



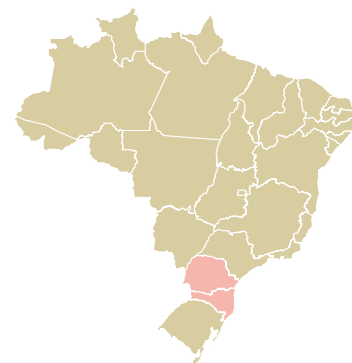
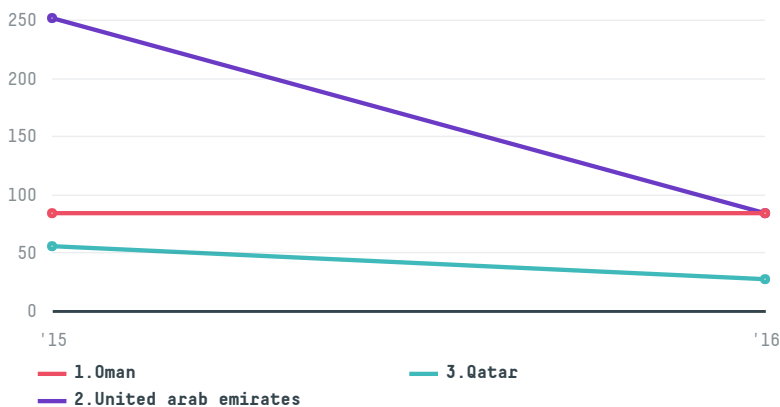

Ess-food a s was the 835th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 195 tons. This is a 54% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Ess-food a s sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Ess-food a s is Oman, accounting for 43% of the total.

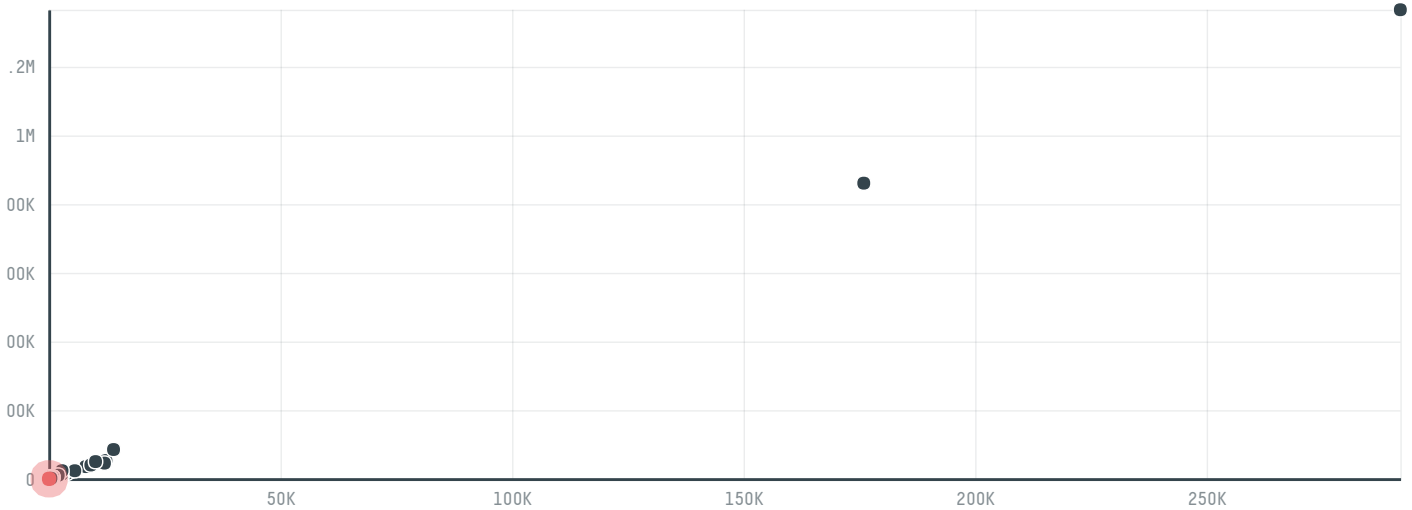
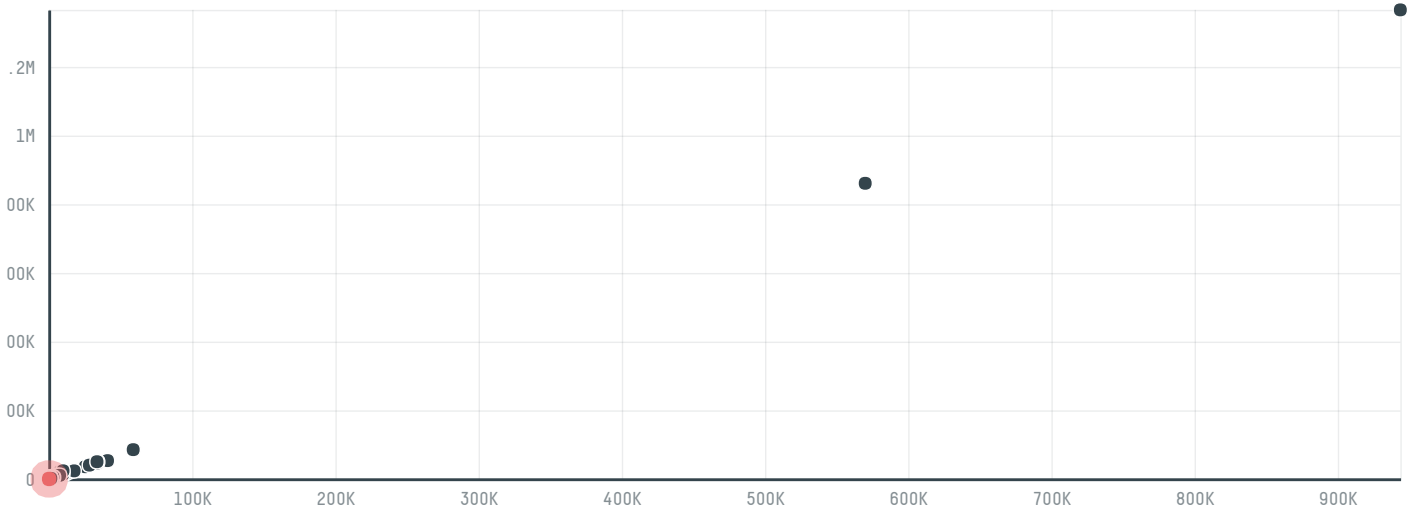
