

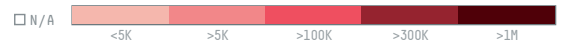
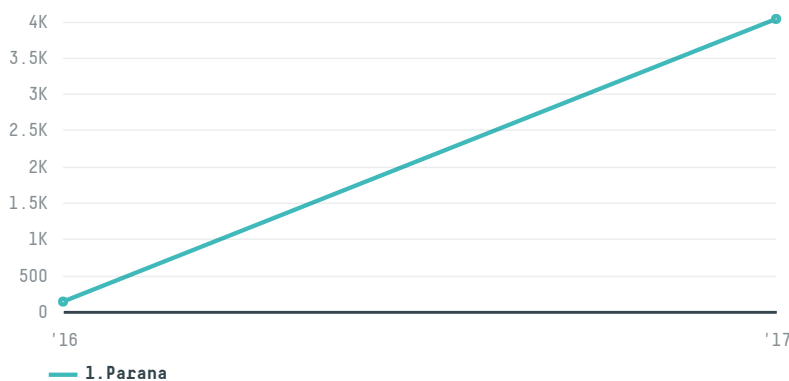
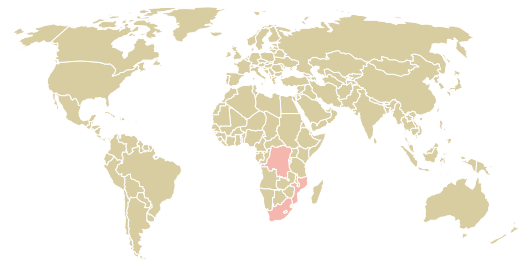
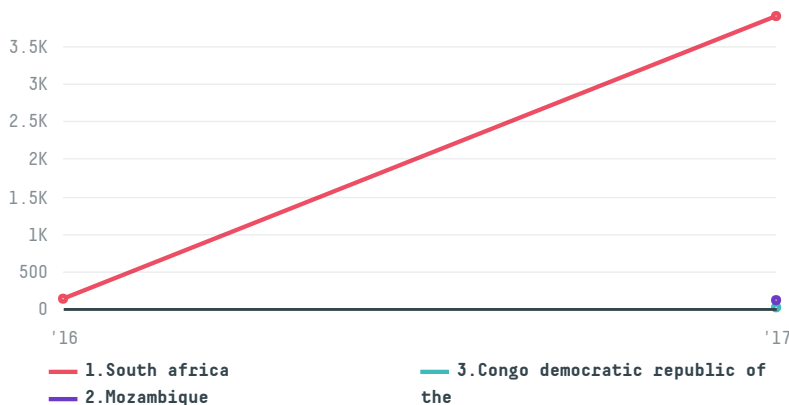


## Gaston matiferie

Gaston matiferie was the 86th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 4 thousand tons. This is a 2853% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, Gaston matiferie sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by Gaston matiferie is South africa, accounting for 97% of the total.

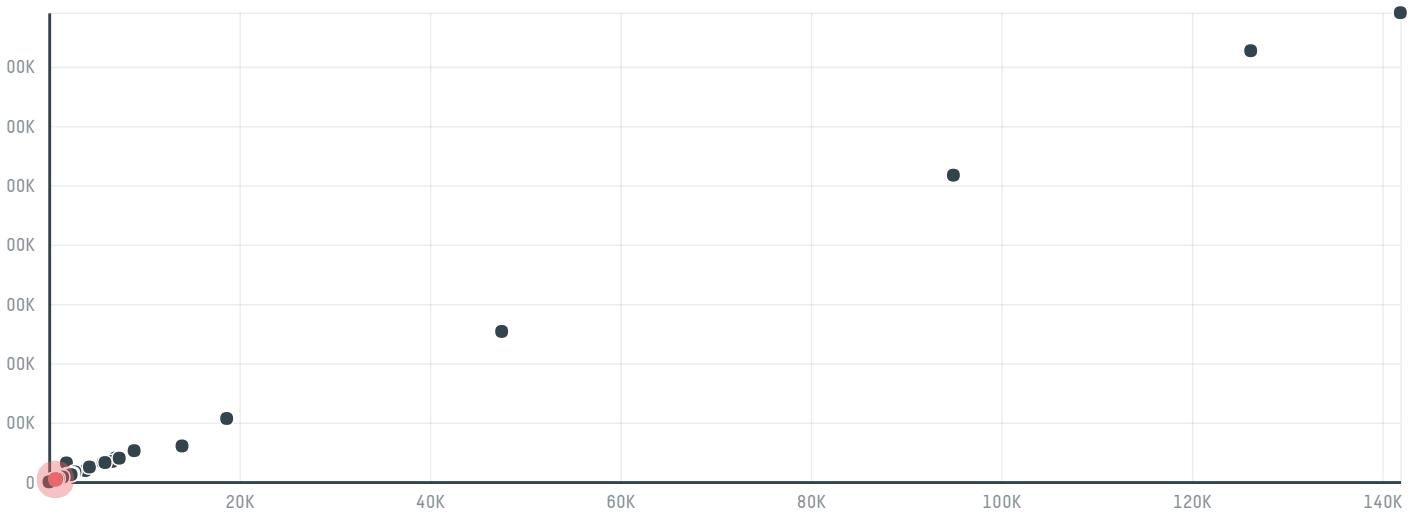
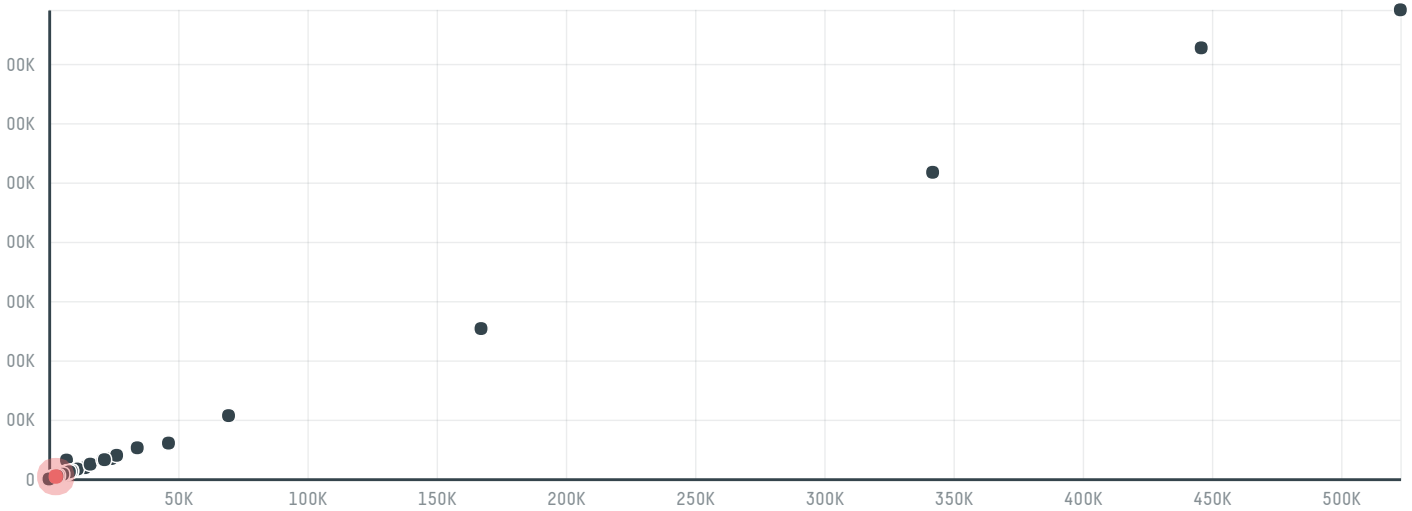
