Uca was the 391st largest importer of beef from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 739 tons. This is a 1924% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, Uca sources from 215 municipalities, or 8% of the beef production municipalities. The main destination of the beef imported by Uca is Russian federation, accounting for 100% of the total.
