## Carlos alberto polato

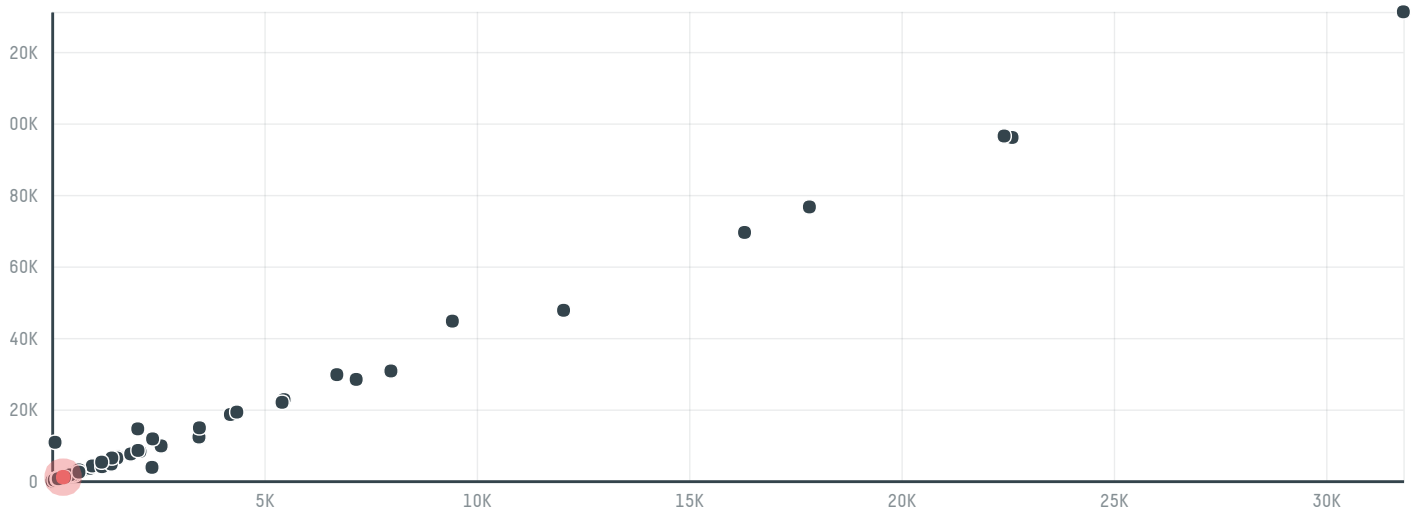

Carlos alberto polato was the 51st largest exporter of cotton from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 1 thousand tons. This is a 88% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, Carlos alberto polato sources from 1 municipalities, or 1% of the cotton production municipalities. The main destination of the cotton exported by Carlos alberto polato is Vietnam, accounting for 98% of the total.
