

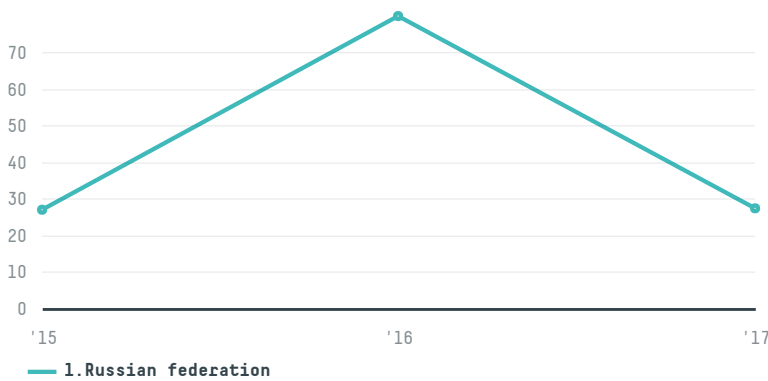


Kompas trade

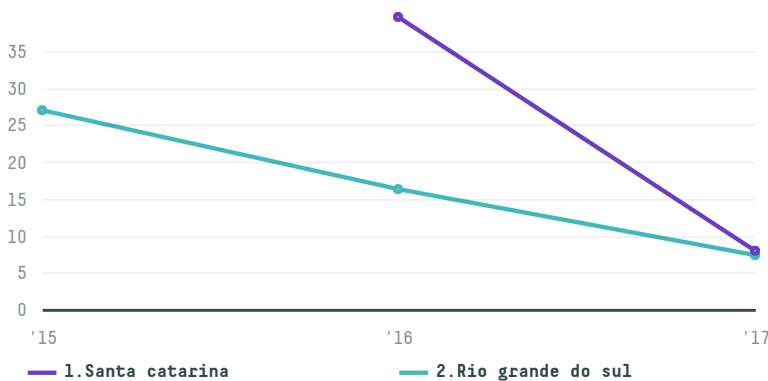
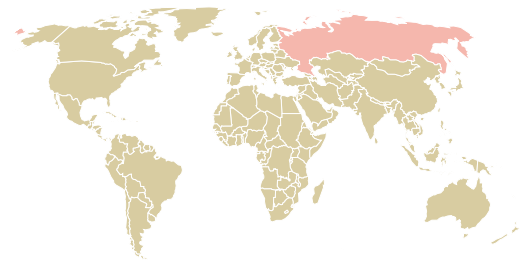

Kompas trade was the 562nd largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 28 tons. This is a 66% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Kompas trade sources from 7 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Kompas trade is Russian federation, accounting for 100% of the total.

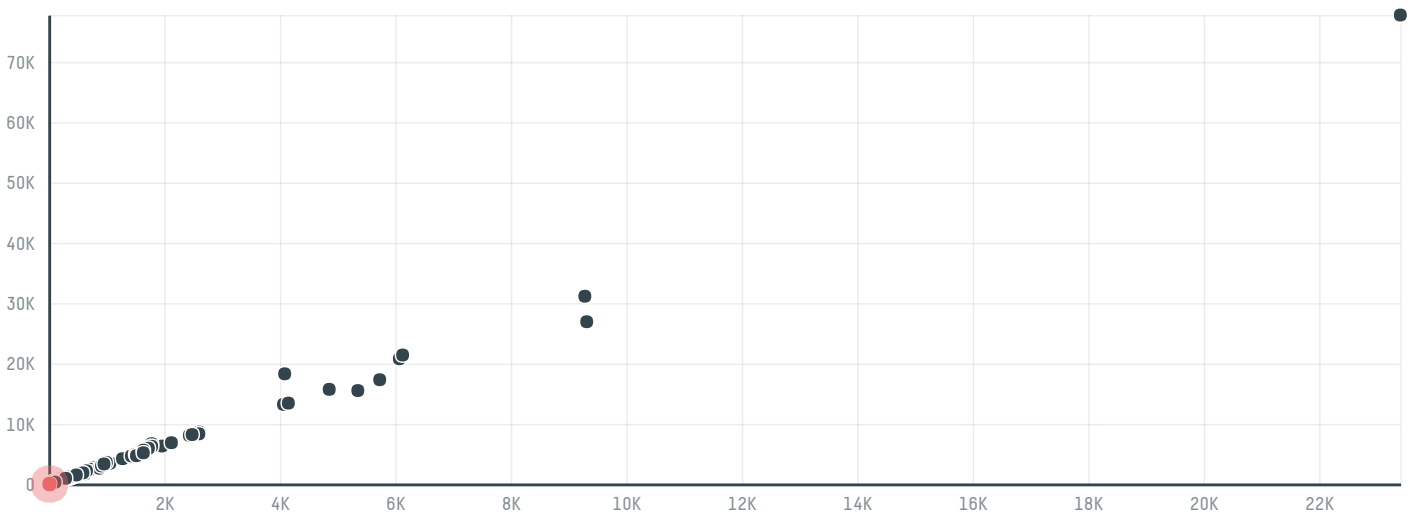
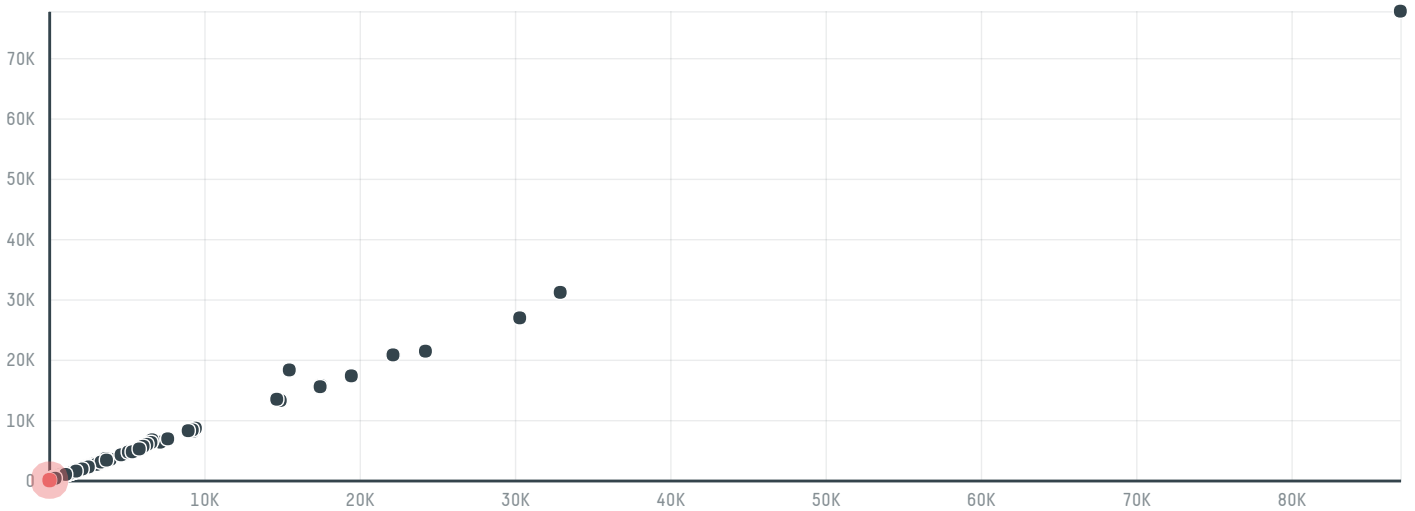
