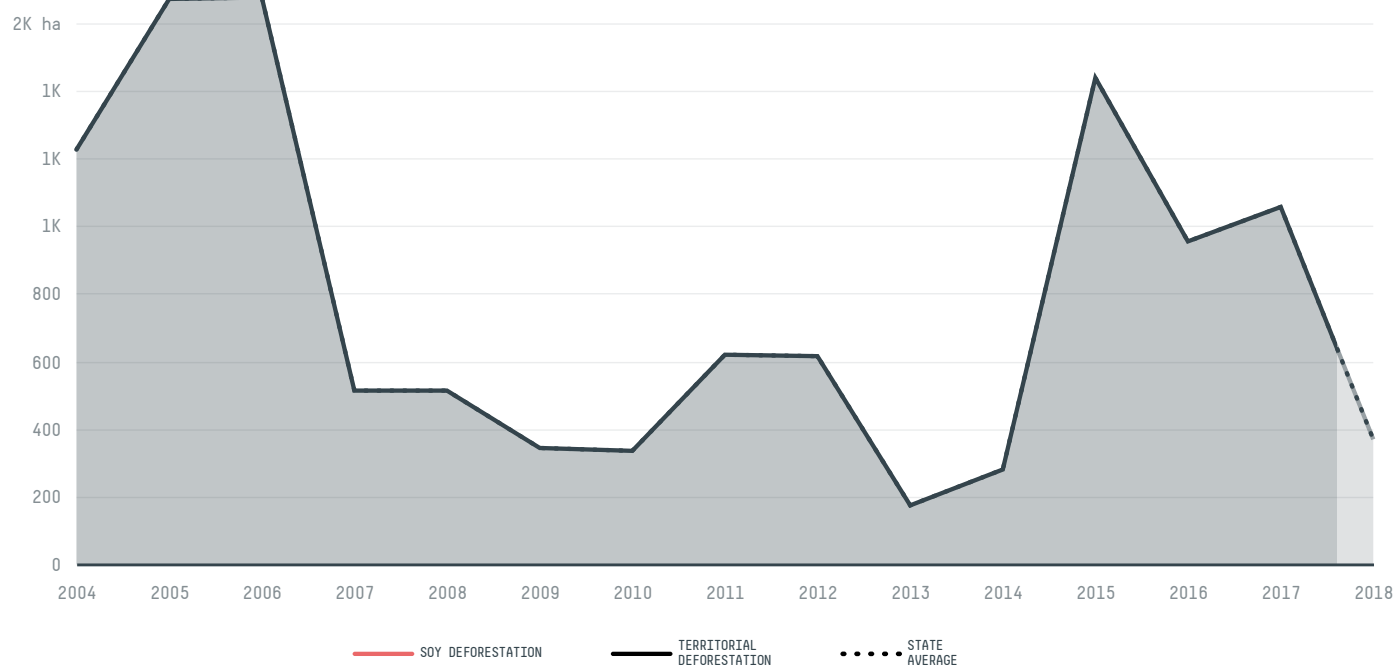

In 2018, Nova Olinda produced 962 t of soy occupying a total of 370 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1453rd in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Nova Olinda was Bunge, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

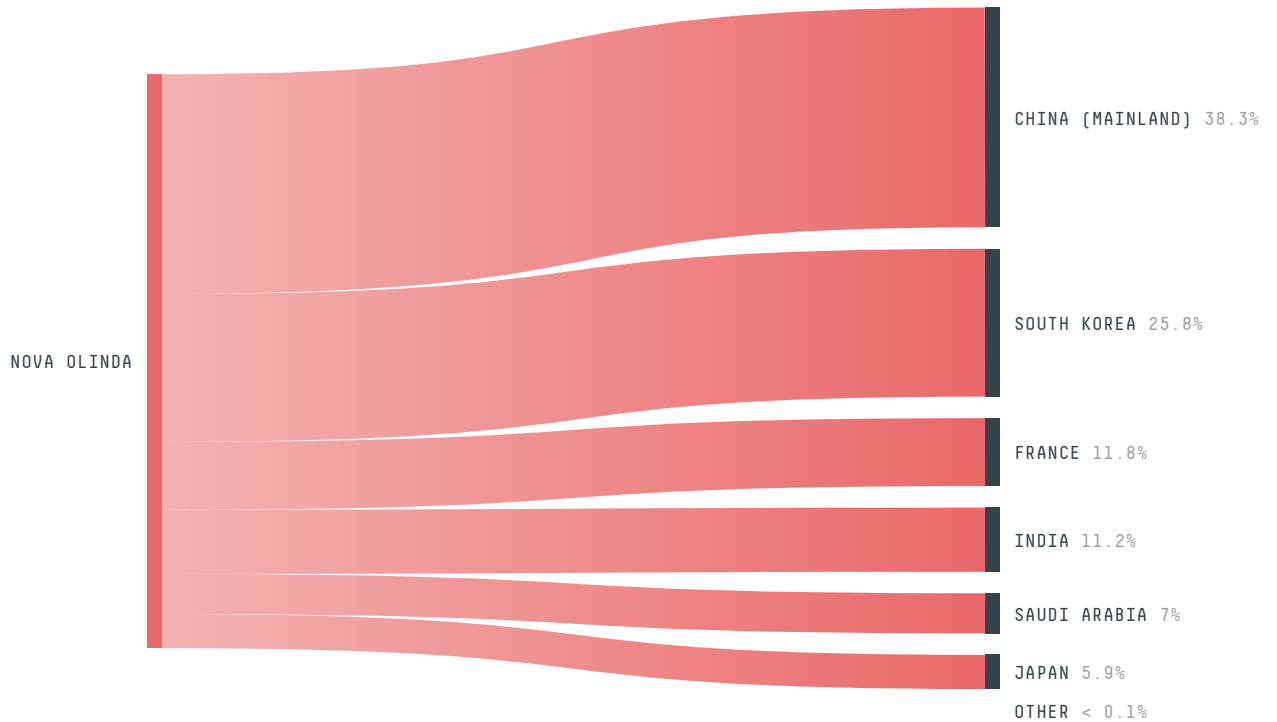
### DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVA OLINDA



## TOP TRADERS OF SOY IN NOVA OLINDA IN 2018



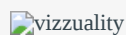
## TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF SOY FROM NOVA OLINDA IN 2018



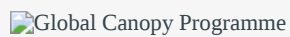
