In 2016, Governador Edison Lobao produced 144 t of soy occupying a total of 70 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1431st in Brazil in soy production, and 50th in the state of Maranhao. The largest exporter of soy in Governador Edison Lobao was Cargill, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

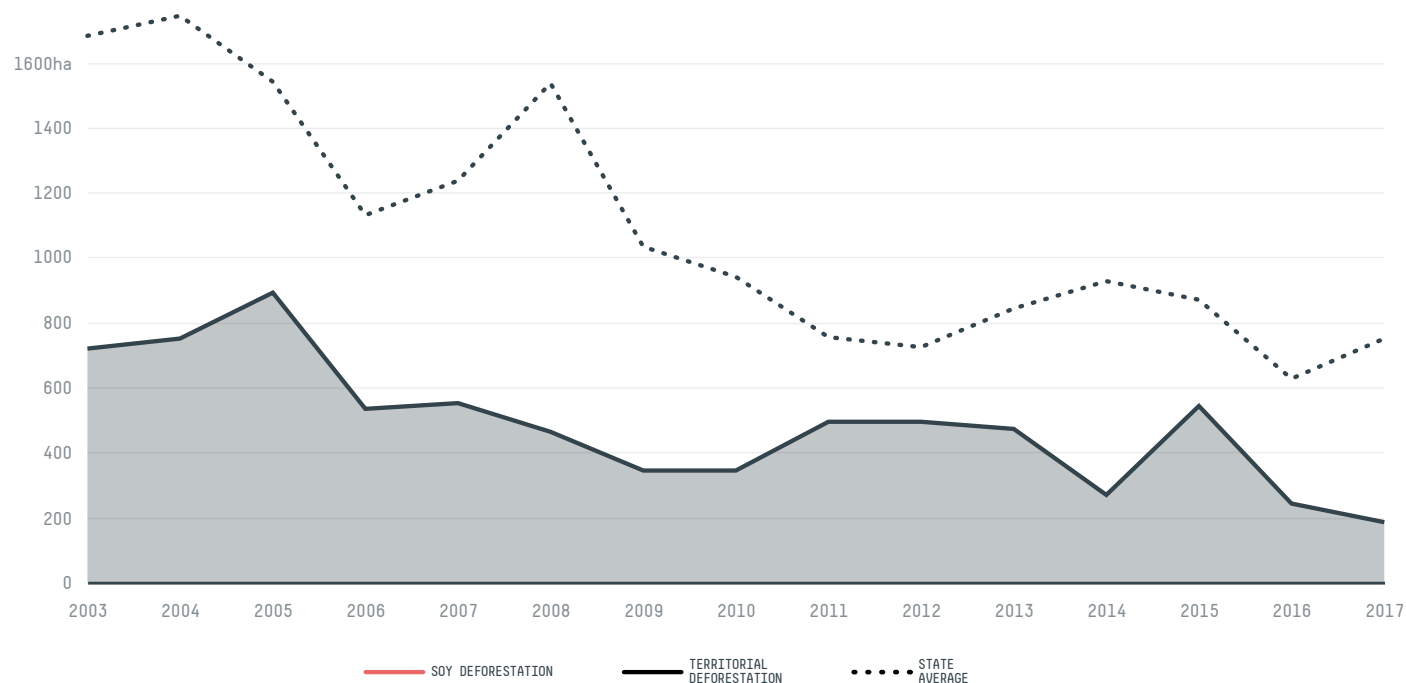

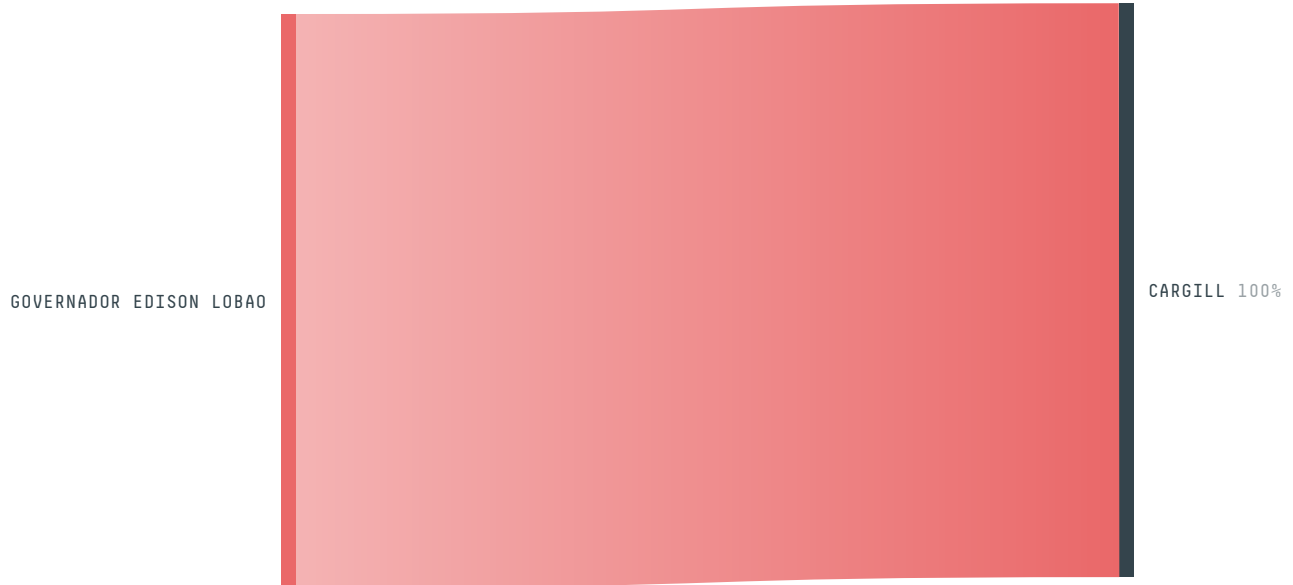

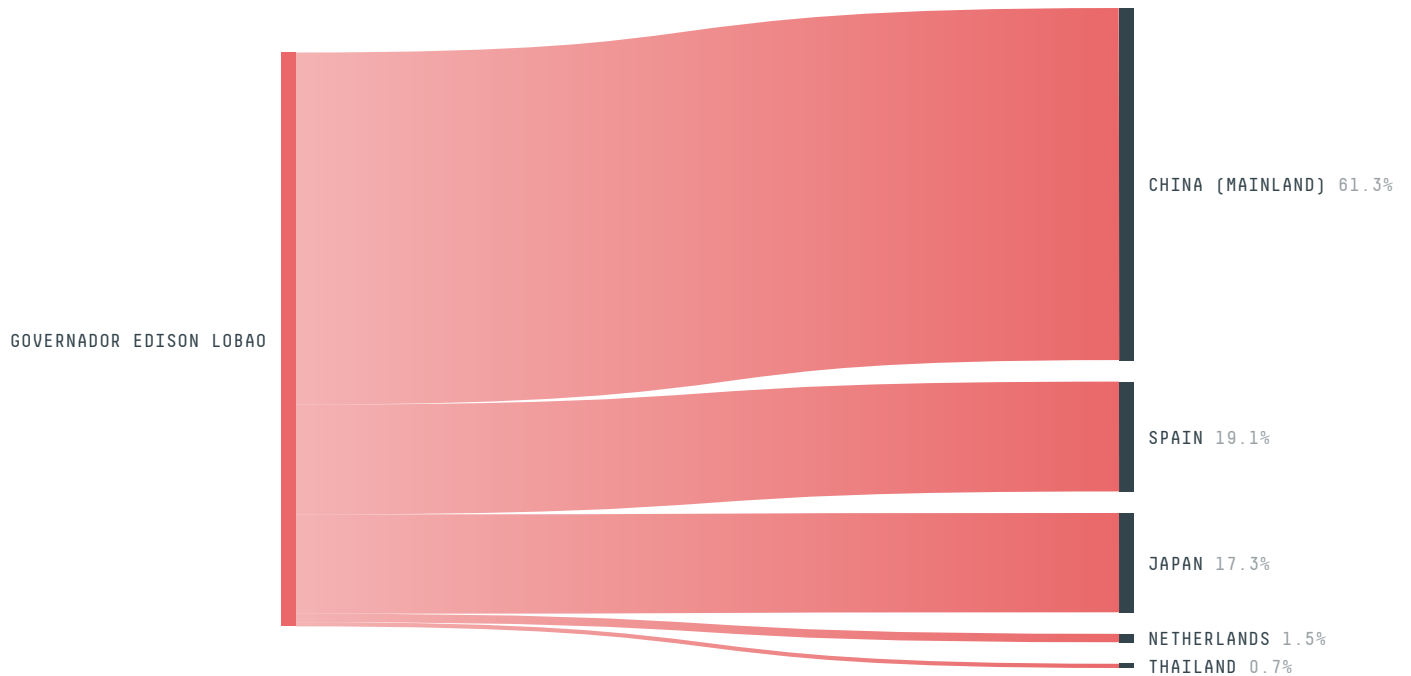
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF GOVERNADOR EDISON LOBAO
