



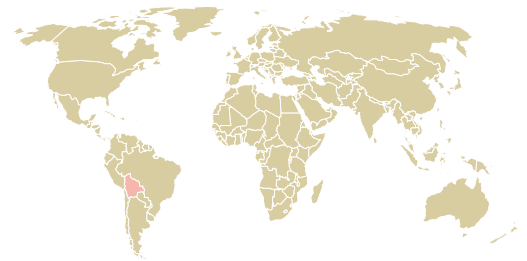
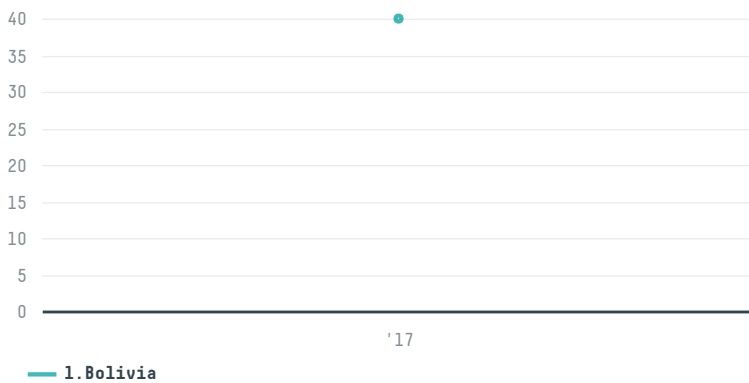

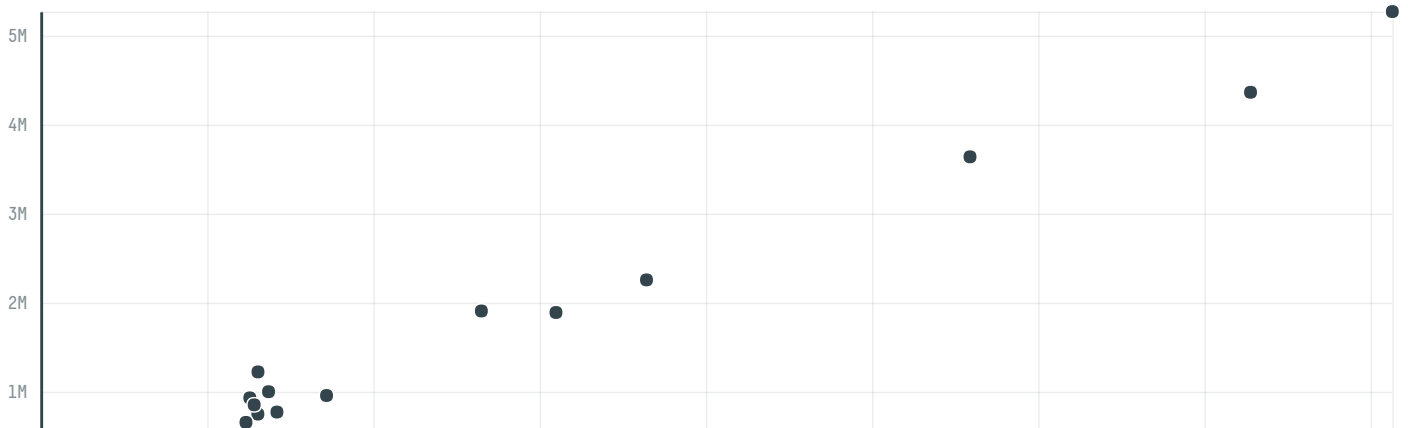

Celia ticona was the 123rd largest importer of corn from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 40 tons. As an importer, Celia ticona sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the corn production municipalities. The main destination of the corn imported by Celia ticona is Bolivia, accounting for 100% of the total.
