AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND
1,708 km² 4,200 t 1,400 ha

In 2017, Urbano Santos produced 4,200 t of soy occupying a total of 1,400 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1195th in Brazil in soy production, and 39th in the state of Maranhao. The largest exporter of soy in Urbano Santos was Abc Industria, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

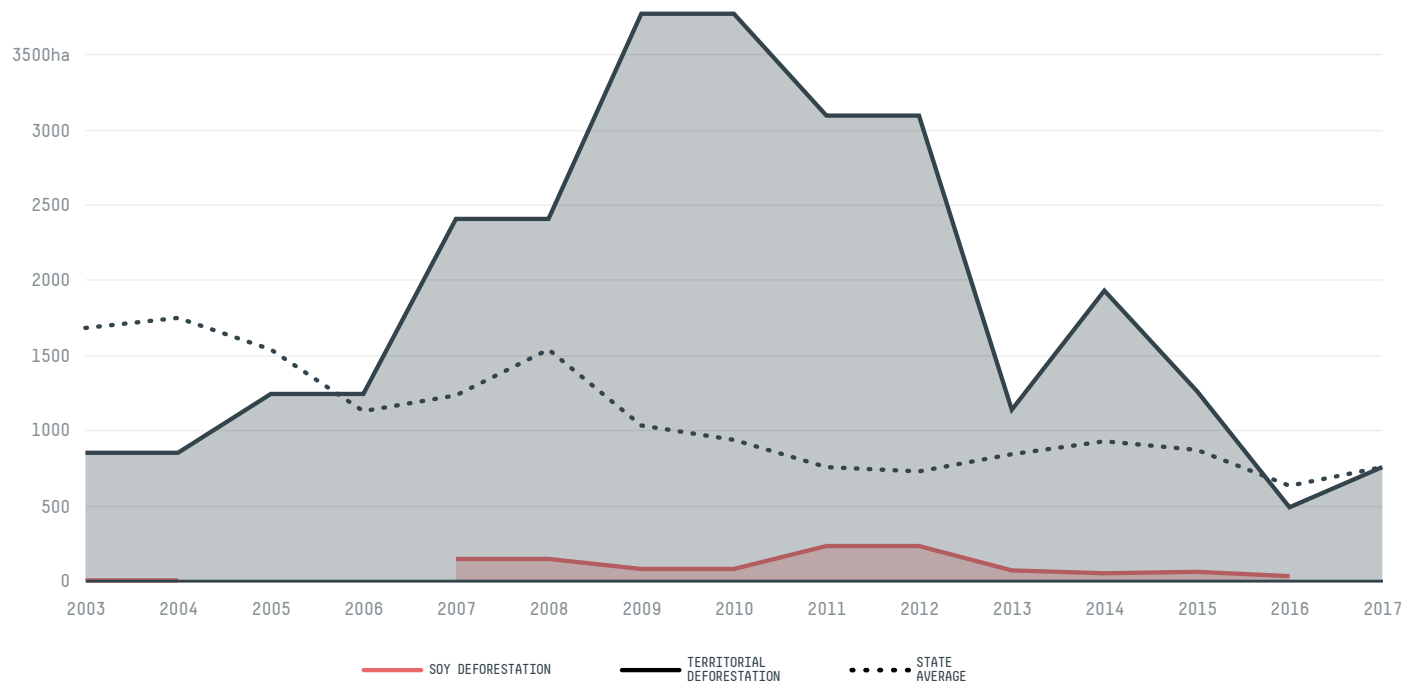

TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF SOY FROM URBANO SANTOS IN 2017



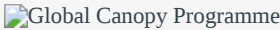


Deforestation alerts in Urbano Santos, Maranhão, Brazil

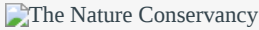
