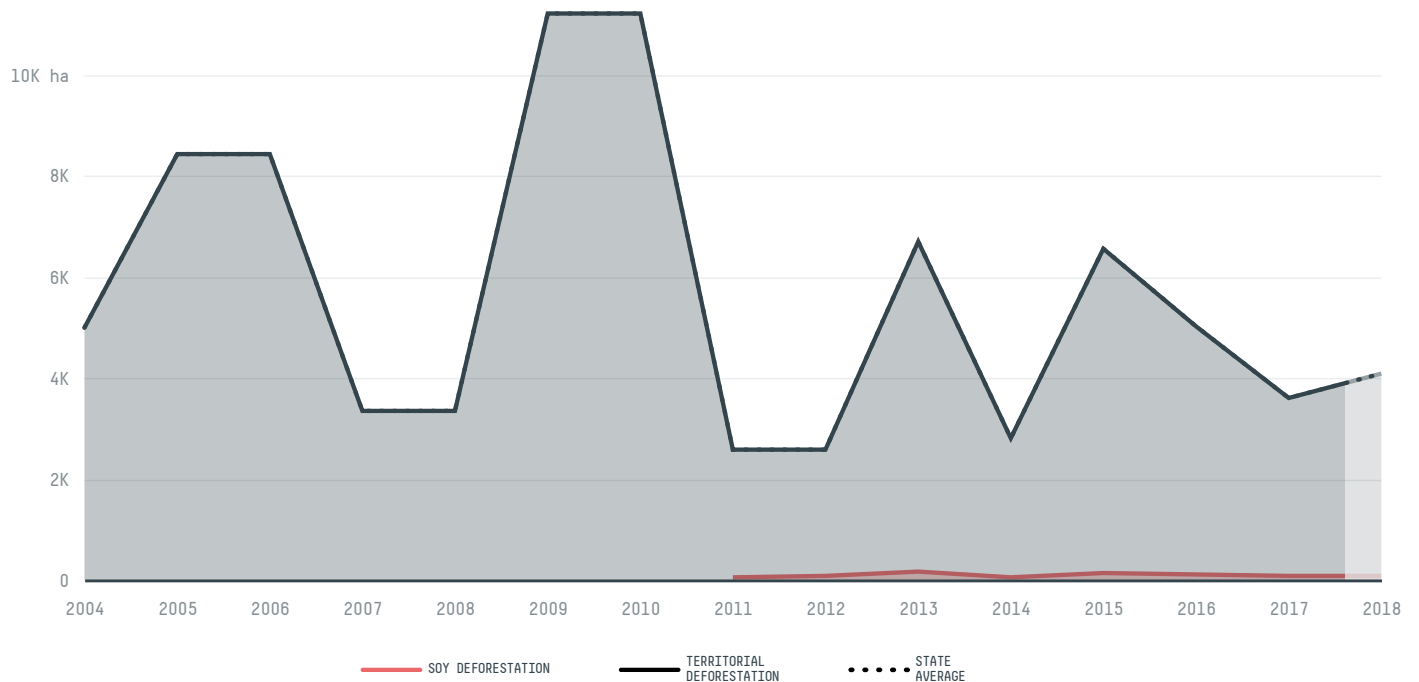

In 2018, Dois Irmaos Do Tocantins produced 10,937 t of soy occupying a total of 3,906 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 978th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Dois Irmaos Do Tocantins was Bunge, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).
