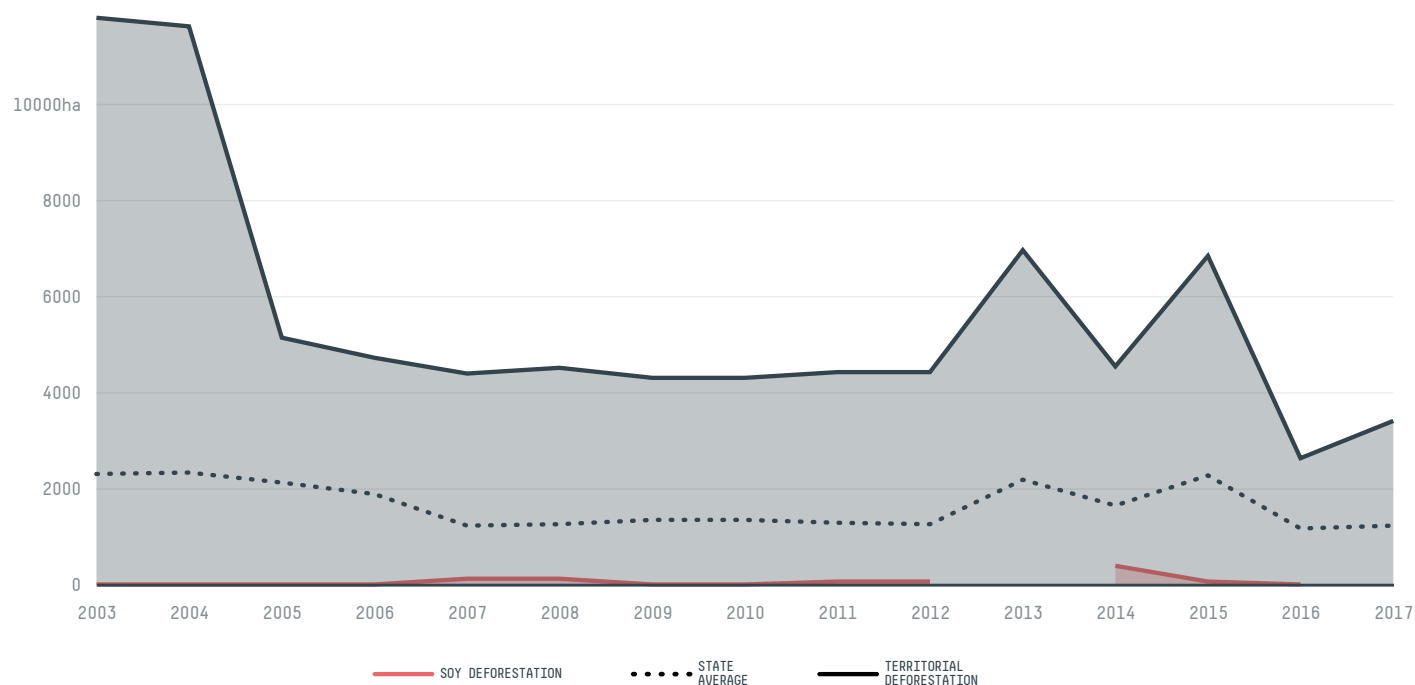
AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND
13,423 km² 56,100 t 18,826 ha

In 2017, Formoso Do Araguaia produced 56,100 t of soy occupying a total of 18,826 ha of land. With 0.03% of the total production, it ranks 453rd in Brazil in soy production, and 15th in the state of Tocantins. The largest exporter of soy in Formoso Do Araguaia was Adm, which accounted for 87.6% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

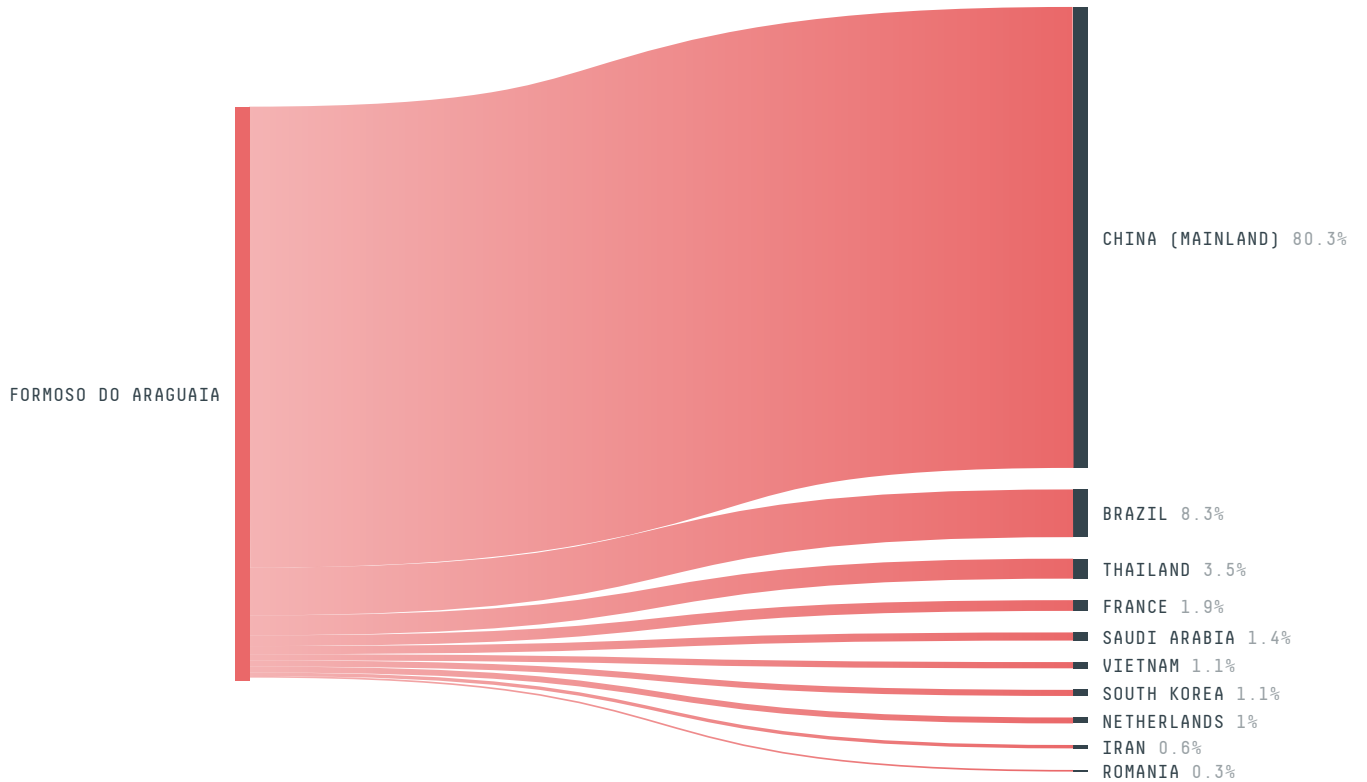
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF FORMOSO DO ARAGUAIA
