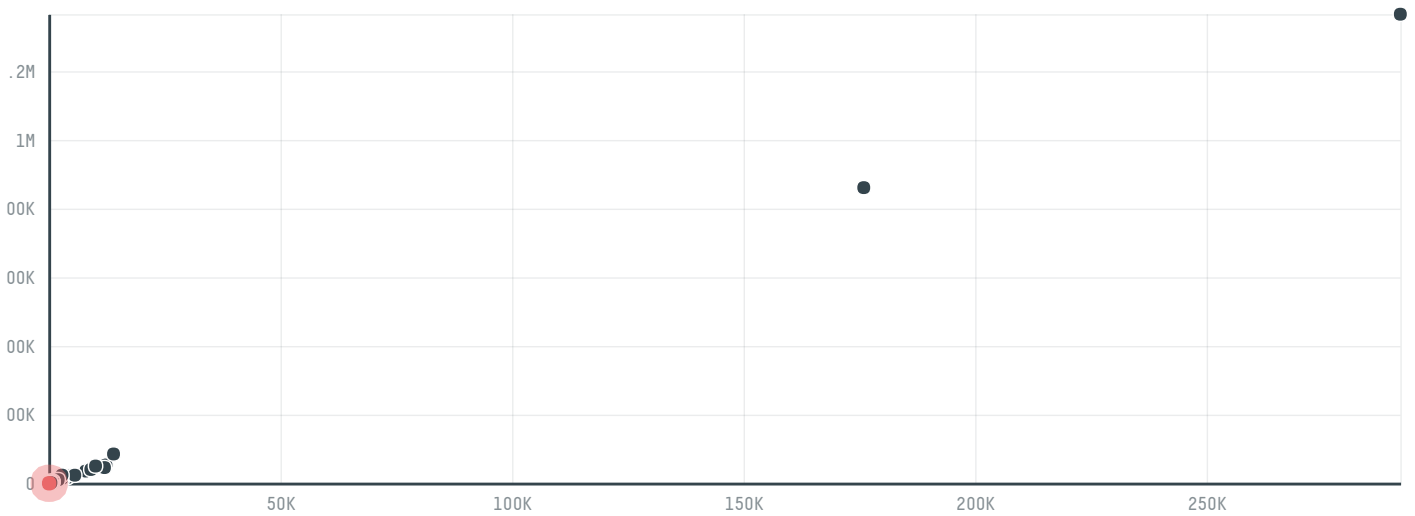
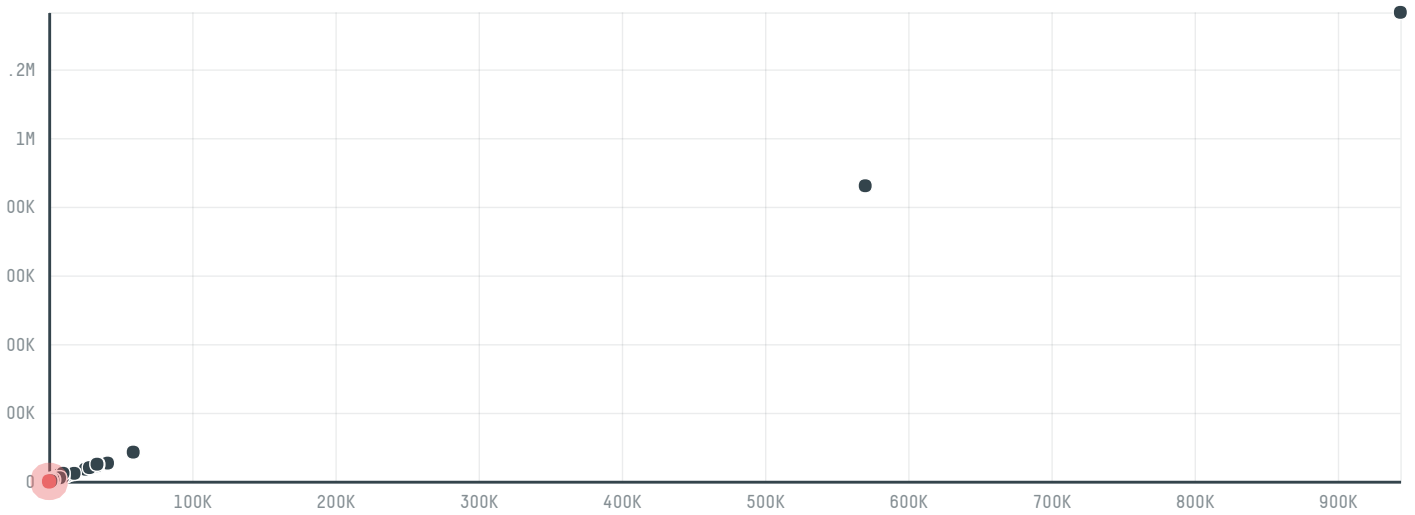
