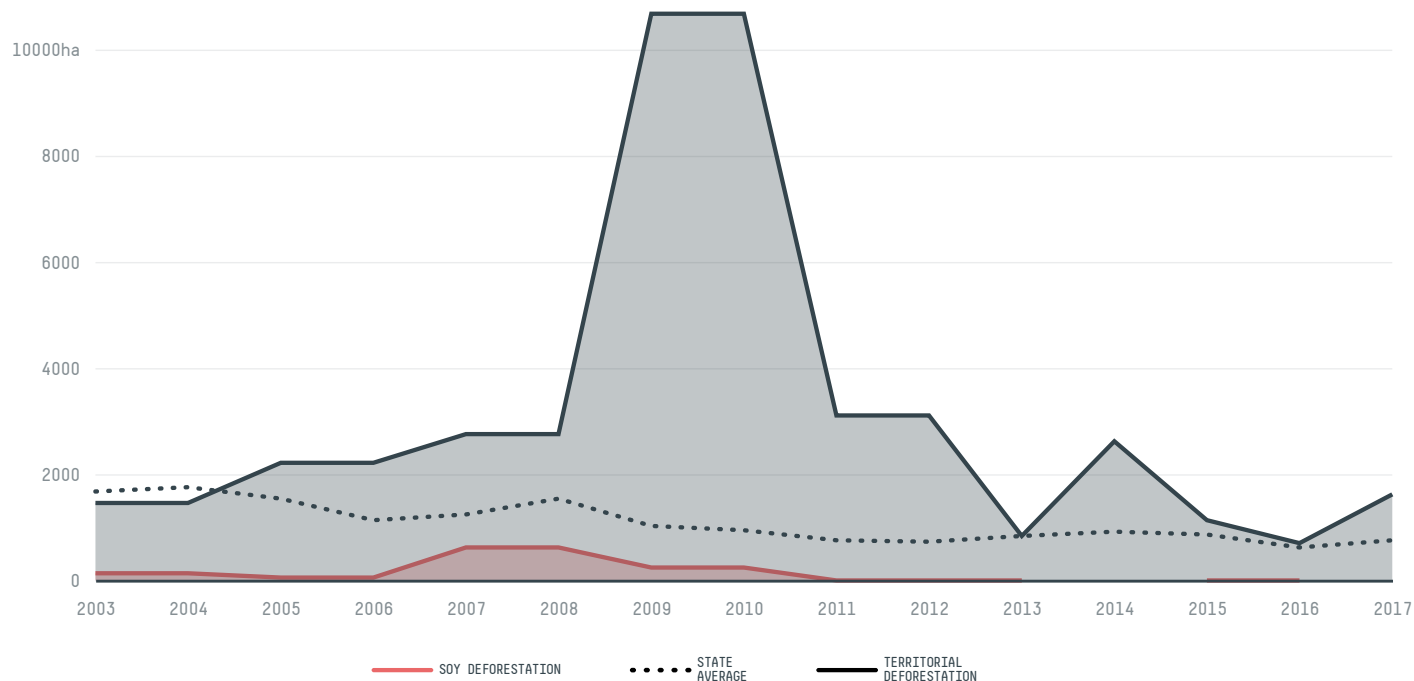
In 2017, Santa Quiteria Do Maranhao produced 7,200 t of soy occupying a total of 2,400 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1084th in Brazil in soy production, and 35th in the state of Maranhao.

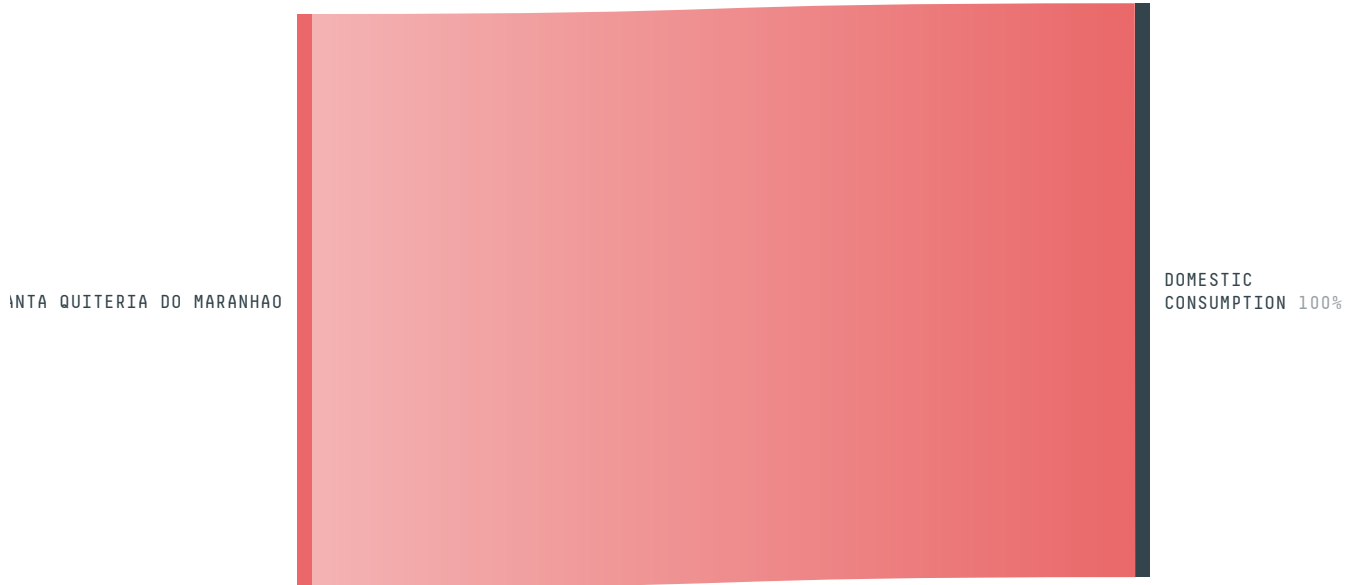

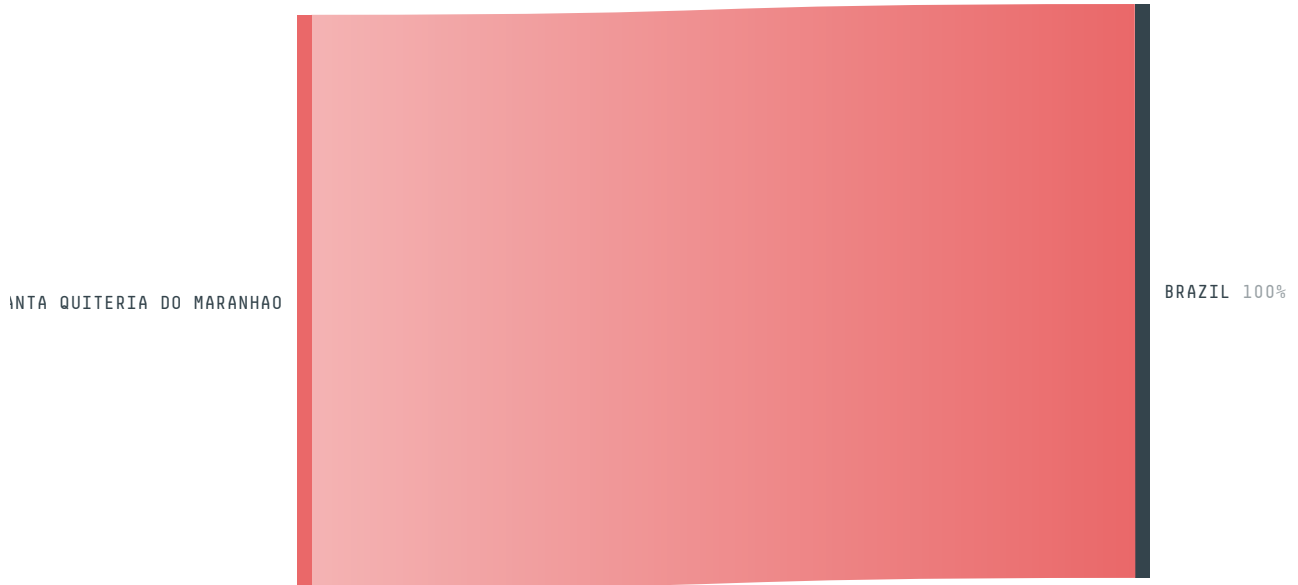
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SANTA QUITERIA DO MARANHAO
