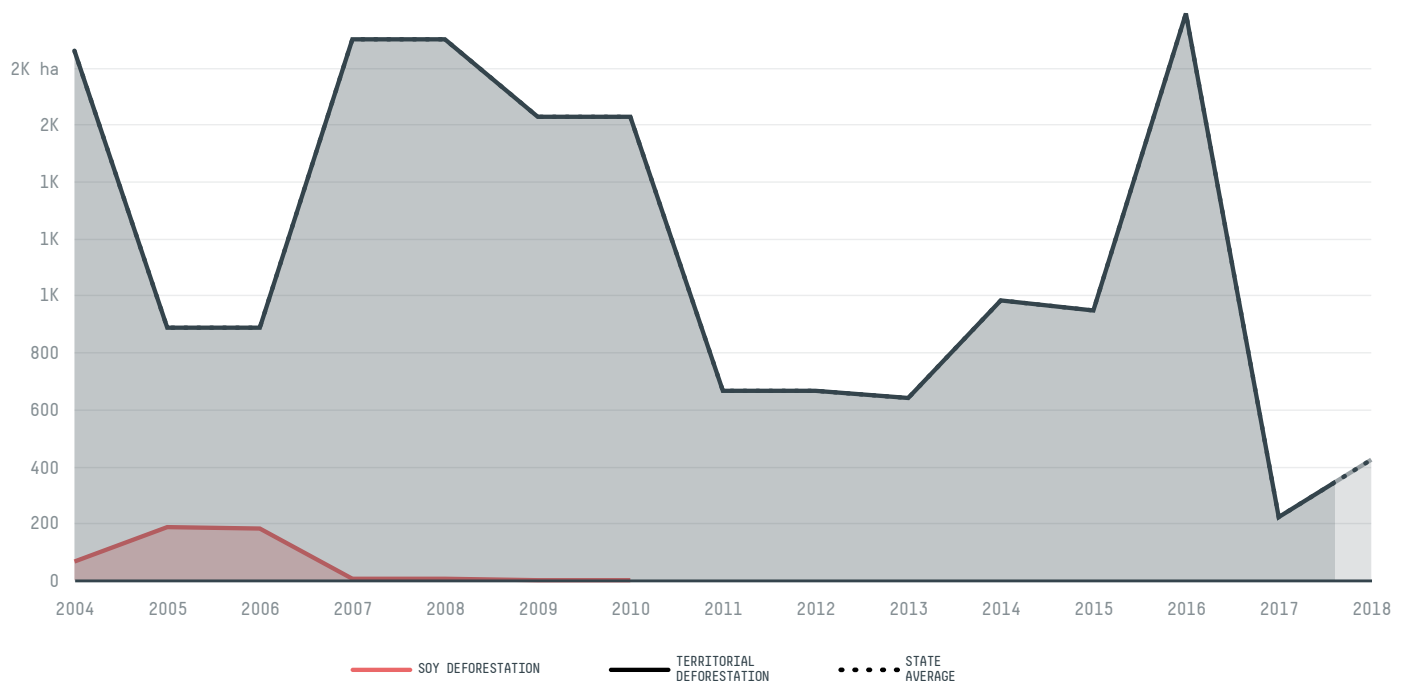

In 2018, Tupiratins produced 2,200 t of soy occupying a total of 1,000 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1311th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Tupiratins was Bunge, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

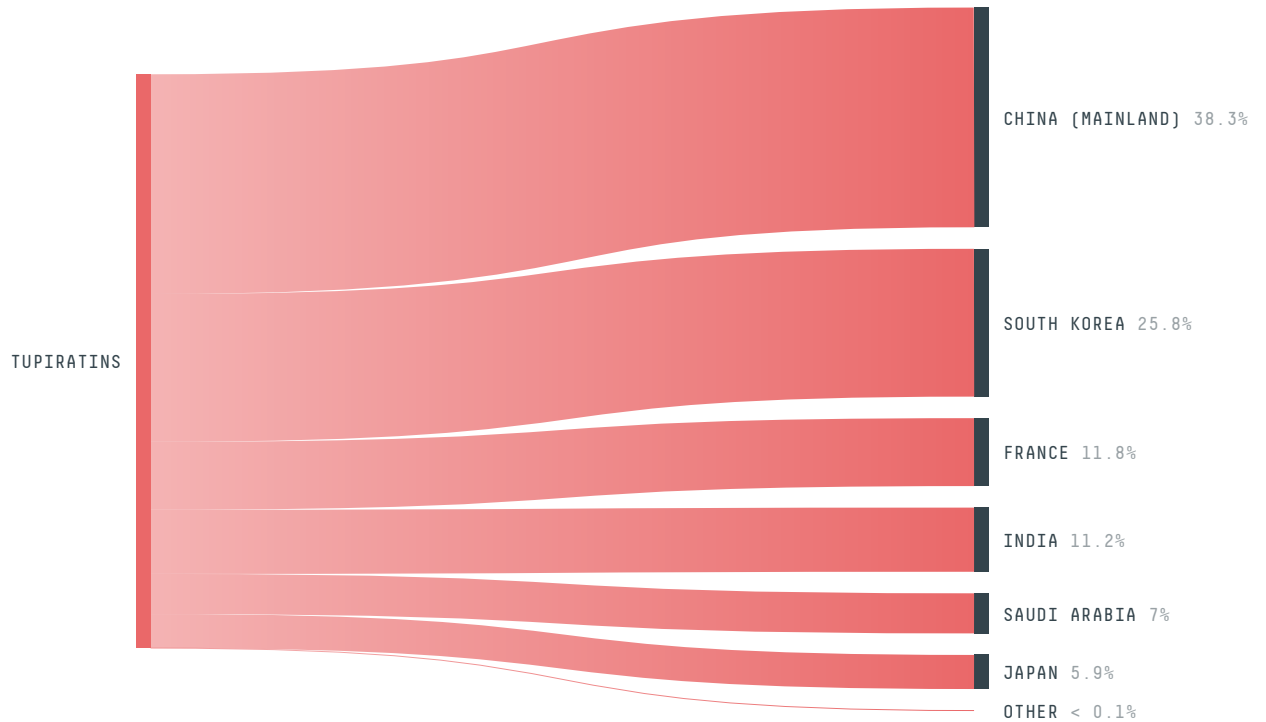
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TUPIRATINS
