



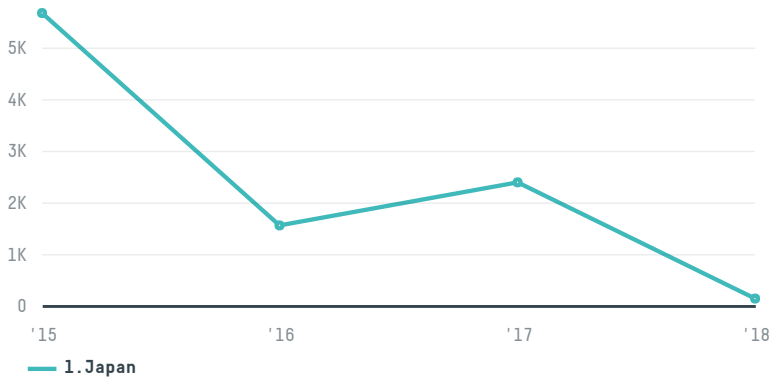

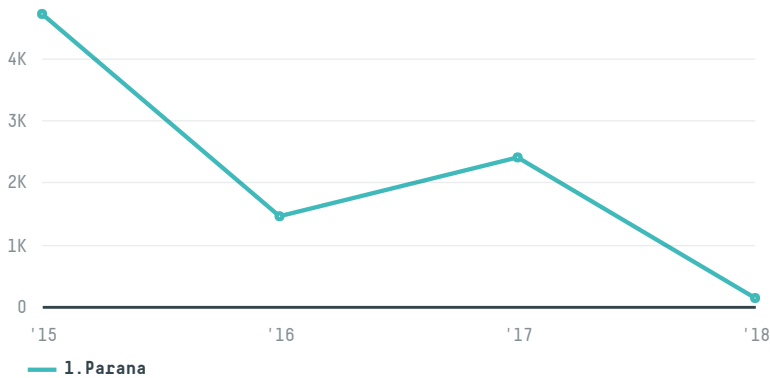

Japan food corporation was the 396th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 143 tons. This is a 94% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Japan food corporation sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Japan food corporation is Japan, accounting for 100% of the total.

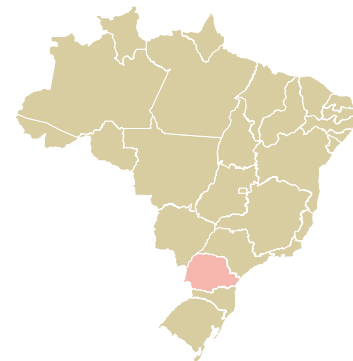
TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN IMPORTED BY JAPAN FOOD CORPORATION:

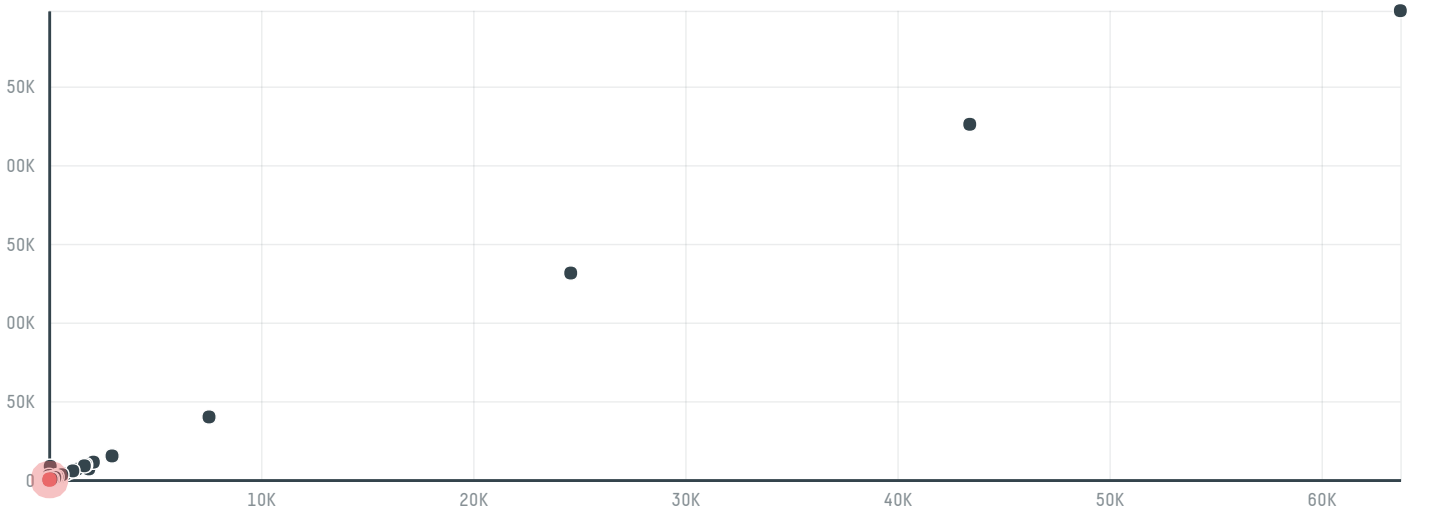
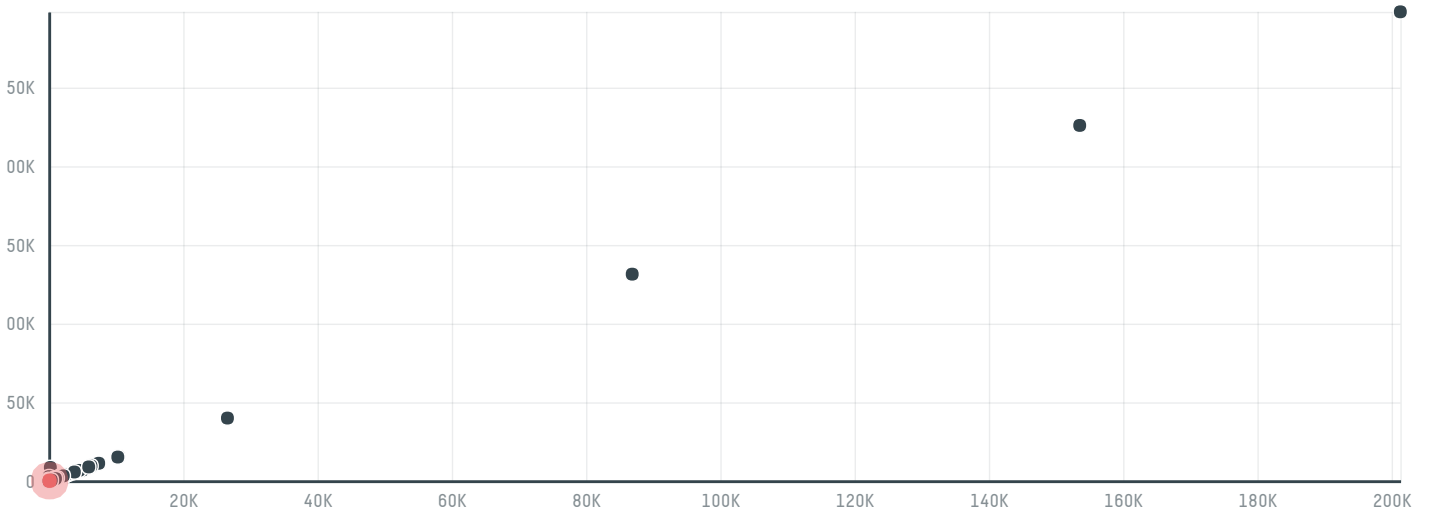
