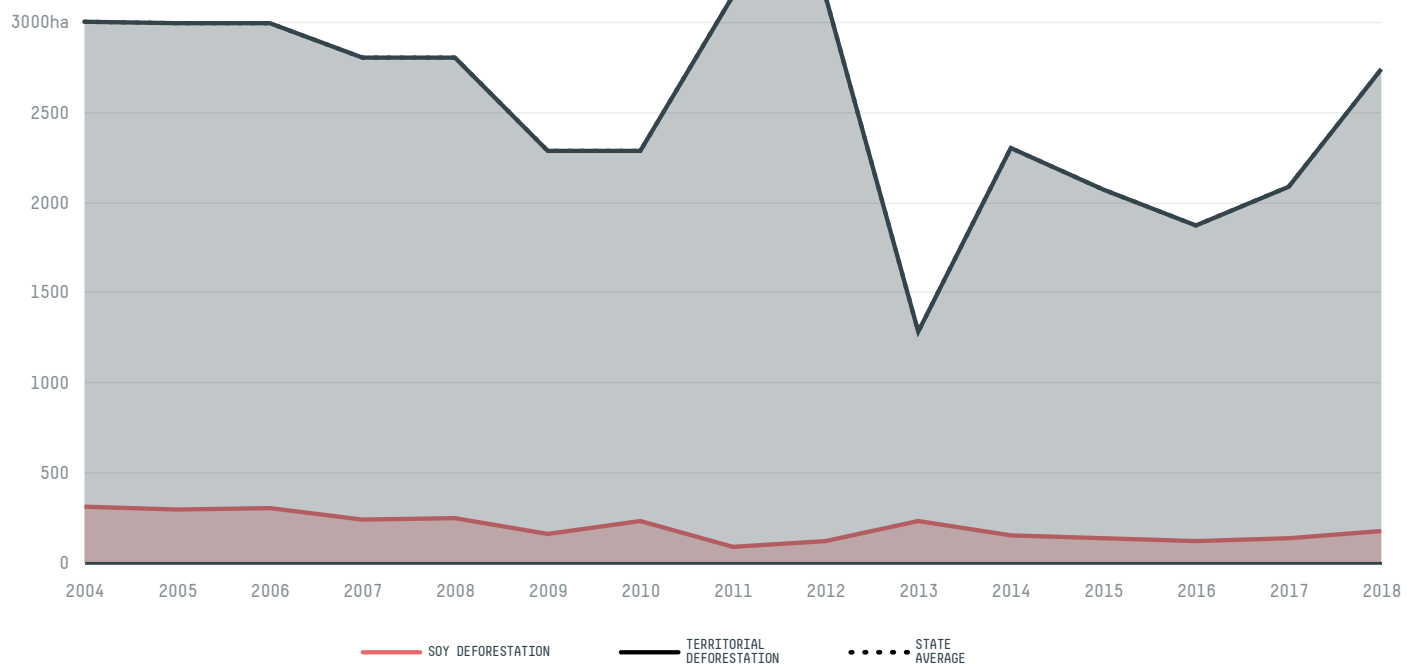
In 2018, Chapadinha produced 12,174 t of soy occupying a total of 3,853 ha of land. With 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 946th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Chapadinha was Cargill, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).
