Manielos sa was the 30th largest importer of pork from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 790 tons. This is a 48% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, Manielos sa sources from 9 municipalities, or 3% of the pork production municipalities. The main destination of the pork imported by Manielos sa is Argentina, accounting for 49% of the total.

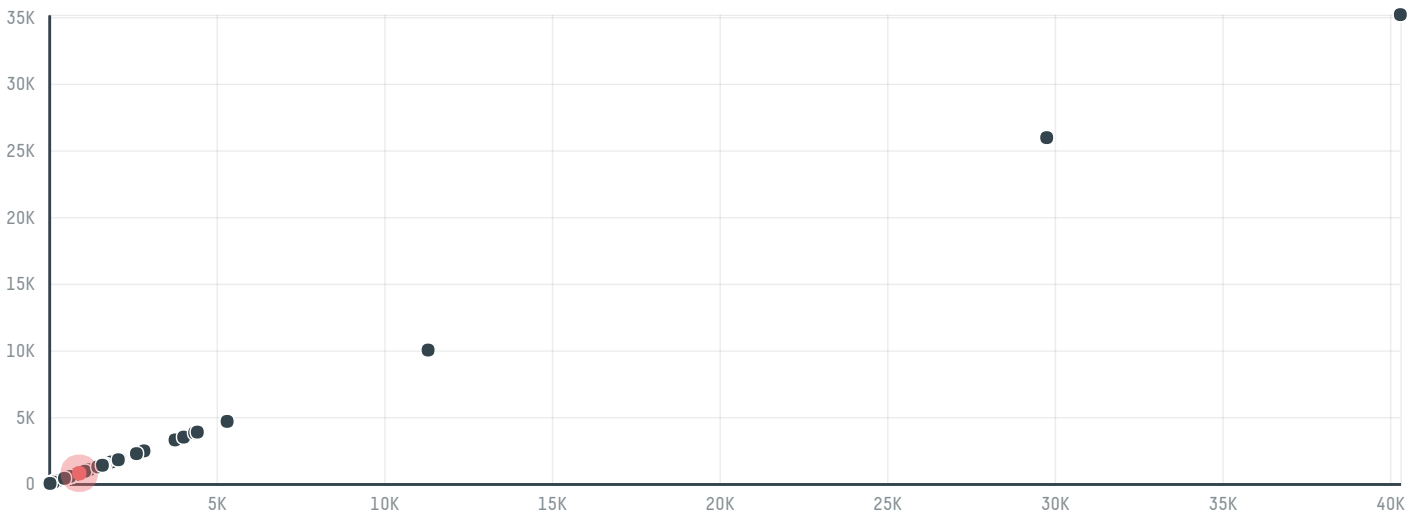
