



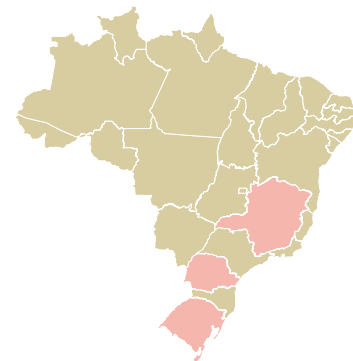
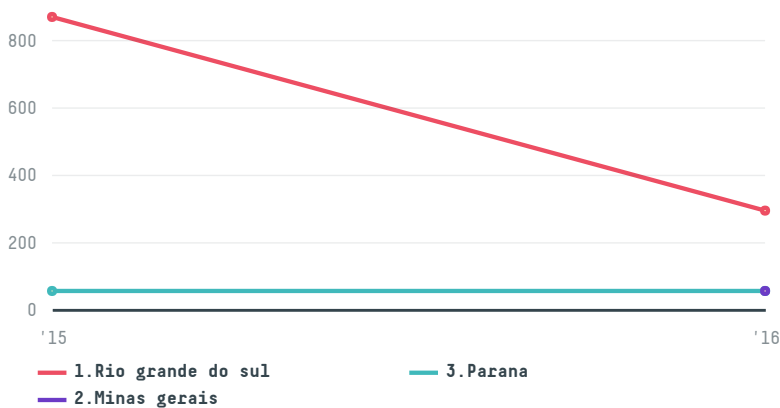
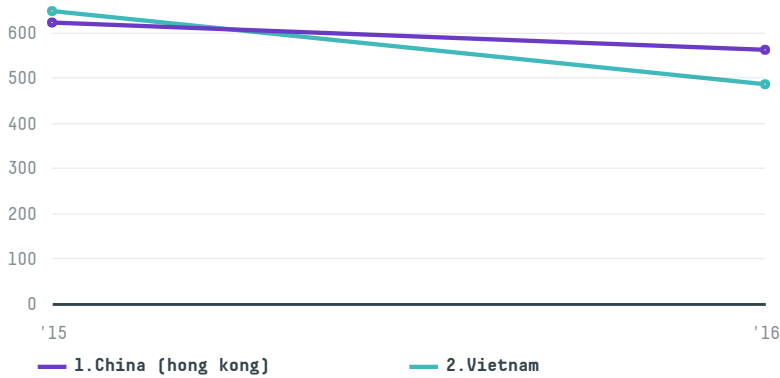

Friendly foods limited was the 290th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2016, accounting for 1 thousand tons. This is a 17% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Friendly foods limited sources from 7 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Friendly foods limited is China (hong kong), accounting for 54% of the total.

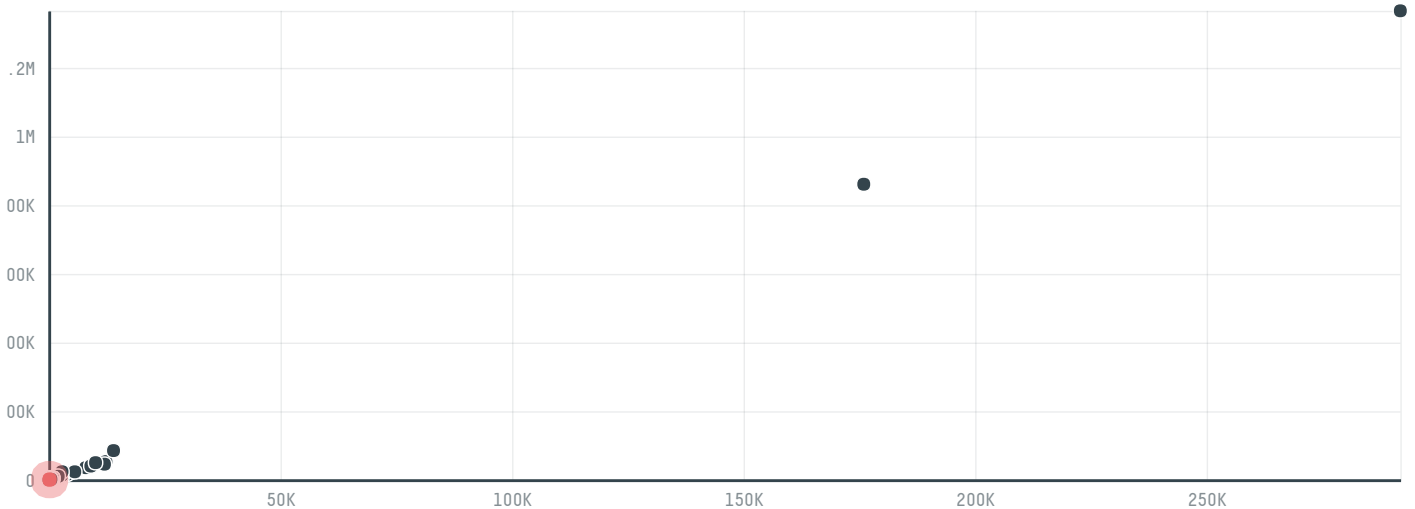
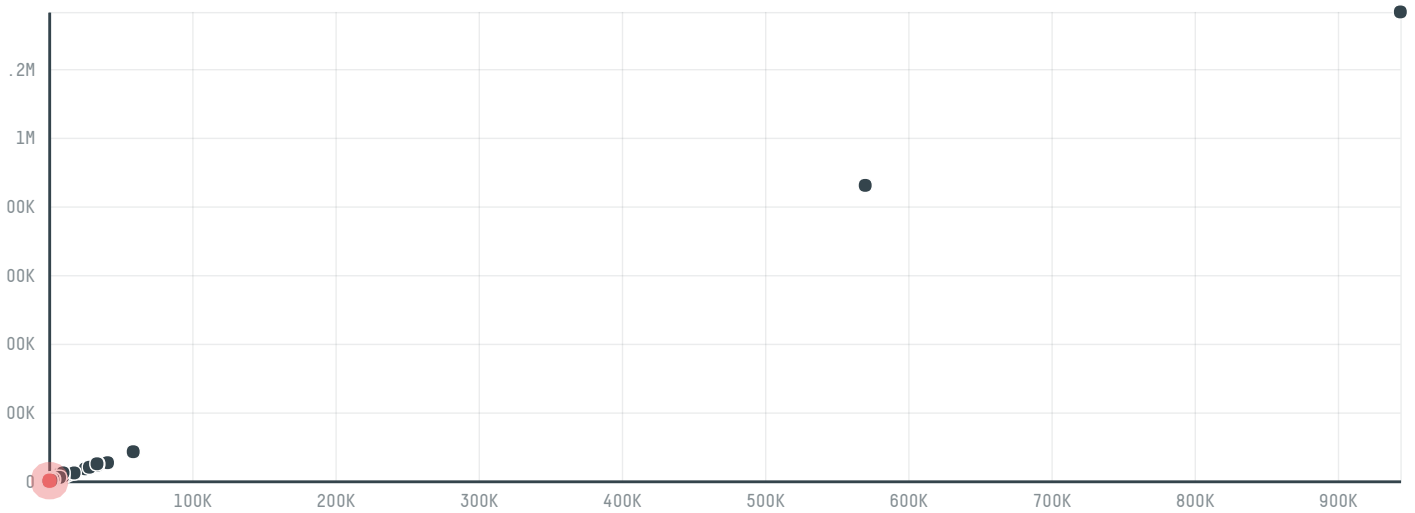
