In 2017, Natividade produced 4,350 t of soy occupying a total of 2,300 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1185th in Brazil in soy production, and 66th in the state of Tocantins. The largest exporter of soy in Natividade was Granol, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

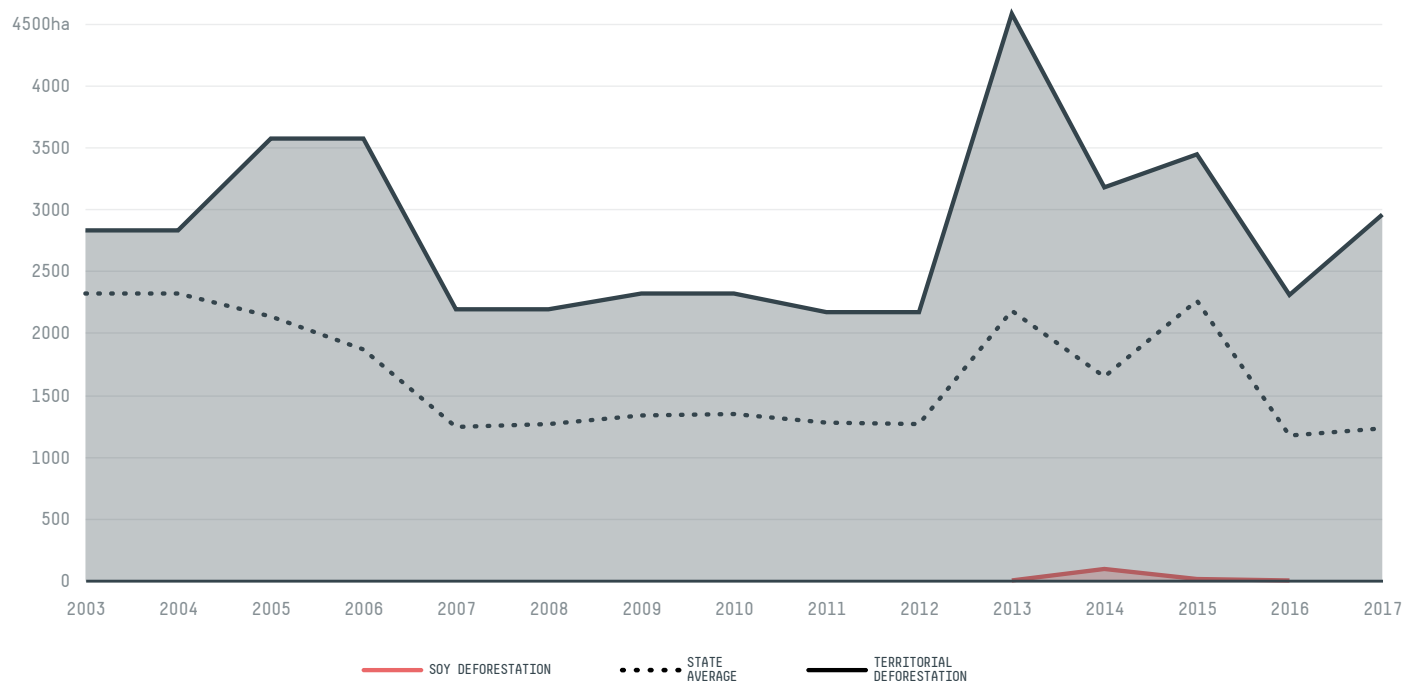

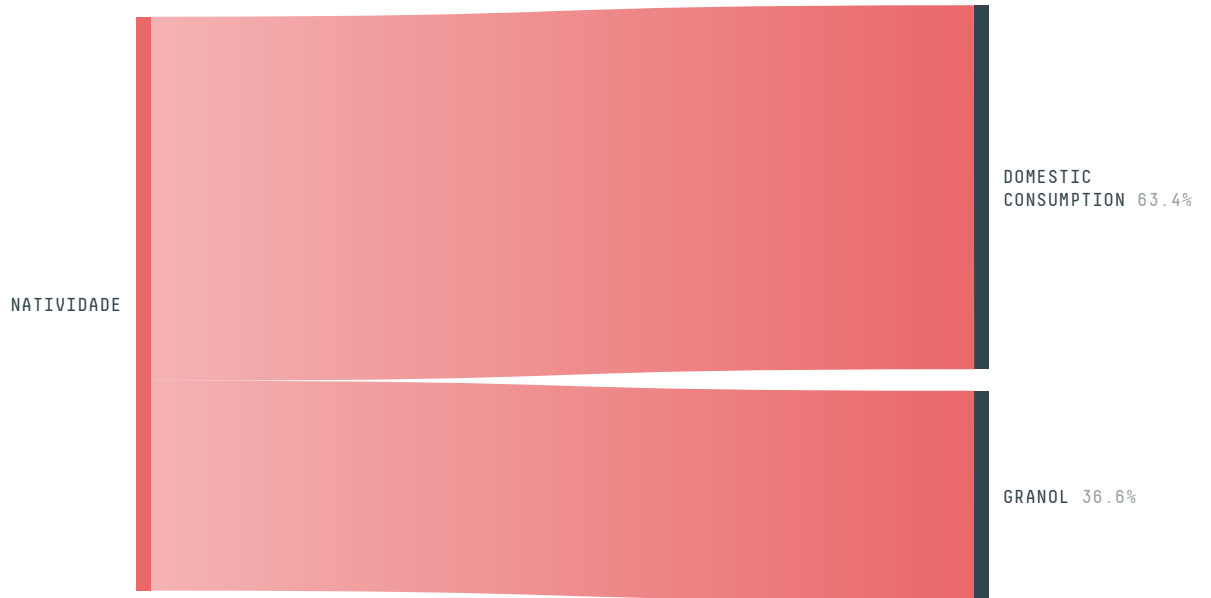
