1,566 km² 564 t 230 ha

In 2017, Nova Olinda produced 564 t of soy occupying a total of 230 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1523rd in Brazil in soy production, and 82nd in the state of Tocantins. The largest exporter of soy in Nova Olinda was Bunge, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

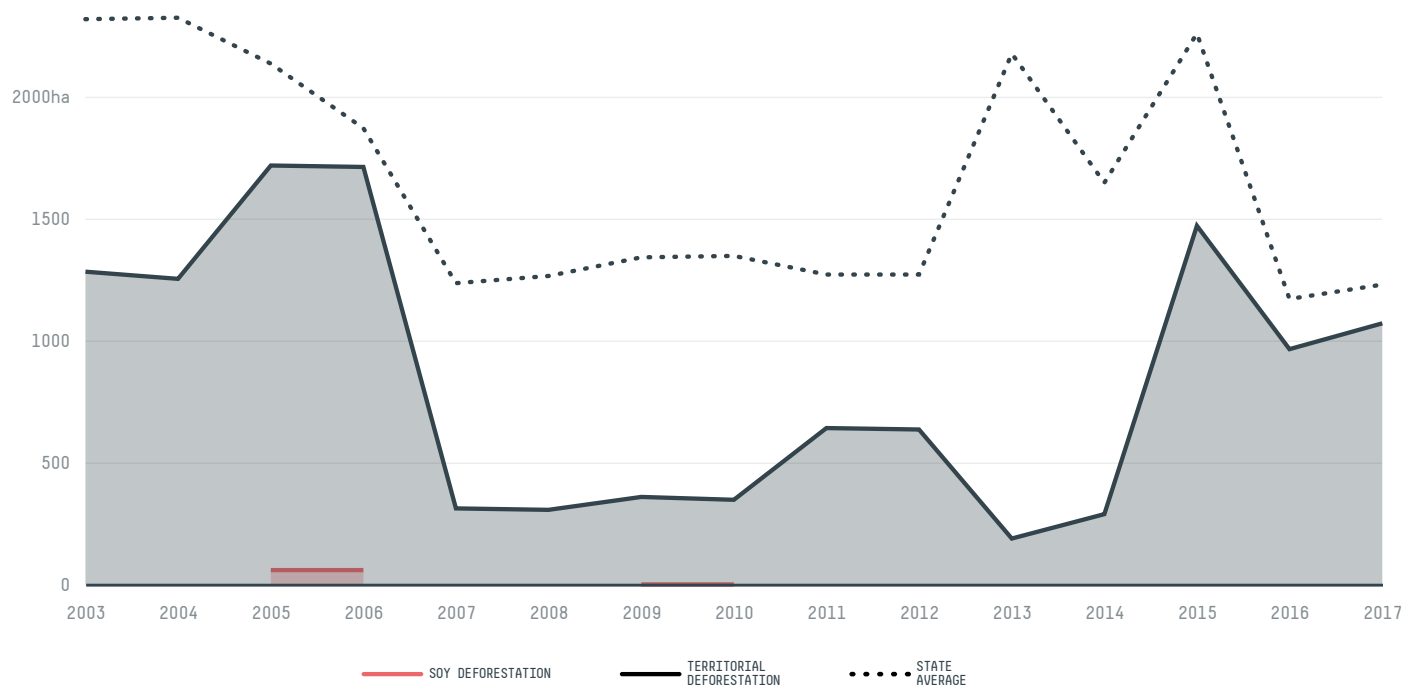

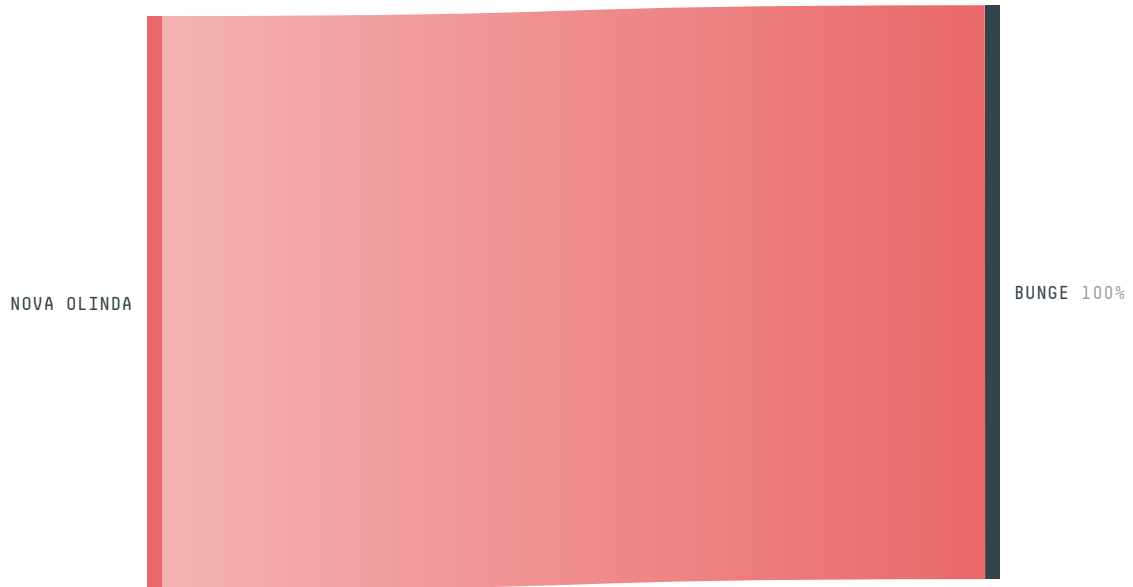

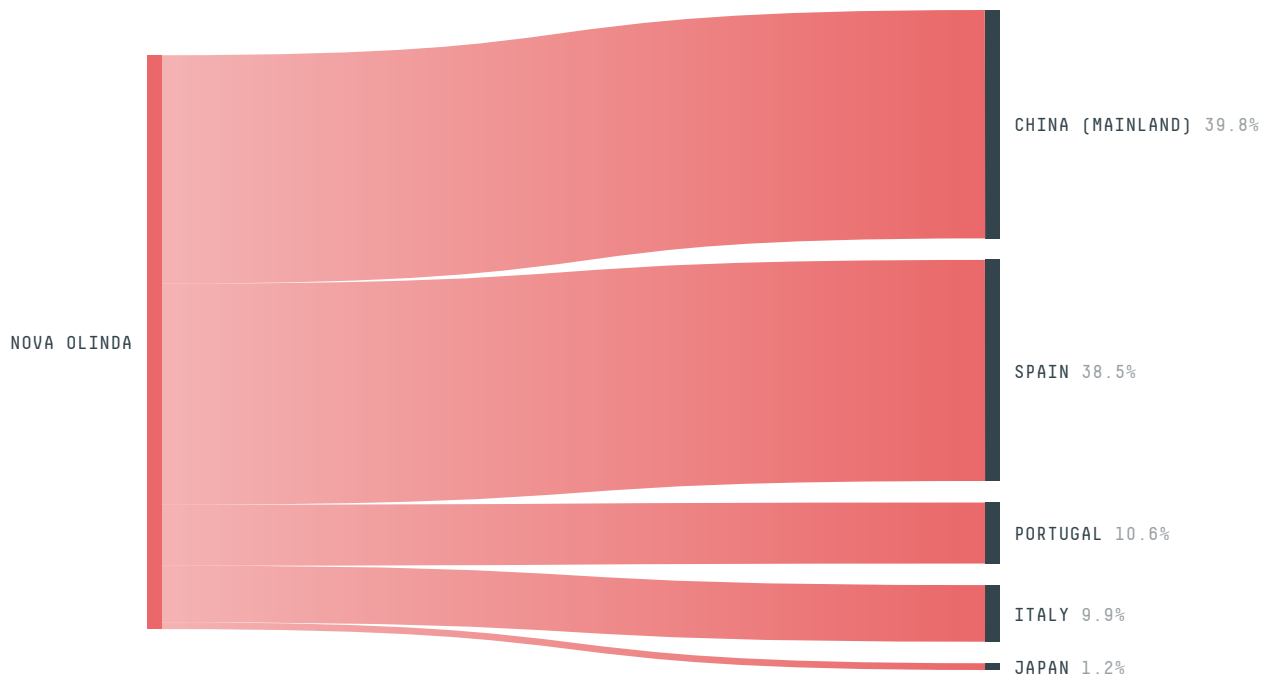
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVA OLINDA



TOP TRADERS OF SOY IN NOVA OLINDA IN 2017



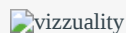
TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF SOY FROM NOVA OLINDA IN 2017



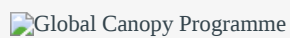
