Redstar was the 642nd largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2015, accounting for 26 tons. As an importer, Redstar sources from 16 municipalities, or 6% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Redstar is Russian federation, accounting for 100% of the total.

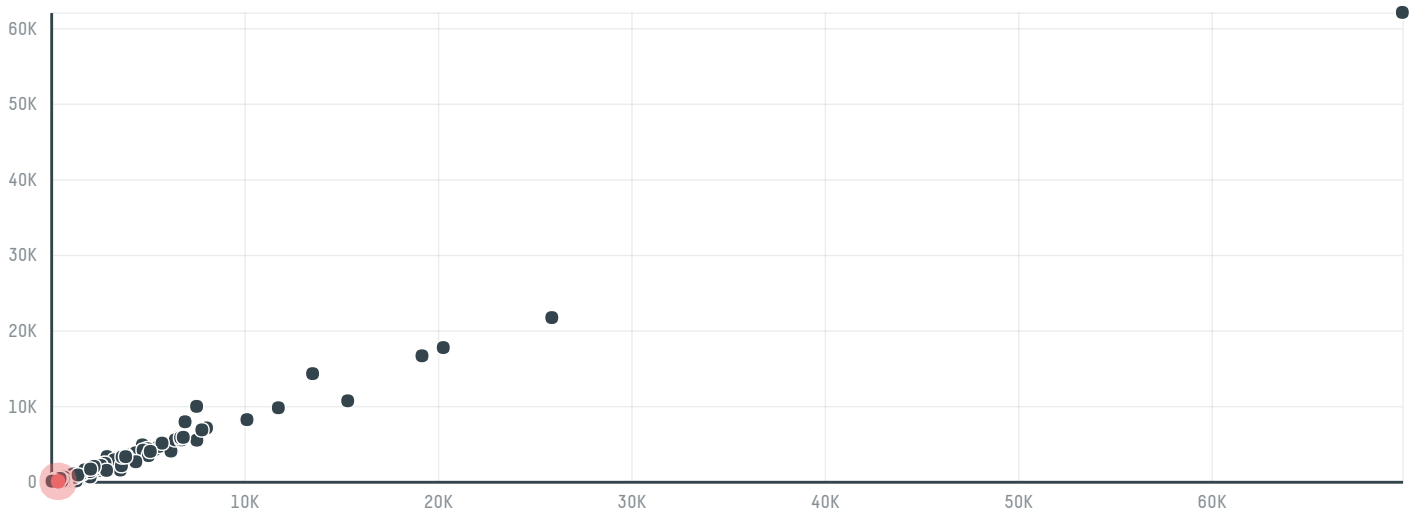

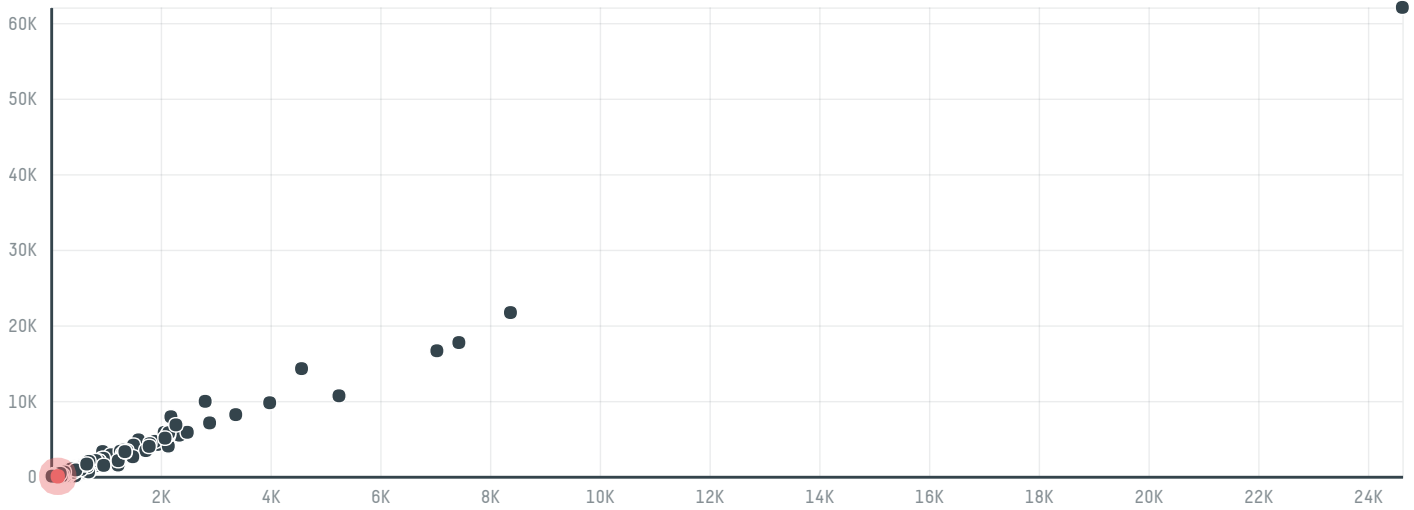
