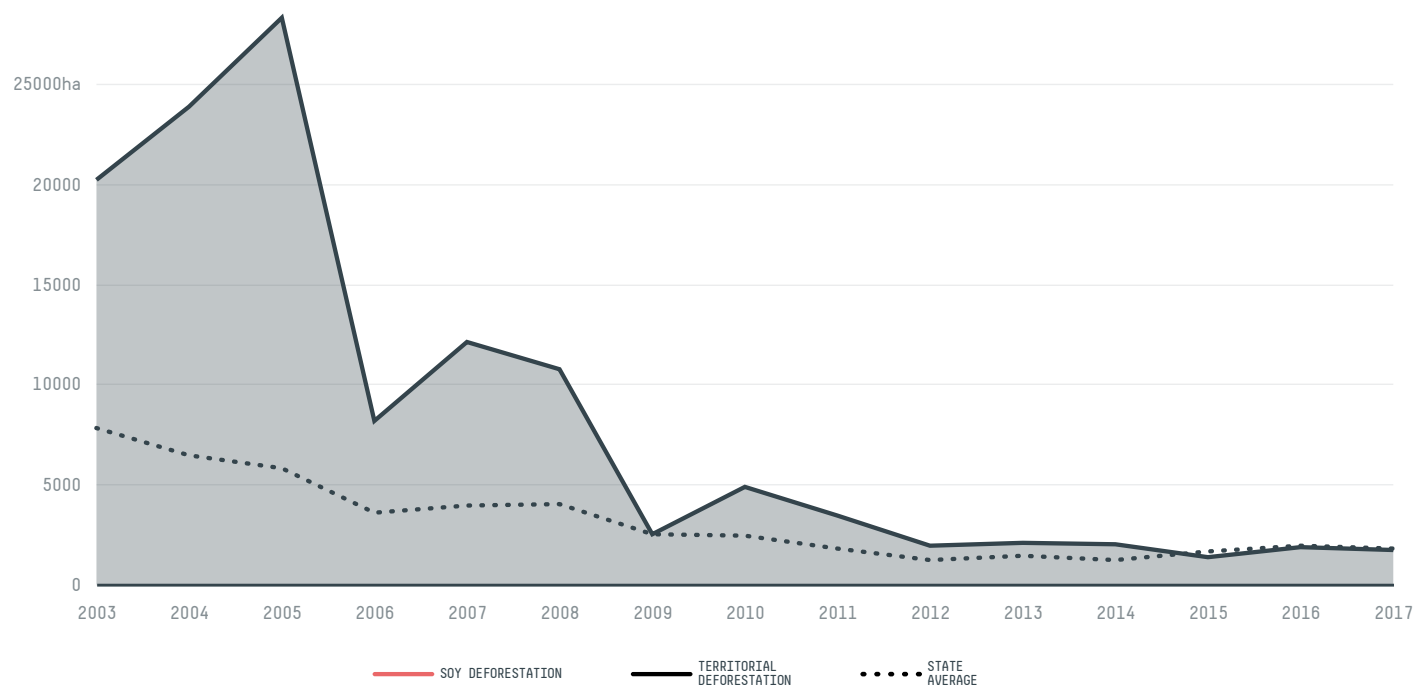
In 2017, Santa Maria Das Barreiras produced 68,028 t of soy occupying a total of 23,621 ha of land. With 0.04% of the total production, it ranks 383rd in Brazil in soy production, and 7th in the state of Para. The largest exporter of soy in Santa Maria Das Barreiras was Glencore, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

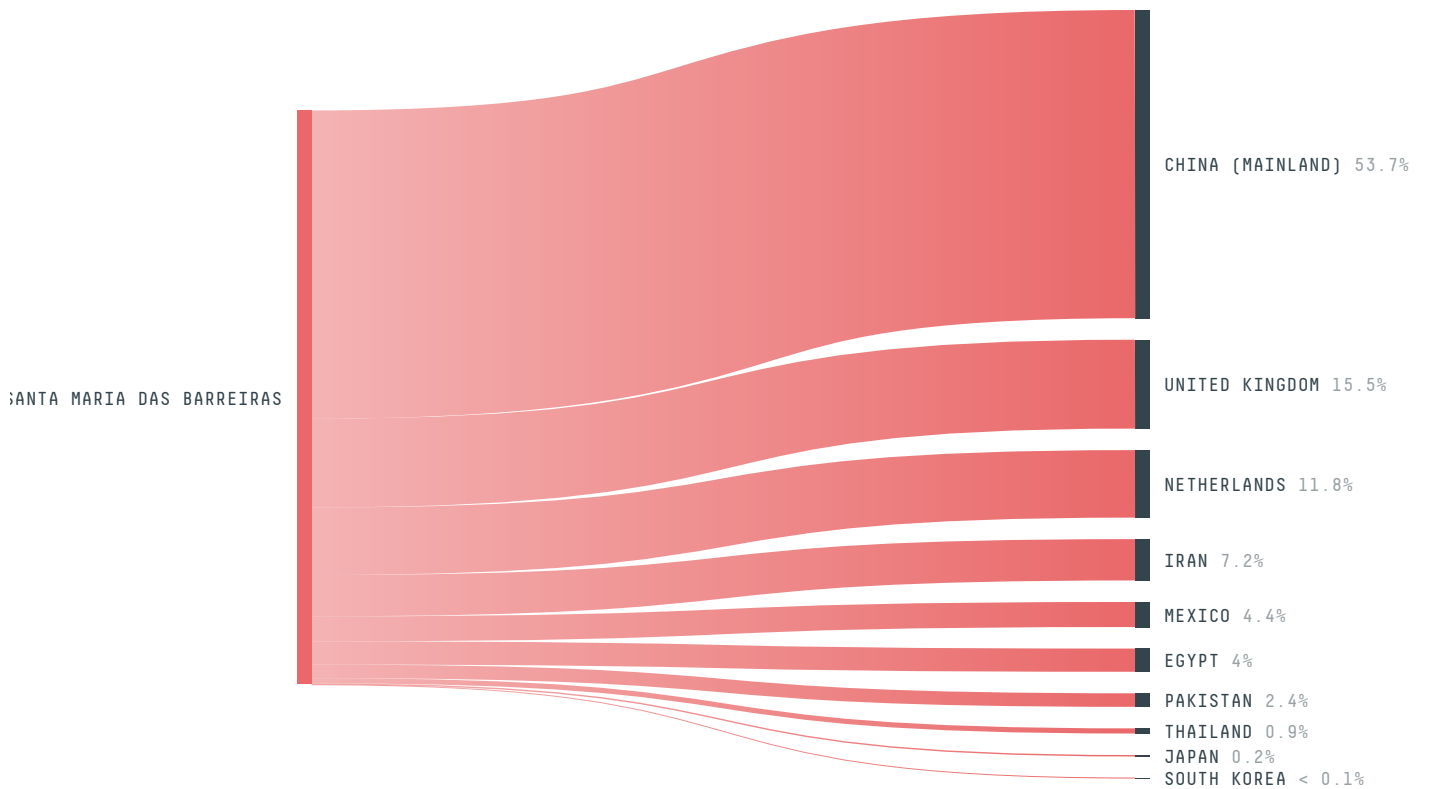
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SANTA MARIA DAS BARREIRAS
