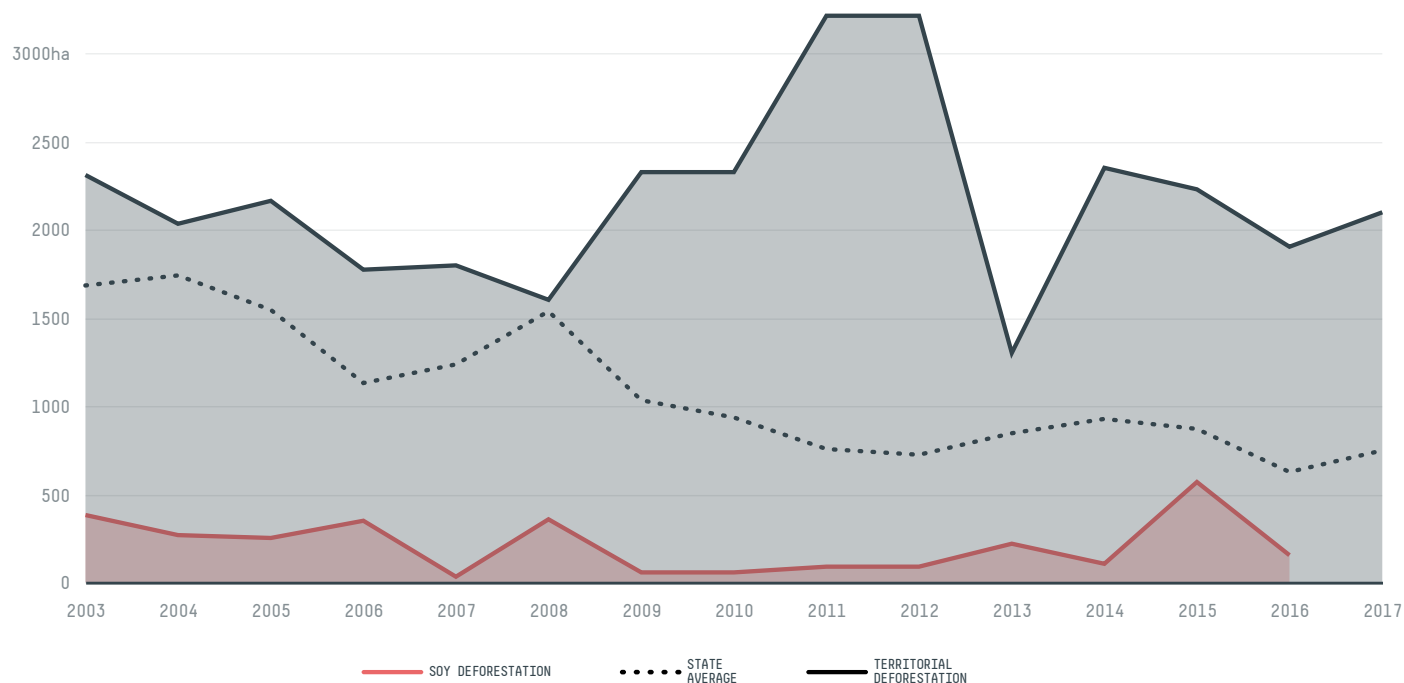

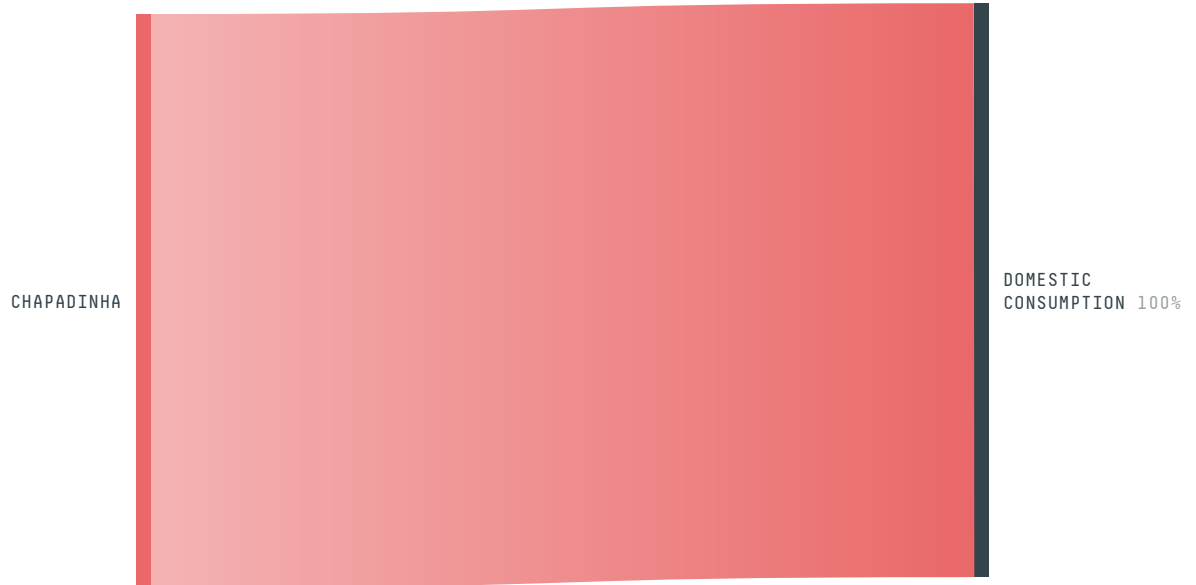

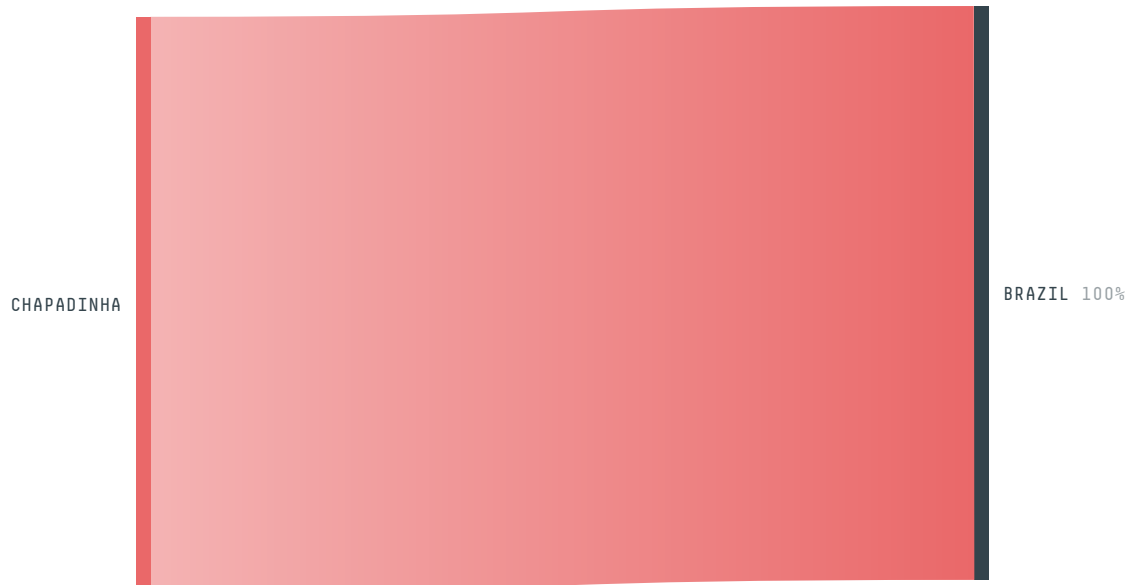
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CHAPADINHA
