Mondial foods b.v was the 701st largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 203 tons. This is a 3% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Mondial foods b.v sources from 7 municipalities, or 2% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Mondial foods b.v is Philippines, accounting for 51% of the total.

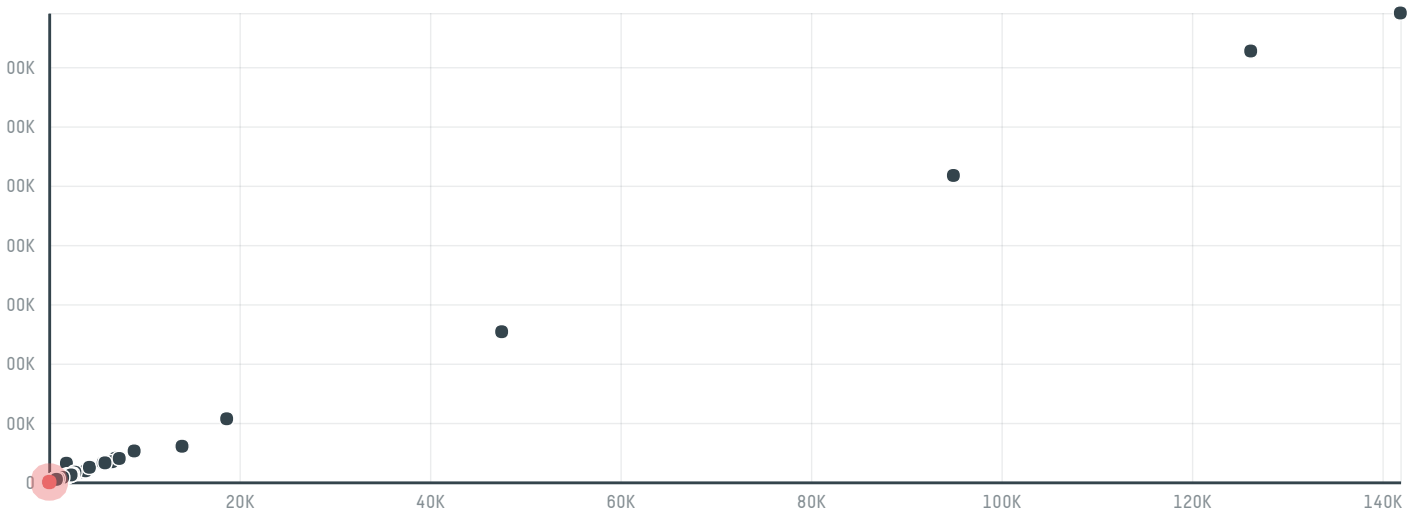
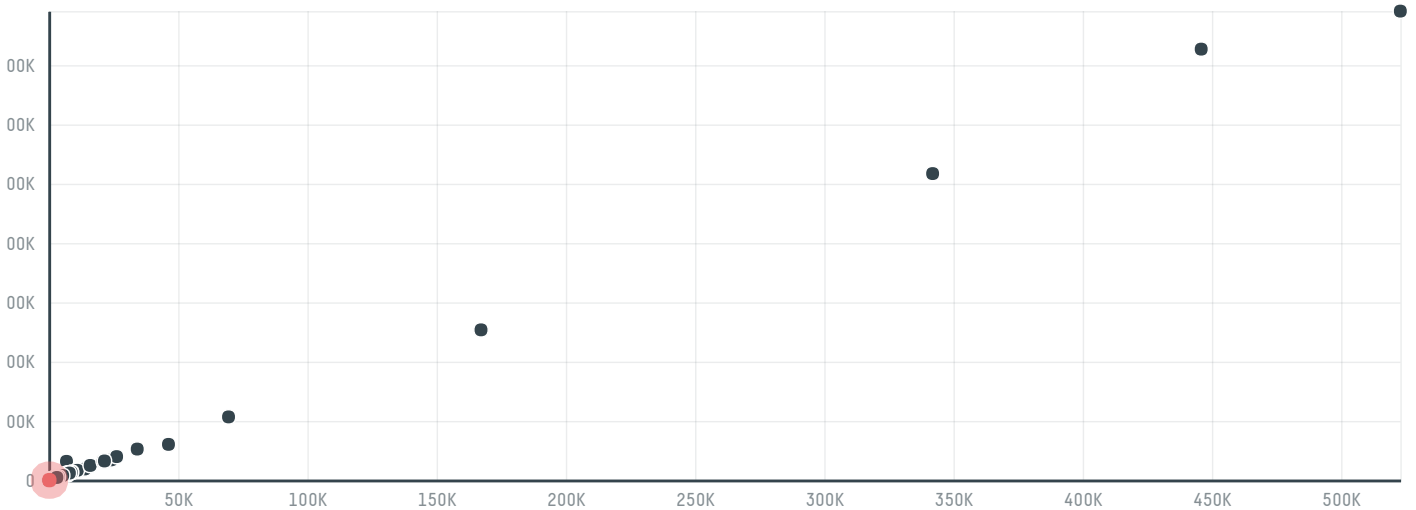
