



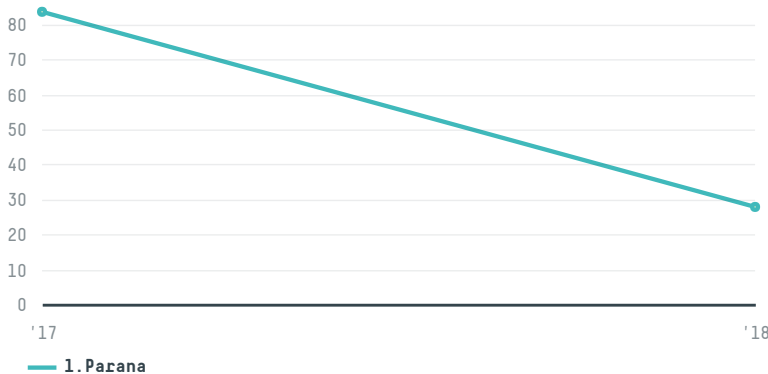
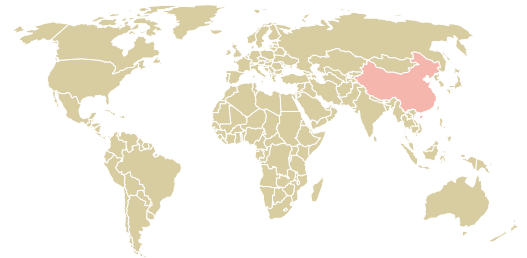
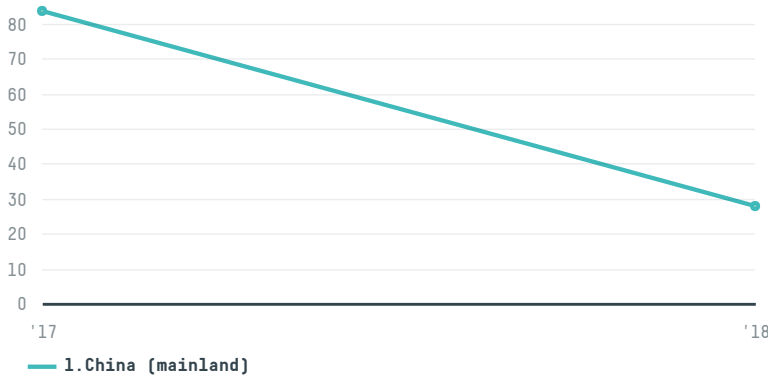

Shenzhen hongpeng imp. & exp. co., was the 684th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 28 tons. This is a 67% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Shenzhen hongpeng imp. & exp. co., sources from 3 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Shenzhen hongpeng imp. & exp. co., is China (mainland), accounting for 100% of the total.

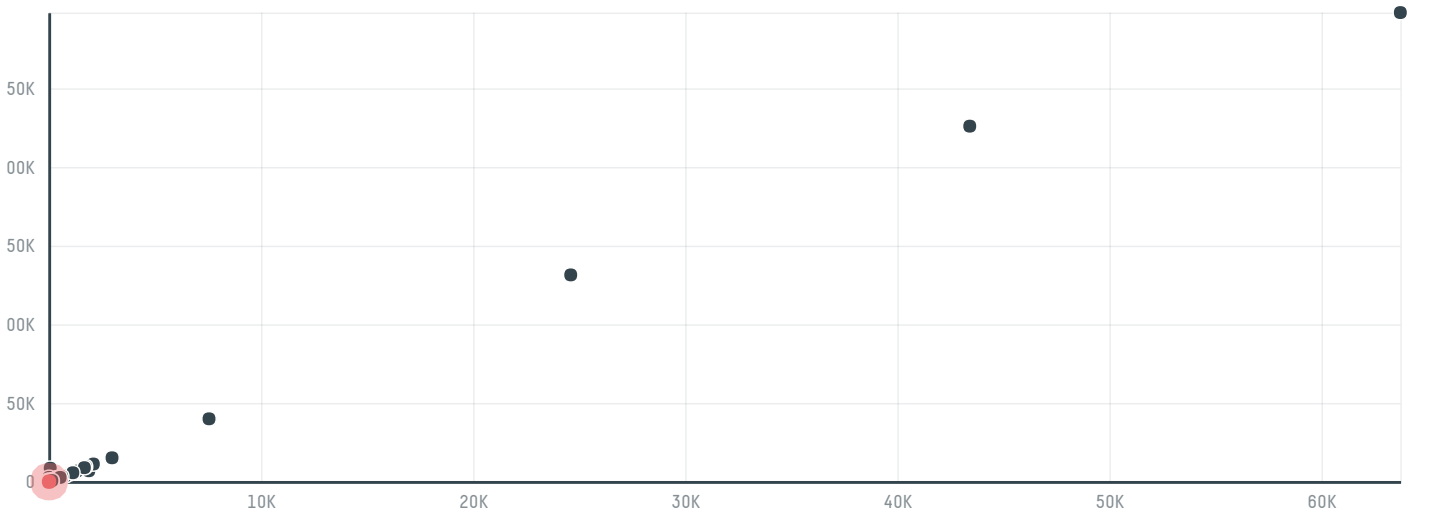
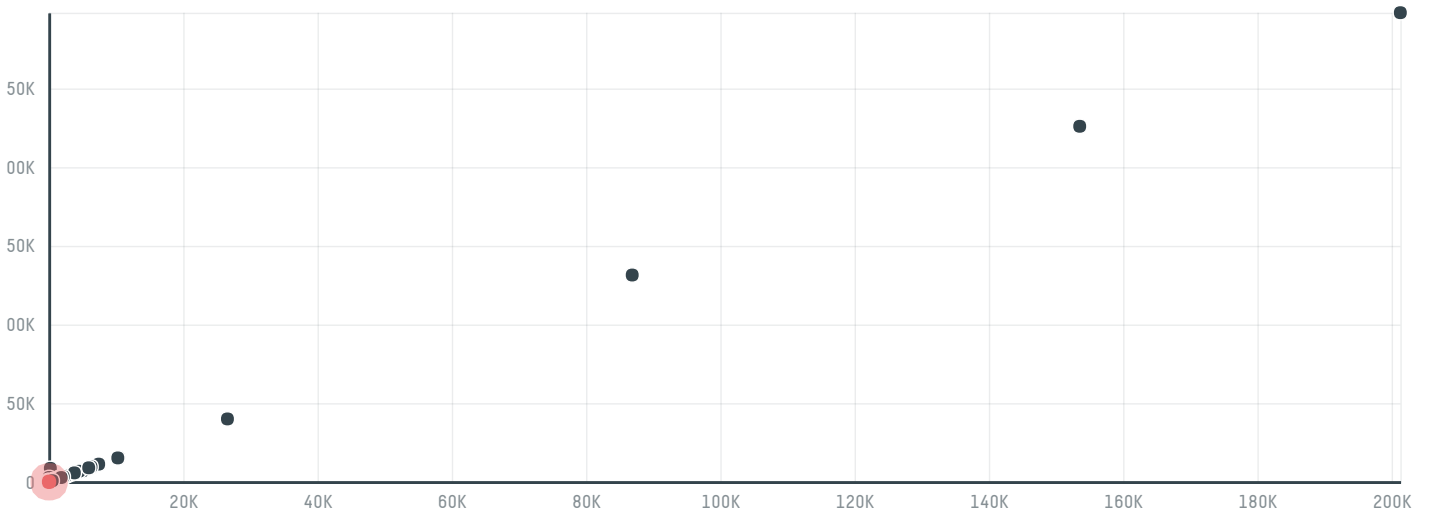
