In 2017, Sao Bernardo produced 4,116 t of soy occupying a total of 1,400 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1201st in Brazil in soy production, and 41st in the state of Maranhao. The largest exporter of soy in Sao Bernardo was Bunge, which accounted for 73.5% of the total exports, and the main destination was Thailand.

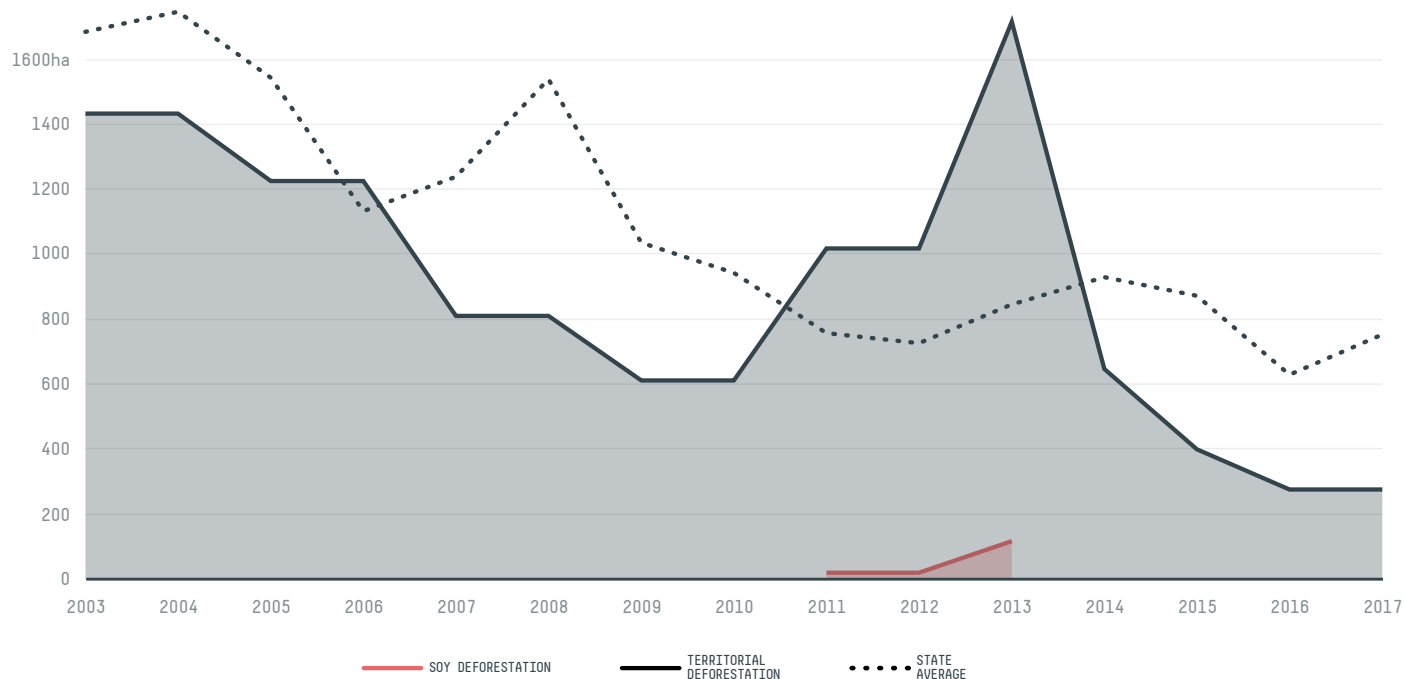
