



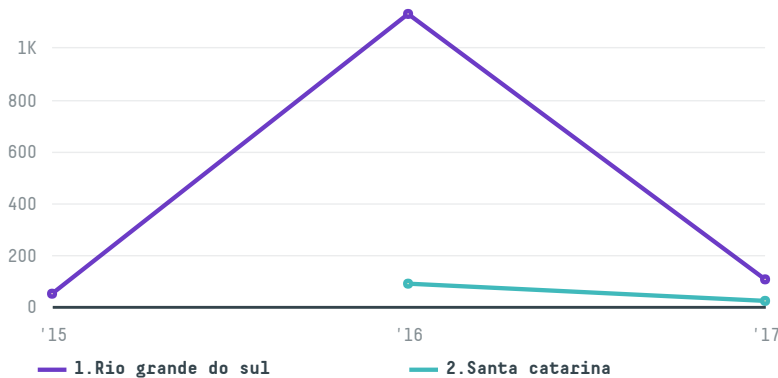
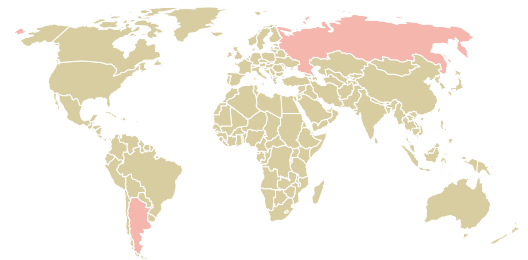
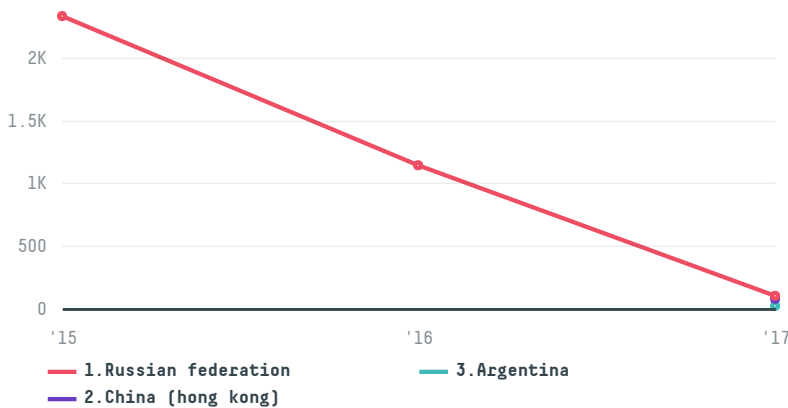

Agrika international was the 315th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 211 tons. This is a 84% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Agrika international sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Agrika international is Russian federation, accounting for 51% of the total.

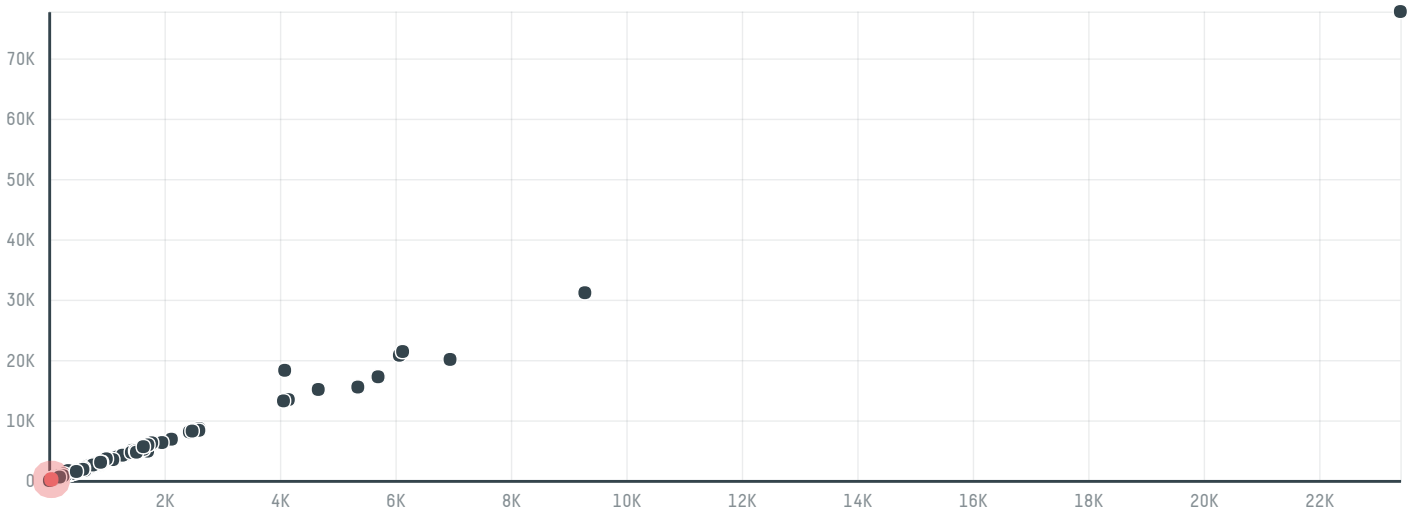
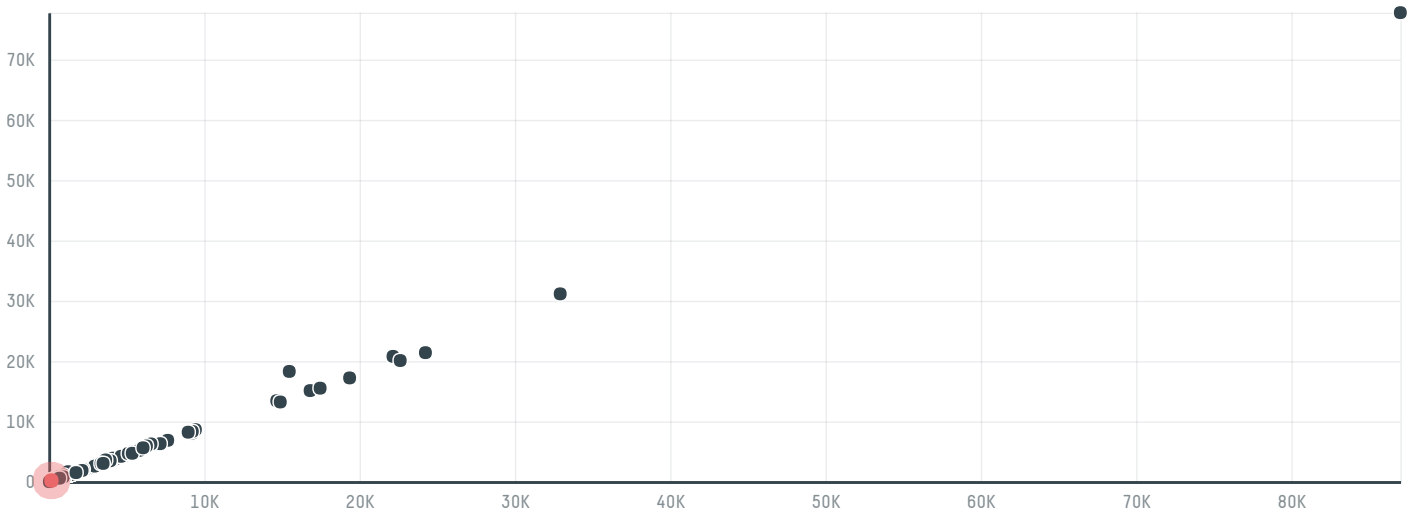
