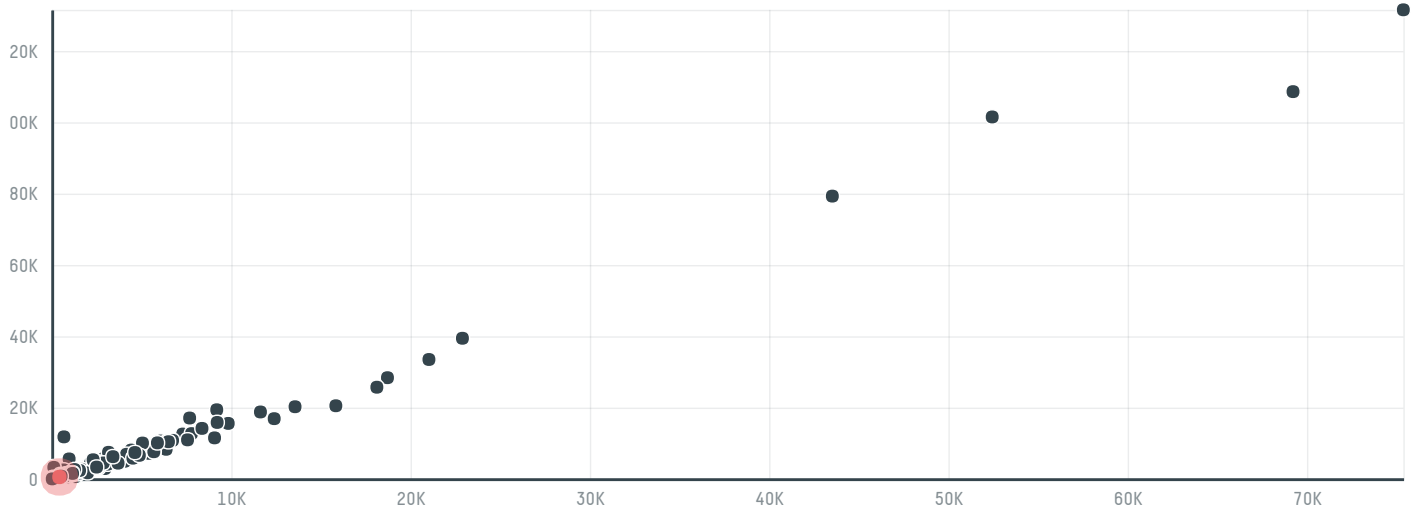

As an importer, Be green trading sa. sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the coffee production municipalities. The main destination of the coffee imported by Be green trading sa. is Belgium, accounting for 100% of the total.
