



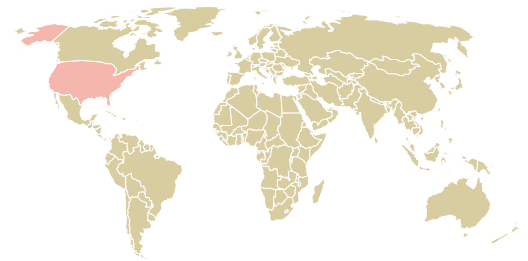

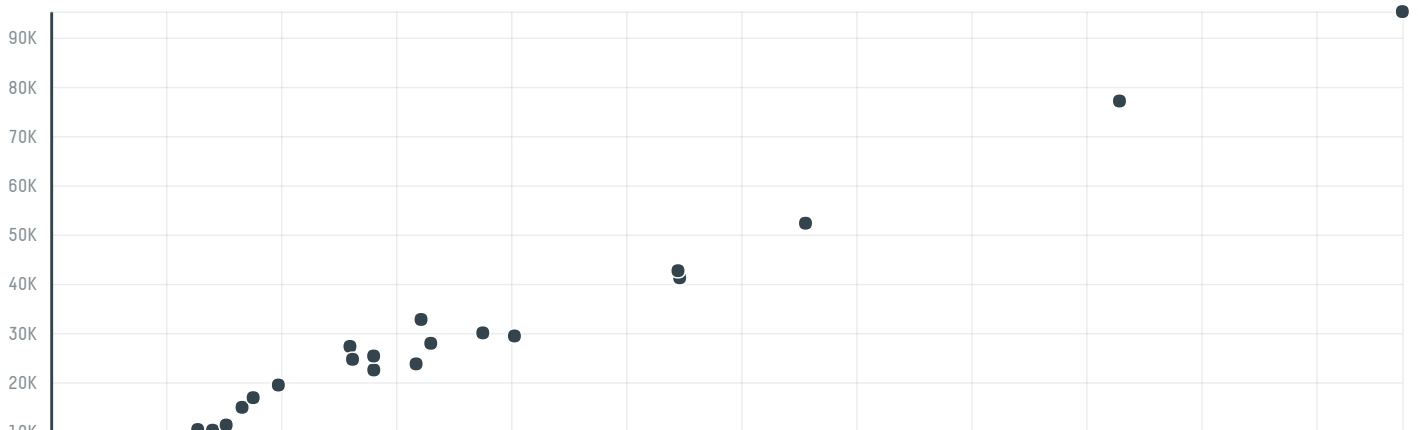

Monsanto was the 218th largest importer of cotton from BRAZIL in 2015, accounting for 0 tons. As an importer, Monsanto sources from 1 municipalities, or 1% of the cotton production municipalities. The main destination of the cotton imported by Monsanto is United states, accounting for 100% of the total.
