## Ooo "lear-product"

Ooo "lear-product" was the 1442nd largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 26 tons. This is a 80% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Ooo "lear-product" sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Ooo "lear-product" is Russian federation, accounting for 100% of the total.

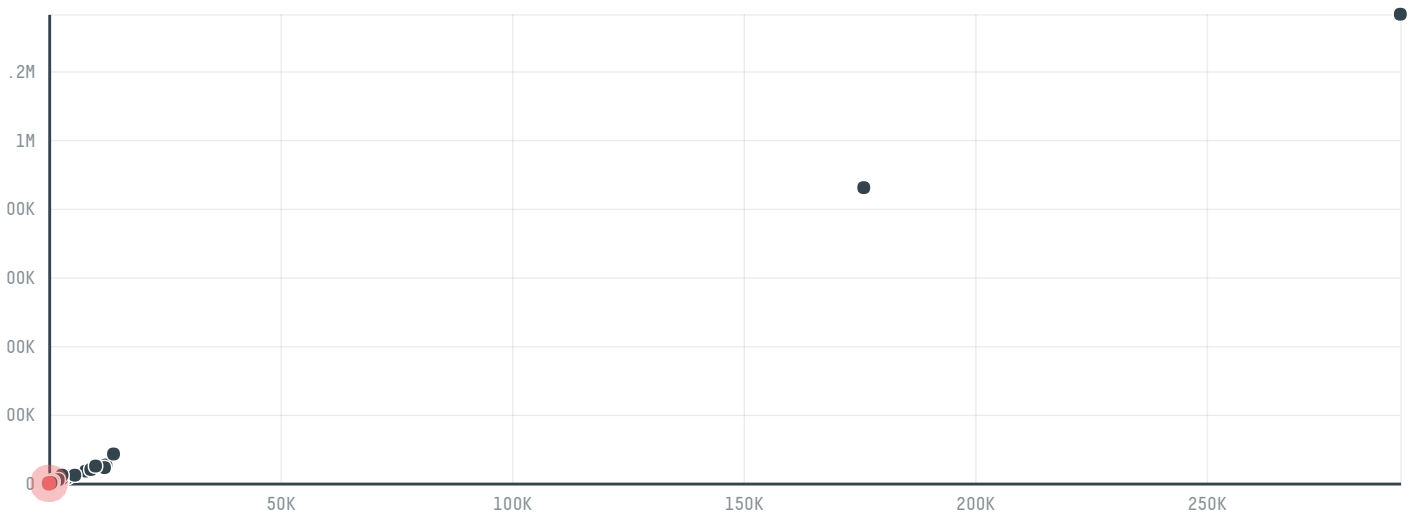
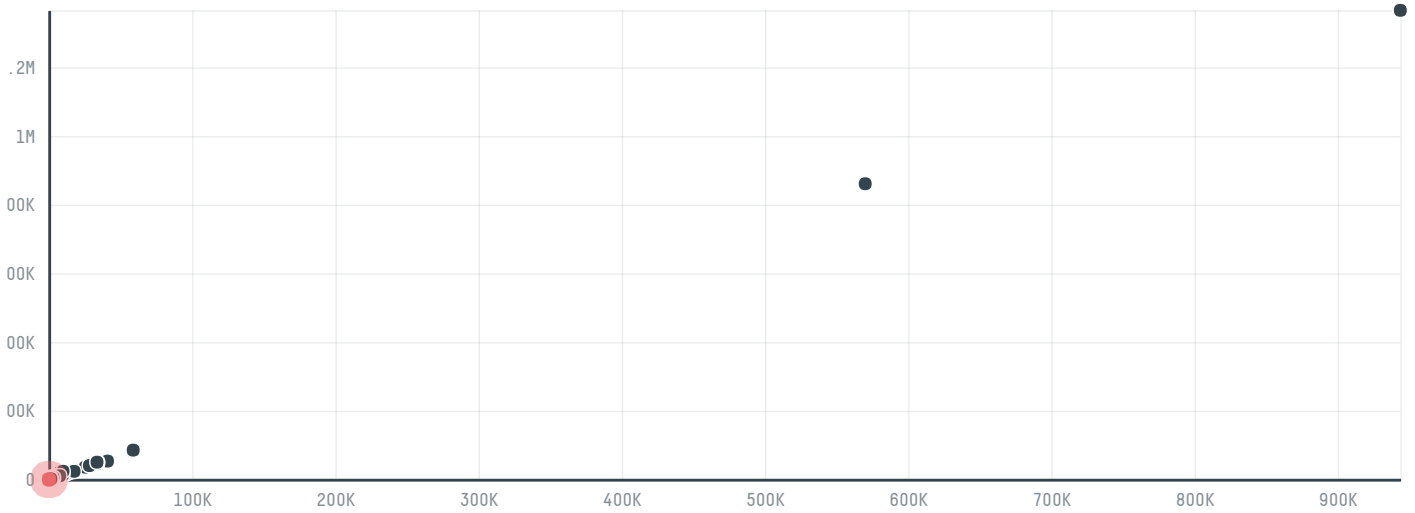
