Rosebelle farm was the 502nd largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 80 tons. This is a 36% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Rosebelle farm sources from 3 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Rosebelle farm is Seychelles, accounting for 100% of the total.

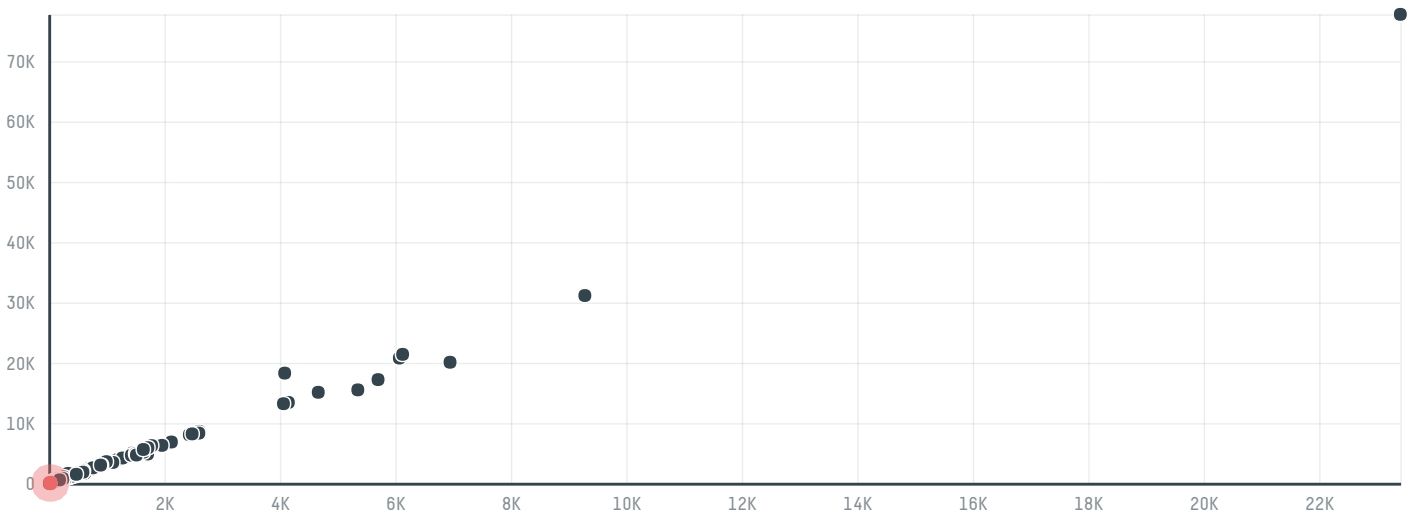
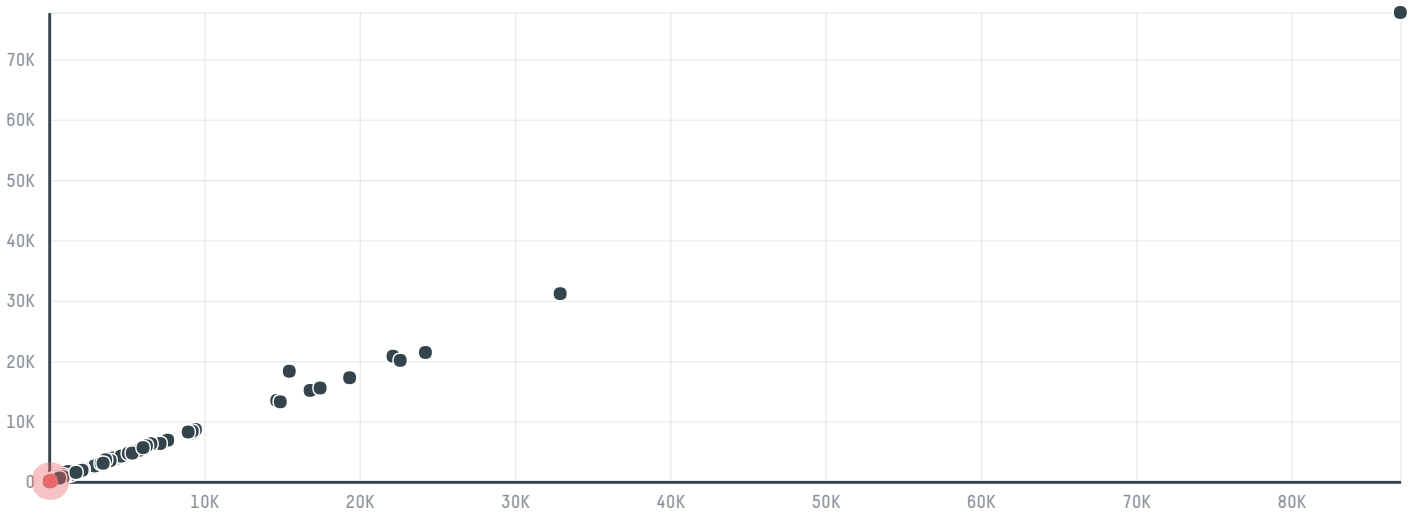
