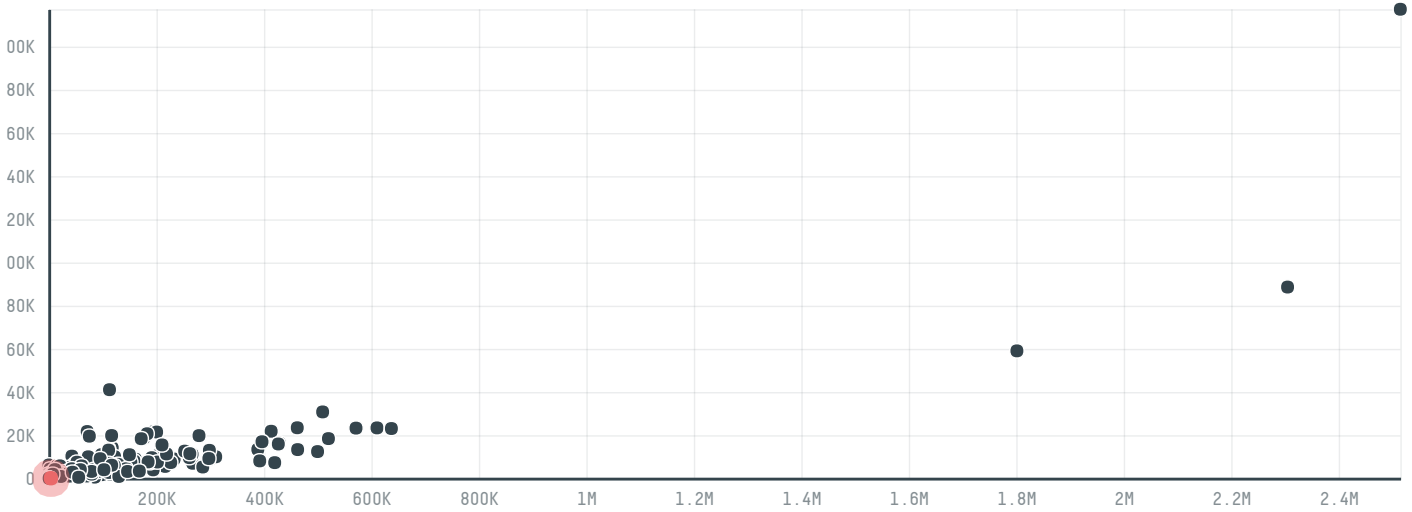
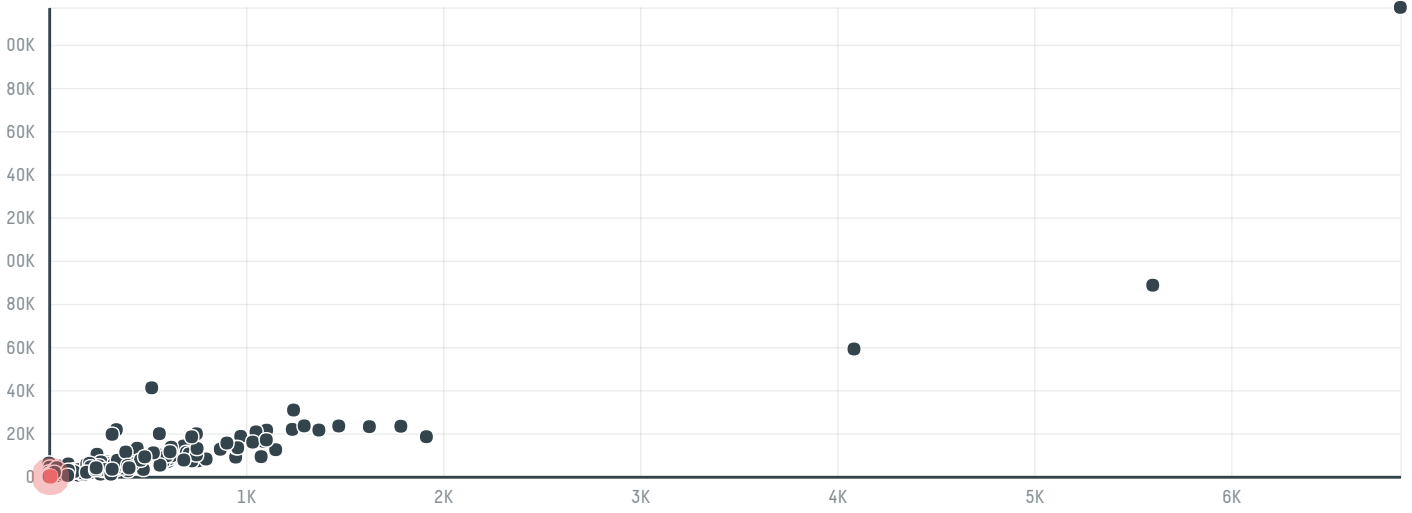
## Hong kong great green industrial

Hong kong great green industrial was the 1000th largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 87 tons. As an importer, Hong kong great green industrial sources from 91 municipalities, or 3% of the beef production municipalities. The main destination of the beef imported by Hong kong great green industrial is China (hong kong), accounting for 67% of the total.
