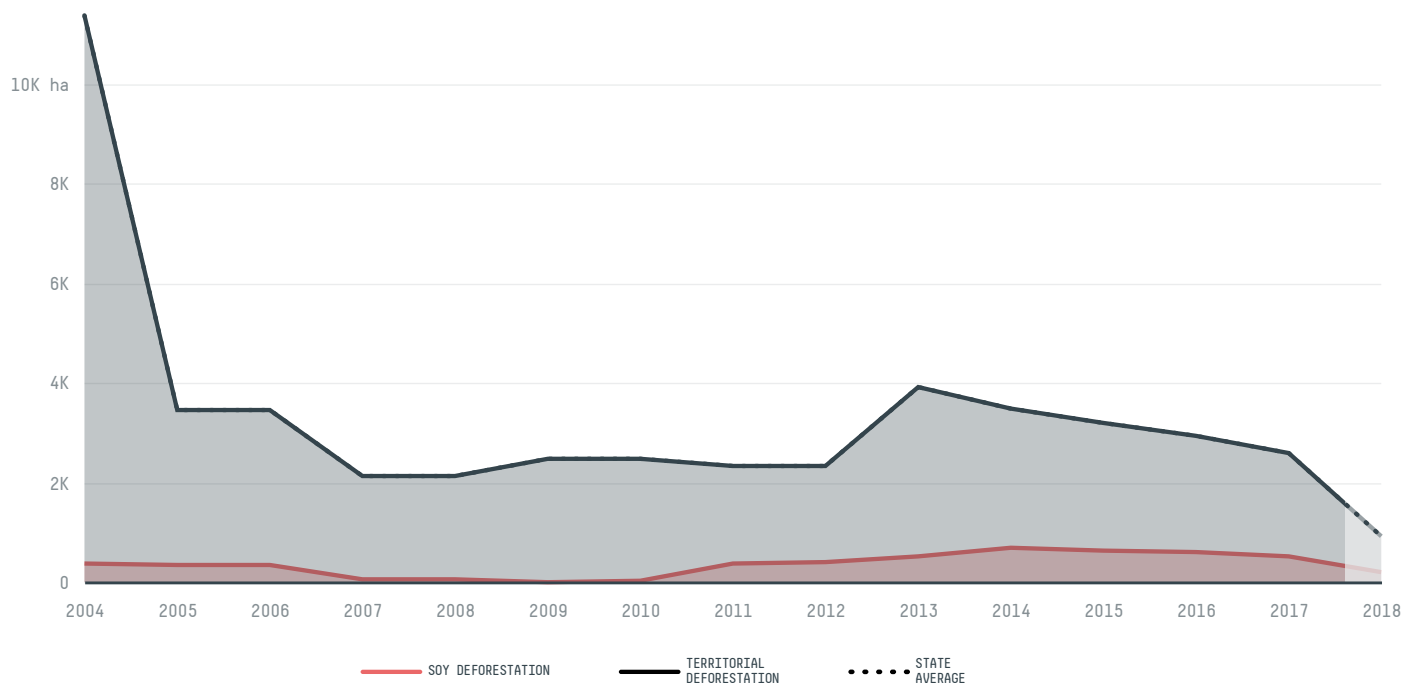

In 2018, Miracema Do Tocantins produced 22,950 t of soy occupying a total of 8,500 ha of land. With 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 764th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Miracema Do Tocantins was Bunge, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

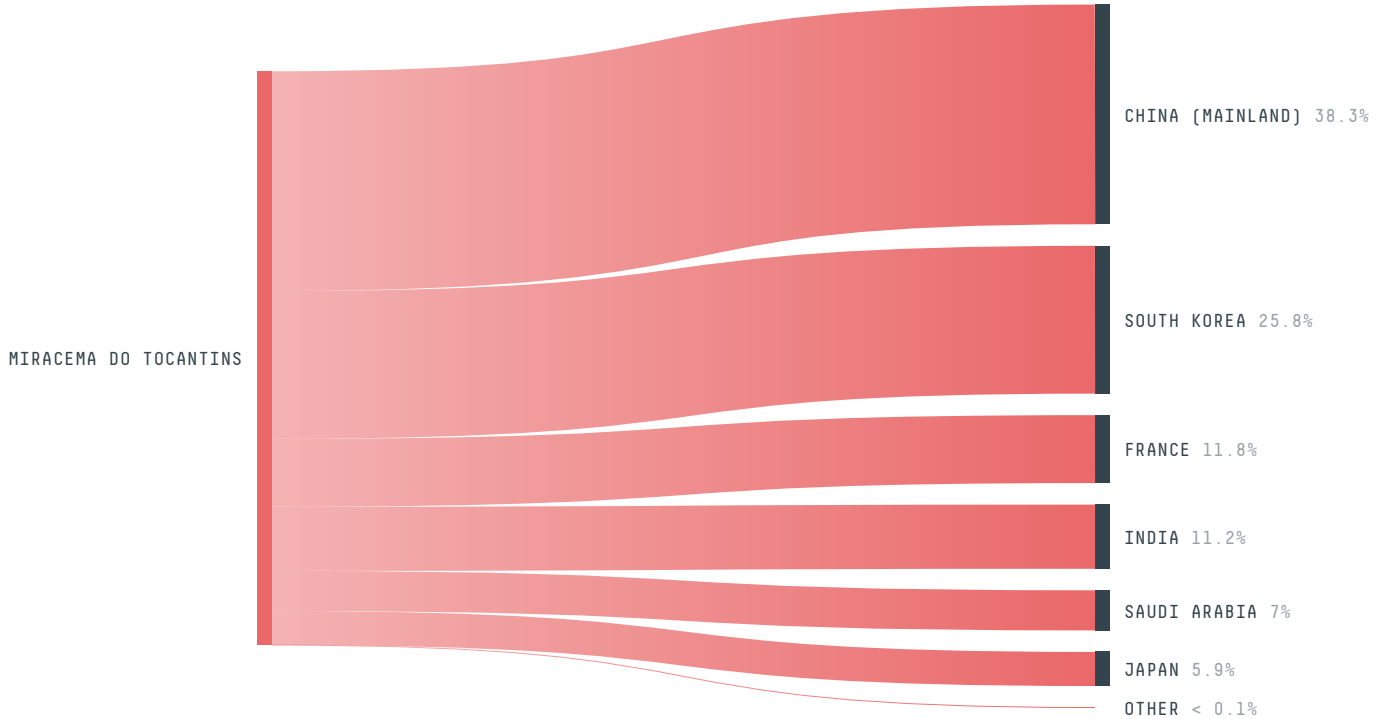
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MIRACEMA DO TOCANTINS
