1,026 km² **36,630 t** **12,409 ha**

In 2017, Sucupira produced 36,630 t of soy occupying a total of 12,409 ha of land. With 0.02% of the total production, it ranks 597th in Brazil in soy production, and 24th in the state of Tocantins. The largest exporter of soy in Sucupira was Adm, which accounted for 76.5% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

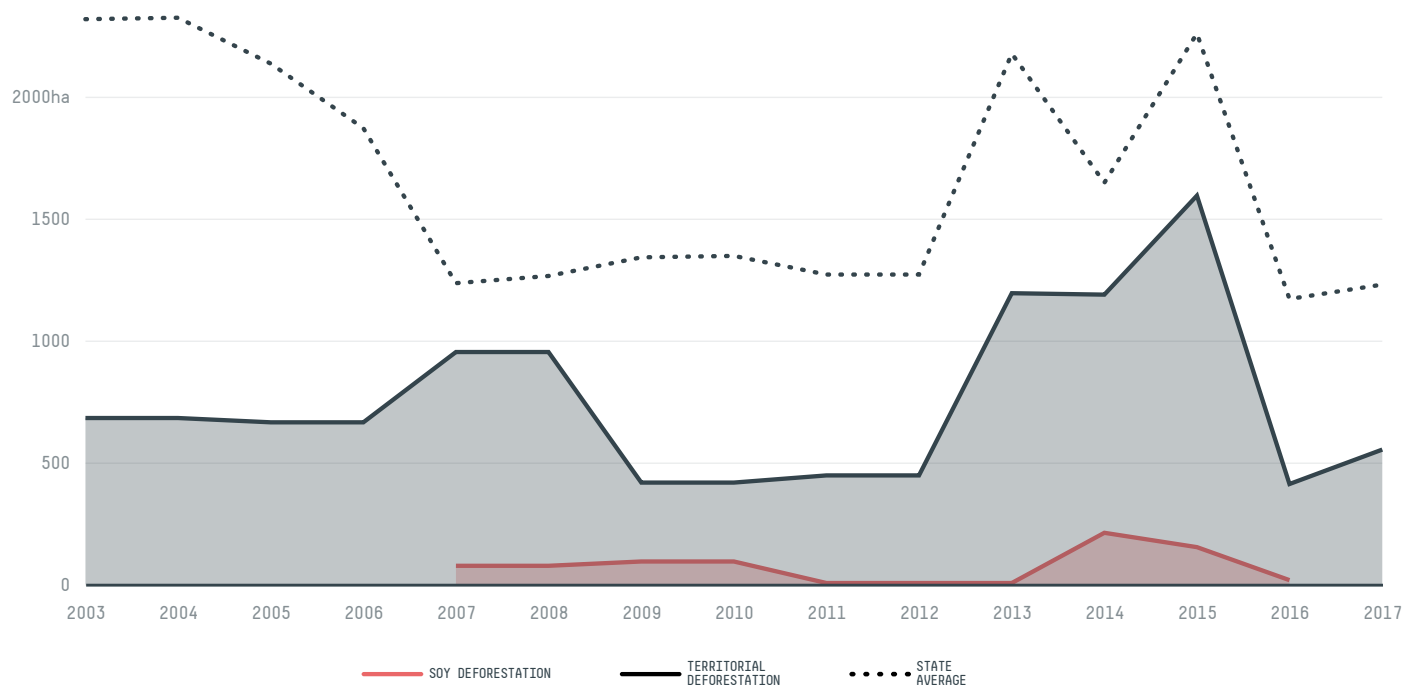

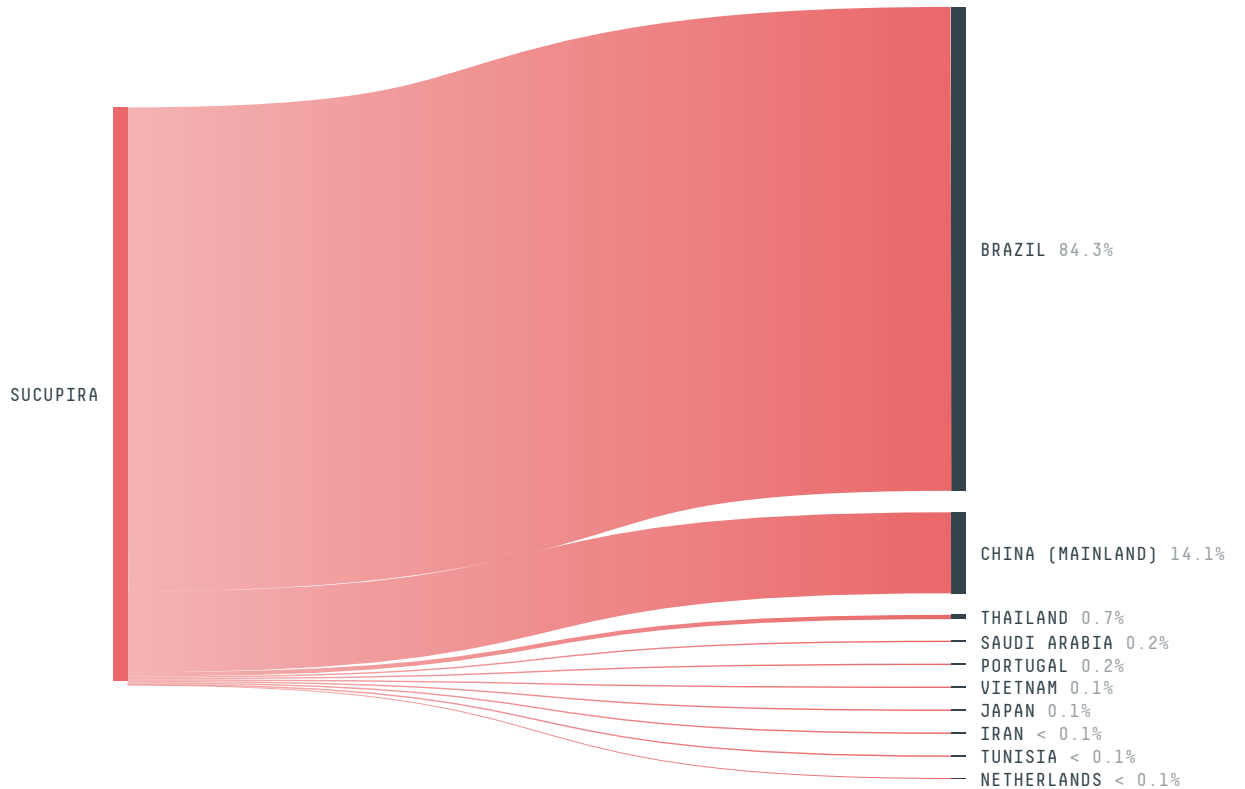
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SUCUPIRA
