Luyben was the 503rd largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 82 tons. This is a 1% decrease vs the previous year. The main destination of the chicken imported by Luyben is Ghana, accounting for 66% of the total.

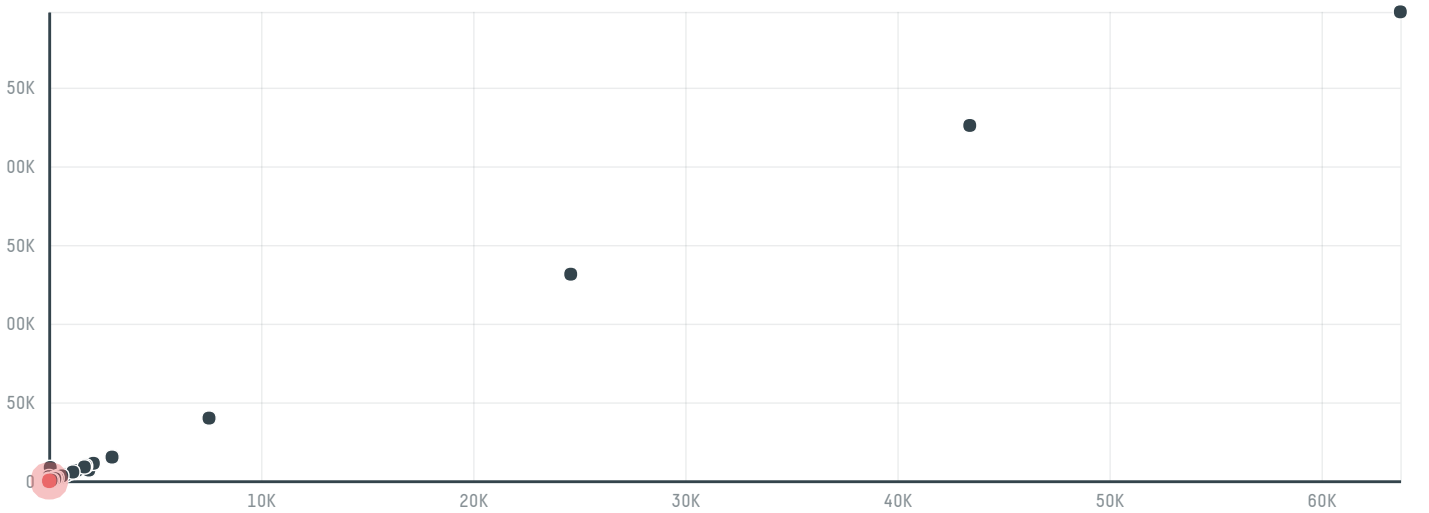
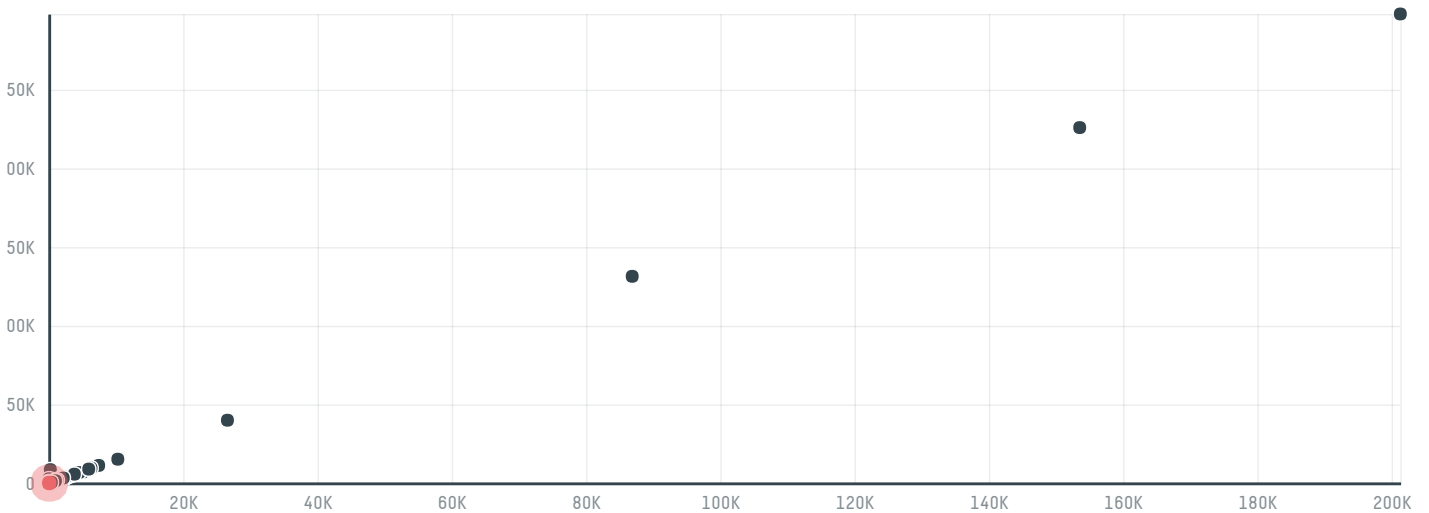
