As an importer, Alternatives food corp sources from 6 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Alternatives food corp is Philippines, accounting for 100% of the total.

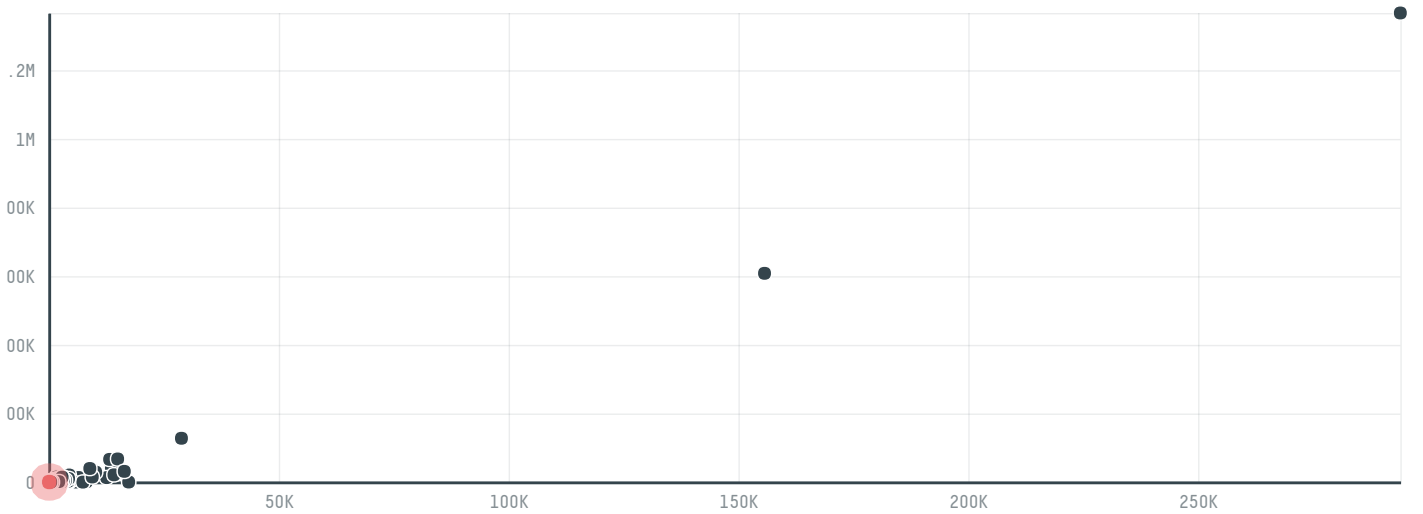
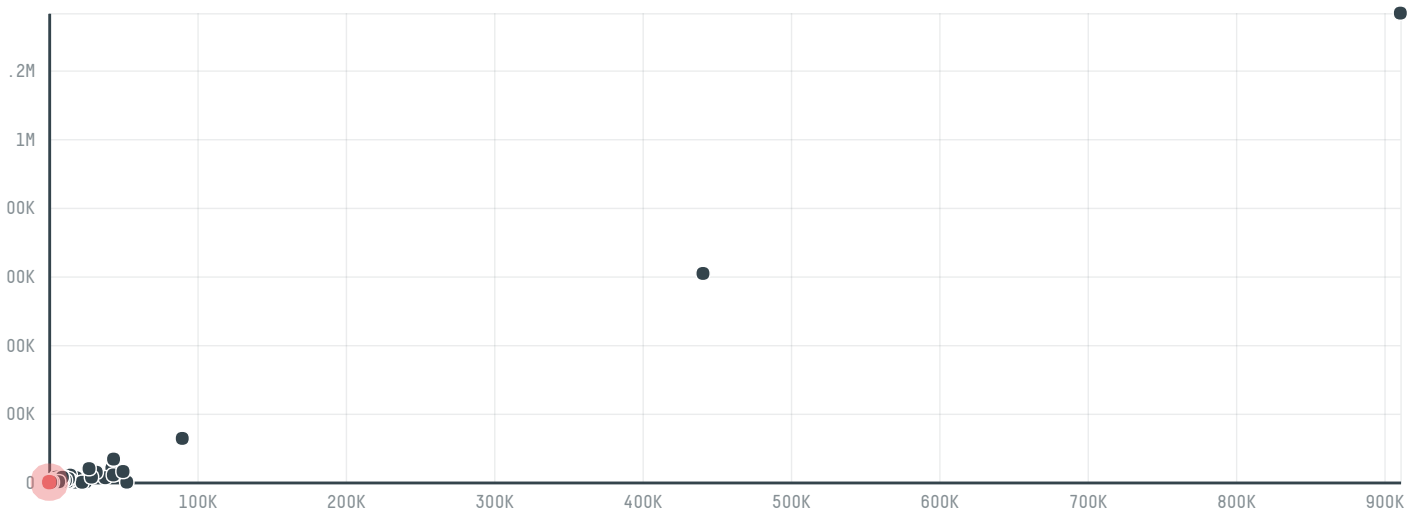
