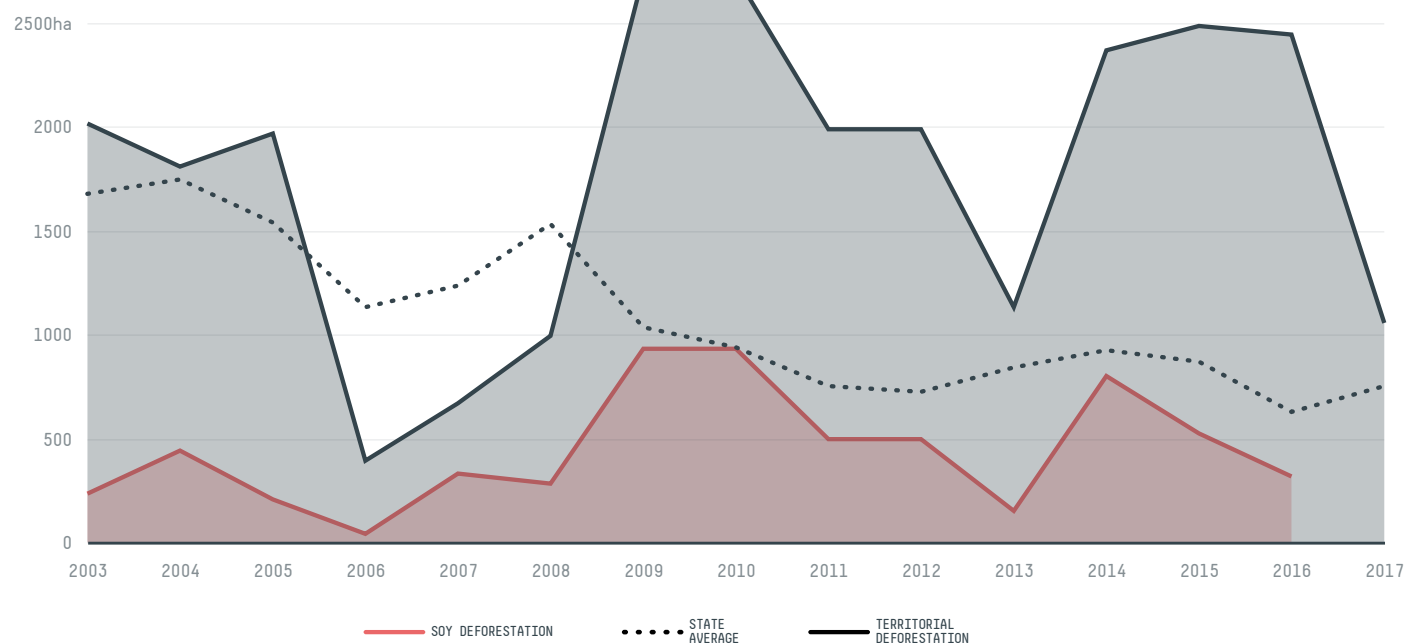
In 2017, Buriti produced 43,400 t of soy occupying a total of 14,000 ha of land. With 0.02% of the total production, it ranks 545th in Brazil in soy production, and 13th in the state of Maranhao.

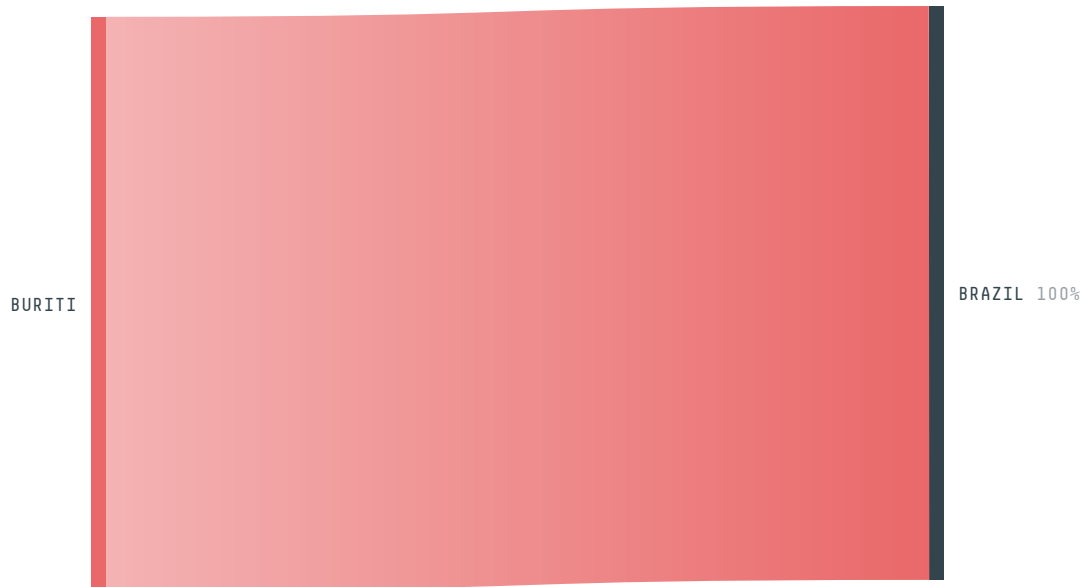
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BURITI
