

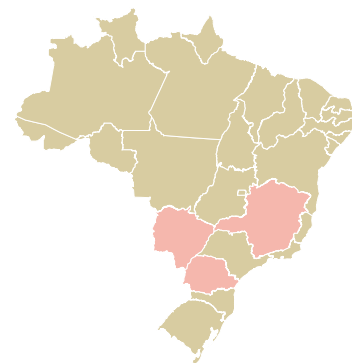
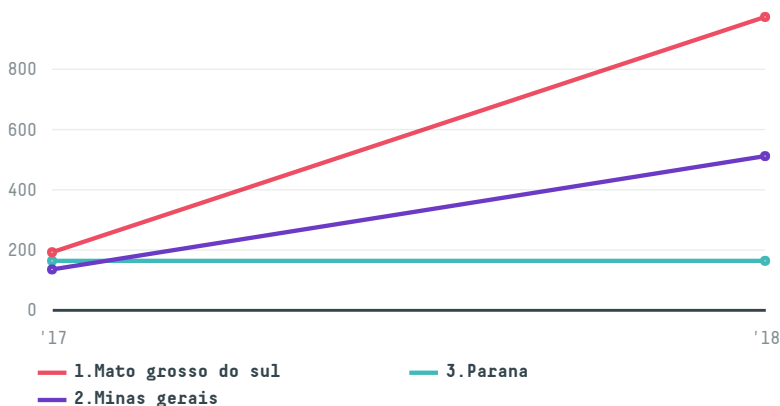
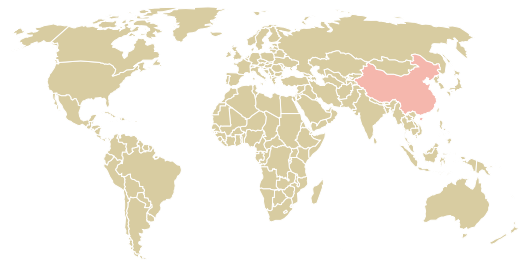
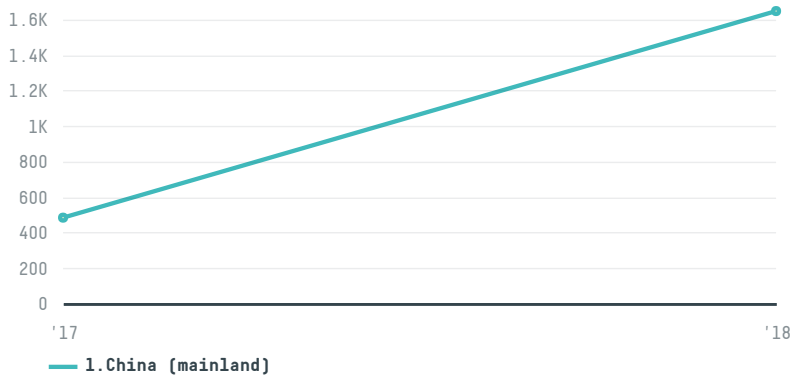


Hfg asia

Hfg asia was the 60th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 2 thousand tons. This is a 222% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, Hfg asia sources from 6 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Hfg asia is China (mainland), accounting for 100% of the total.

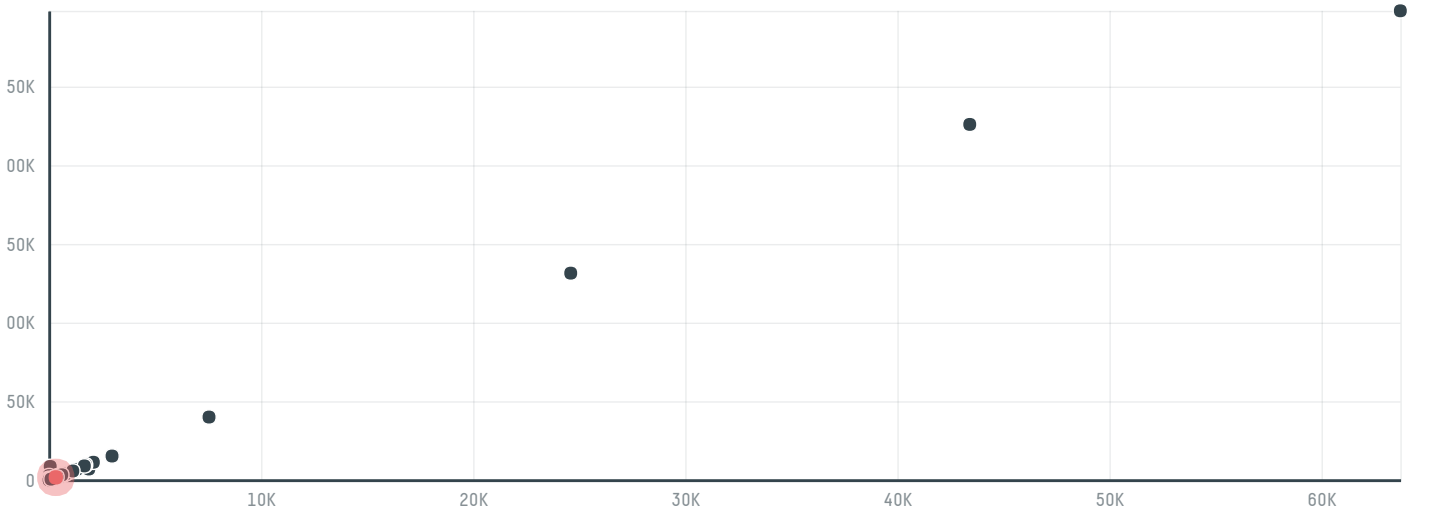
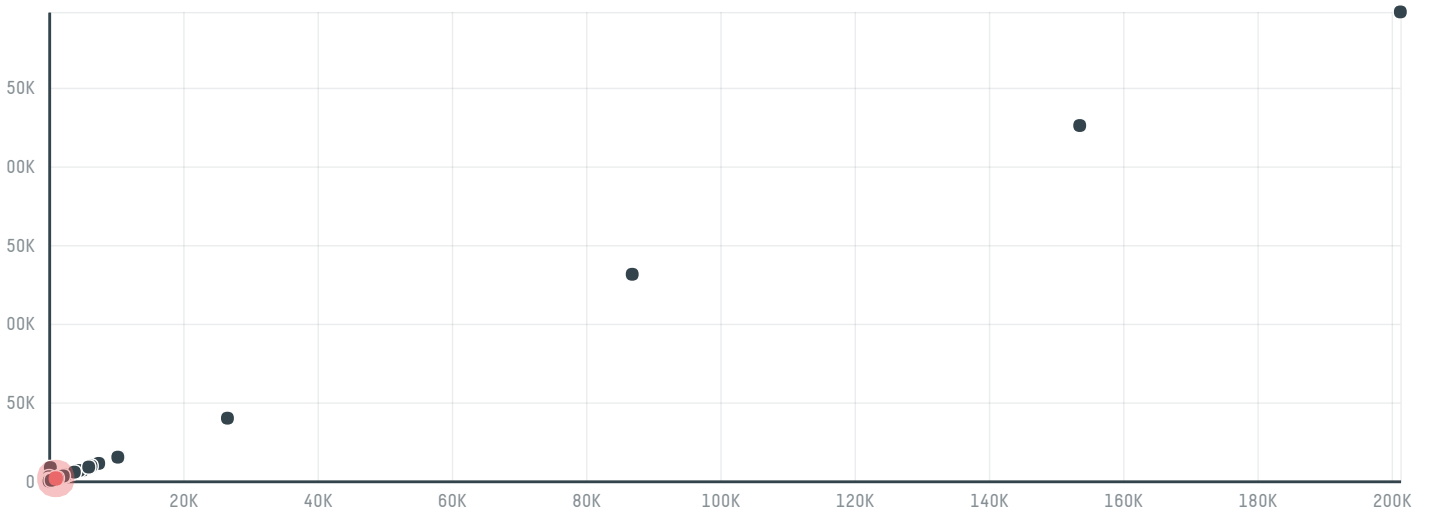
