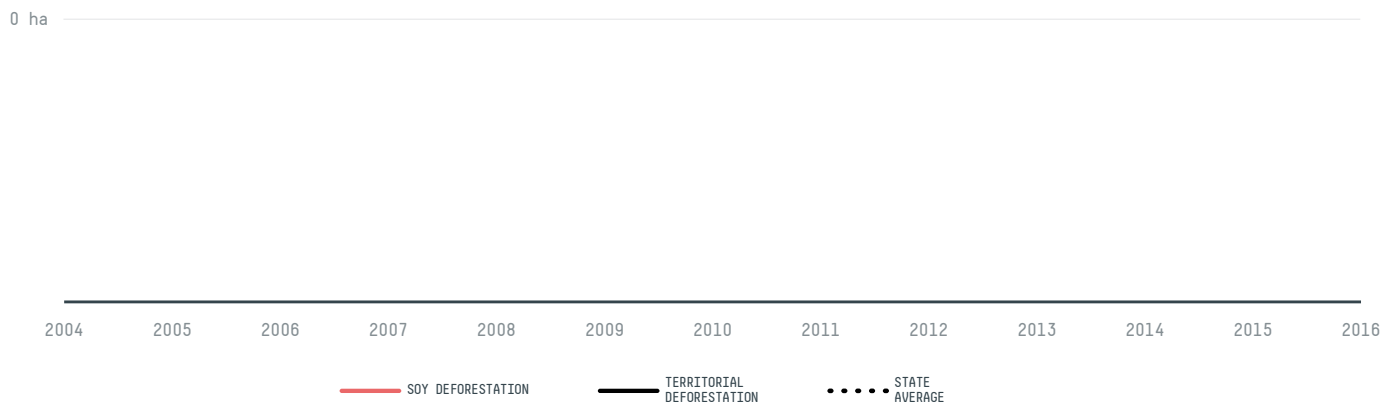
AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND

In 2004, Taquarana produced 90 t of soy occupying a total of 30 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1223rd in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Taquarana was Aat International, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

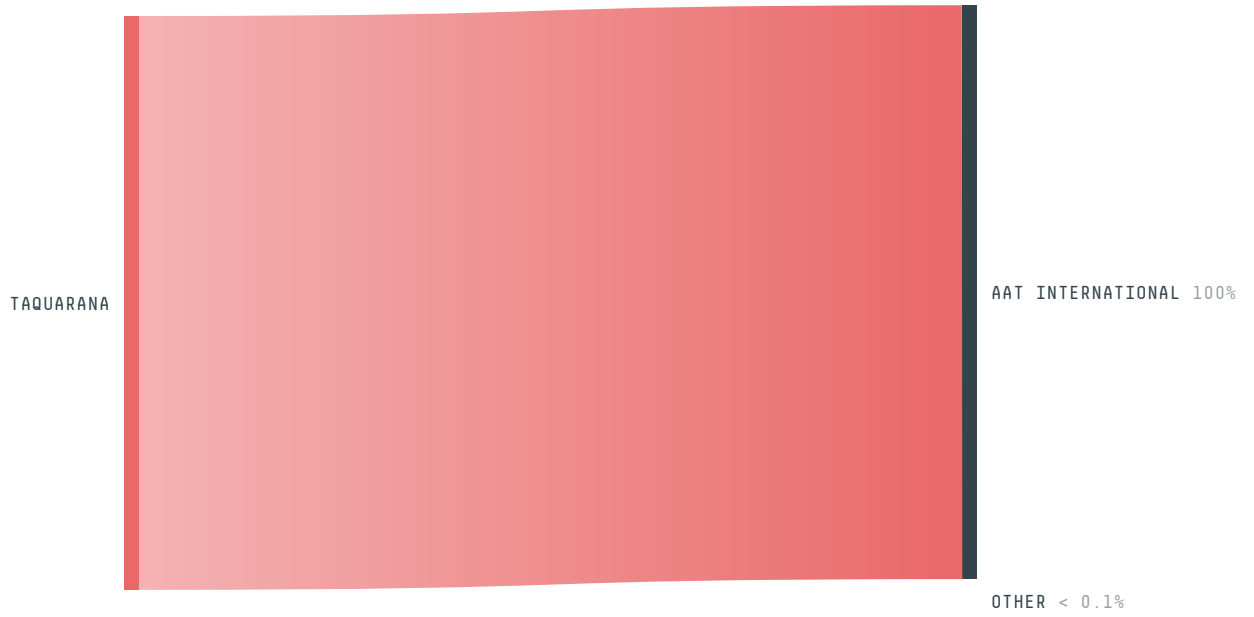
